<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Anata and detained a resident. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya, demolished 2 homes (including an apartment under construction) owned by Osama Al-Daraji and Riyadh Al Mazra’awi (owner of the apartment) for allegedly being built without a licence during which they clashed with residents who were protesting the demolitions and as a result injured a woman and detained a resident after assaulting him which left him with head injuries. • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the afternoon of January 19th 2015, Israeli forces detained the child

	<p>Mohammad Ghayth (16 years old) after assaulting him in Silwan neighbourhood and as a result left him with head injuries.</p> <p>(ii) On the evening of January 18th 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Amireh and Ahmad Amireh in Sur Bahar neighbourhood.</p> <p>(iii) On the morning of January 19th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mahdi Abu Al-Hawa and Tariq Abu Al-Hawa in Al-Tur neighbourhood.</p> <p>(iv) At 11:30, Israeli forces detained Hiba Al-Husseini as she was exiting Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</p> <p>(v) At 12:00, Israeli forces detained Abdallah Abu Qaf in Sur Bahaar village.</p> <p>(vi) Israeli forces detained Basil Al-Rifa'I in Anata.</p> <p>(vii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Zamrud in Al-Eisawiya.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Injury:</u> At 20:00, An Israeli Military jeep ran over and injured the child: Jenin Salem Ka'abneh (6 years old) in Al-Eizariya leaving her hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On the morning January 19th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained Juman Abu Arfah (a journalist) as she was exiting Al-Aqsa mosque compound. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 18:50 on January 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the area between Al-Mughier village and a by pas road and the main road between Al-Mughier and Duma villages with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge located in North Bir Zeit until 21:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 05:45. (ii) At 04:40, Israeli forces raided Mazar'I Al-Nubani village, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:10. (iii) At 04:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, stormed several homes, detained a child, assaulted Taher Al-Rimawi (80 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions then withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Wadaah Thiyab in Mazar'I Al-Nubani village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Suhayeb Al-Rimawi (16 years old) in Beit Rima. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (ii) At 16:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Nathim village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.

JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:30 on January 19th 2015, Israeli forces raided Barta’a Al-Sharqiya village and served two demolition orders for two barracks for allegedly being built without proper licencing. (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided the area between Qabatiya and Masliyat villages until 13:05. (iii) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Da’if village until 11:40. (iv) At 13:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village, stormed a home and temporarily detained its residents then released them after questioning. (v) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya and Jaba’, detained a resident in Jabaa’ then withdrew at 04:35. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 16th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Al-Jamalah village detained Yacoub Mir’I (A resident of Jenin). (ii) On January 18th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Nator (A resident of Jenin) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Salatnah in Jaba’.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:25, Israeli forces positioned at Tayassir checkpoint temporarily detained three residents: Abdel-Salam Odeh, Abdel Karim Bashirat and an unidentified resident while they were herding their sheep near the checkpoint and released them at 16:30.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:35, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Nur Al-Shams camp in Tulkarem, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:40. (ii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Attil and stormed three homes. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hazim Abu Diya during their raid into Nur Al-Shams camp in Tulkarem. • <u>Closure of Wall gate:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces closed wall gate (408) near Akaba village and prevented farmers from entering the gate for alleged attempts by local residents of cutting a whole through the barbed wire fence on the wall gate and allowed them to pass through at 19:30.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural

	<p>road leading to Far'ata village, which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00 and again at 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Jayyus and Kafar Jamal village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, stormed and searched several homes, summoned 4 residents: Ahmad Shamasneh , Mudar Al-Bik, Alaa Bayada and Amin Shamasneh then withdrew at 01:15. (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided immatin village, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:00. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed a home then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces detained Nassar Thiyab (A resident of Azzun) near Al-Nabi Eliyas village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Malik Ghanam in Immatin village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:05, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate leading to Azzun Atma temporarily detained five children then released them at 14:00. (ii) At 16:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun temporarily detained Othman Radwan then released him later. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village until 12:10. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Madma village, took photographs of several merchant shops then withdrew at 16:55. • <u>Detention:</u> At 02:15 on January 19th 2015, Israeli forces detained Dr. Waleed Abu Ziena (A University Professor at Al-Najah University) and confiscated his computer during their raid into Nablus as mentioned in the previous report
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 01:00 on January 2nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 14:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:00. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint beneath Iskaka Village Bridge until 11:15.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. <p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron and detained a resident. (ii) At 17:20, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at road (35) and (60) junctions and at Halhul Bridge in North Hebron. <p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis and Rafah. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats in North Gaza.
