<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, installed a checkpoint then withdrew at 23:15. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On March 31st 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Wad road area in the old city of Jerusalem detained Yasser Najeeb after storming his home. (ii) On March 31st 2015, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem Hijazi Abu Sbieh. (iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained Mu’tasim Boyatil. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at Shu’fat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On March 31st 2015, Israeli forces stormed Wad Al-Juz and Al-Sunah neighbourhood demolished several barrack’s owned by Hani Tutah. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ras Kar Kar village, temporarily detained several residents then released them after taking their finger prints then withdrew at 23:05. • <u>Raid:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:00 on March 31st 2015, Israeli forces raided Obwein, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 05:00. (ii) At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Qubiya village, stormed a merchant shop then withdrew at 13:00. (iii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:50. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Ofar” Military base fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Abboud fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged firebombing of an Israeli military Jeep. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Abdel-Hamid Hussien in Beituniya.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village until 19:30. (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes and as a result injured Ahmad Jalamneh and detained 2 residents as well as temporarily detaining 4 residents including a Woman: Khawlah Al-Damj, Tarik Al-Damj and Fawzi Al-Damj and released them at a later time then withdrew at 05:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Qareeni and Abdel-Kareem Abu Fawaz in Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 07:25 on March 31st 2015 and again at 20:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:40. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:45, Israeli forces raided Far’oun, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 22:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:10, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Forces stormed the entrance of Shufa village and impeded the free flow of traffic then withdrew at 20:30.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrances of Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib village. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on April 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Azzun, detained a resident

(ii) Israeli forces detained Anas Saleem in Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:25, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint, after a car accident which caused one of the vehicles to inadvertently hit an Israeli Soldier during which Israeli forces assaulted Ahmad Al-Najjar (the driver) as they temporarily detained him then released him at a later time and impeded the free flow of traffic until 15:20. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Shave Shomron” settlement junction until 10:15. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan village until 21:40. (iii) At 07:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Assirah Al-Shimaliya until 08:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Sawiyah village, stormed a school, assaulted Oaws Fadil (A school teacher) and forcibly removed teachers and students out of the school for the alleged stoning of an Israeli Settler vehicle. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Awarta village until 14:45. (iii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Orif village, stormed and searched two homes then withdrew at 07:30. (iv) At 04:50, Israeli forces raided Nablus, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 05:55. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:10, Israeli forces detained Adham Mabrookat (A resident of Nablus) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Imad Al-Sadek, Mansour Al-Batiyah and Mohammad Akoubah in Nablus.

	<p>detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</p> <p>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</p> <p>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: At 10:20, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:20. • Flying Checkpoint: At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Yasuf village.

<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 and Road #35 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up four checkpoints at the north entrance of Hebron, at the entrance of Sa'ir, near Wadi Qif area located near Tarqumiya and at the West entrance Sa'ir. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir and Al-Shoyoukh then stormed and searched a home. (ii) At 11:40 and again at 00:10, Israeli forces raided Ithna until 00:50. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, detained 4 residents including 3 University students. (iv) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya. (v) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Yatta and stormed a home. <p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire and launching stun and tear gas grenades from their positions behind the Green Line towards d Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards an Israeli Military Jeep near the border fence as alleged by the Israeli military

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p>KHAN YUNIS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: On the afternoon of March 31st 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents for allegedly being near the border fence in east Al-Qarara in response to alleged gunfire by Palestinian gunmen towards an Israeli Military vehicle near the border fence as alleged by the Israeli Military.
<p>RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
