### **MONTHLY SUMMARY OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS** **01 November 2014 – 30 November 2014**

The following summary tables and overview of events survey hostile Israeli activities during the period 01 November 2014 to 30 November 2014. The report includes a summary table of events, classified by type, throughout the West Bank and Gaza Strip, in addition to a comparative table surveying events over the past three months. The survey is compiled from the Daily Situation Reports of the Palestinian Monitoring Group (PMG) of the Negotiations Affairs Department (NAD) of the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO). The PMG monitors ground conditions in the West Bank and Gaza Strip, including Israeli and Palestinian violations. The PMG Daily Situation Reports are a survey of daily events collated from information provided by civil ministries and security agencies of the Palestinian National Authority. The information reported through the PMG process represents data available at the time of distribution only.

## SAMPLE OF ISRAELI VIOLATIONS DURING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2014

- **November 5<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Ibrahim AlAkari (A resident of Shu'fat camp) was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him after he had ran over several Israeli settlers with his vehicles and as a result killed one Israeli soldier and injured 13 Israeli settlers near the rail station in Al-Sheikh Jarah neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- **November 5<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli settlers the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from entering the compound during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards worshipers inside Al-Aqsa mosque as they attempted to prevent Israeli settlers from storming the mosque during which Israeli forces entered Al-Qibli mosque and fired tear gas grenades and as a result set fire to carpet and several electronic equipment inside and also injured 10 residents including a woman and a journalist: Lo'ay Abu Irmeleh (A journalist), Sabrin Obidat (a journalist), Shamiya Abu Sbieh, Thaer Abu Sbieh, Hamza Ajaj, Nihad Za'ir, Rabi' Al-Satad, Ibrahim Abu Gharbiya, Awad Al-Salamiya and Midhat Jabr as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- **November 7<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 8 residents including 2 children and a paramedic: Yusef Farhan (16 years old), Omar Orabi (15 years old), Yusef Abdel-Qadder (A Paramedic), Abdel-Mu'ti Abu Sneneh, Munthir Manasrah, Mohammad Attalah, Ashraf Matour and Yusef Abdel-Qadder.
- **November 7<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli forces positioned near the north junction of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Khaled Al-Bassati (15 years old)
- **November 7<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 7 residents including 5 children: Khalil Hillis (14 years old), Ahmad Al-Ramahi (17 years old), Mohammad Khattab (17 years old), Qassim Abu Adib (16 years old), Yusef Farhan (16 years old), Omar Arrabi and Munthir Manassrah as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- **November 10<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Shate' area in Rafah and as a result injured two unidentified fishermen and destroyed two fishing boats.
- **November 10<sup>th</sup> 2014:** 3 children: Sufiyan Abdel-Jabbar (2 years old), Adel Khalaf (14 years old) and Mohammad Shwiqat (11 years old) were injured after a tear gas grenade canister exploded near Hizma and as a result were hospitalised.
- **November 11<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of "Ofar" Military Base/ Prison fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 7 residents including 2 children: Eyad Aliyan (14 years old), Ibrahim Qandah (17 years old), Mahmoud Aliyan, Eyad Samarah, Ahmad Harish, Abdel-Rahman Samarah and Ahmad Othman.
- **November 11<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, clashed with several residents and a result injured two children: Moa'yad Khattabat (16 years old) and Ali Hani (16 years old) until 11:30.
- **November 11<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed Mohammad Jawabrah (21 years old).
- **November 13<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli forces raided Askar camp in Nablus, clashed with several residents and as a result injured 4 residents including 3 children: Yazan Al-Ajouzi (15 years old), Hamza Qatani (14 years old), Hamza Awad (12 years old) and Agham Al-Shalabi as well as occupying several homes surrounding the home of Khaled Abu Hashiyeh (who stabbed an Israeli soldier in Tel Aviv) and converted their rooftops into military posts then stormed and searched the home and took photographs of the home.

- **November 14<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli forces positioned near Al-Fuwar junction fired live ammunition stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Hmza Abu Ma'ali (15 years old).
- **November 17<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Yusef Al-Rumani (A resident of Al-Tur neighbourhood) was killed by Israeli settlers as he was on duty working as a bus driver for "Egged" Bus Company during which the Israeli settler beat him and then strangled him to death and left him hanged by a rope inside the bus.
- **November 18<sup>th</sup> 2014:** 2 residents: Ghassan Abu Jamal and Oday Abu Jamal (residents of Jabal Al-Mukabir) were killed by Israeli forces after they allegedly entered a Jewish synagogue in Jerusalem and killed four Israeli settlers and injured eight others.
- **November 18<sup>th</sup> 2014:** The child Mohammad Siyam (16 years old) {A resident of Rafah} died at a hospital in the Republic of Turkey from injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza Strip.
- **November 21<sup>st</sup> 2014:** Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents including a woman: Nawal Al-Tamimi, Ammar Al-Ghalban and Sa'ed Al-Masri.
- **November 21<sup>st</sup> 2014:** A group of Israeli settlers armed with steel pipes stormed Jerusalem and assaulted Sanaa Al-Salaymeh and as a result left her hospitalised with contusions.
- **November 23<sup>rd</sup> 2014:** Ahmad Sawafta (A resident of Tubas died at a hospital in Israel of injuries sustained after an Israeli Military UXO near him as he was herding his sheep in Bardalah village.
- **November 23<sup>rd</sup> 2014:** Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line opened fire towards east Jabaliya and as a result killed Fadil Hawalah (A resident of Jabaliya).
- **November 24<sup>th</sup> 2014:** The Palestinian Minister of Detainees and Ex-Detainees affairs confirmed that the Israeli Prison authorities in Rimon prison assaulted several detainees and as a result injured six including two critically injured: Issah Jabarin and Adel Al-Nashash leaving them hospitalized in critical condition.
- **November 28<sup>th</sup> 2014:** Israeli; forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 children: Ibrahim Hassan (15 years old), Omar Zied (15 years old) and Ahmad Rahmah (15 years old).

In addition Israeli navy vessels carried out 12 attacks on Palestinian fishermen and territory , 3 from Settler attack, 1 from Military checkpoint and 2 attacks during raids

The majority of arrests took place in the districts of Jerusalem (299); Ramallah (41); Jenin (12); Tubas (4) Tulkarem (18); Qalqiliya (9); Nablus (26); Salfit (13); Jericho (12); Bethlehem (37); Hebron (83), North Gaza (1), Gaza (1) , Central Gaza (4), Khan Yunis (6) and Rafah (10). Among those arrested by the Israeli military were 58 children, 5 Security Force officers and 11 Women.

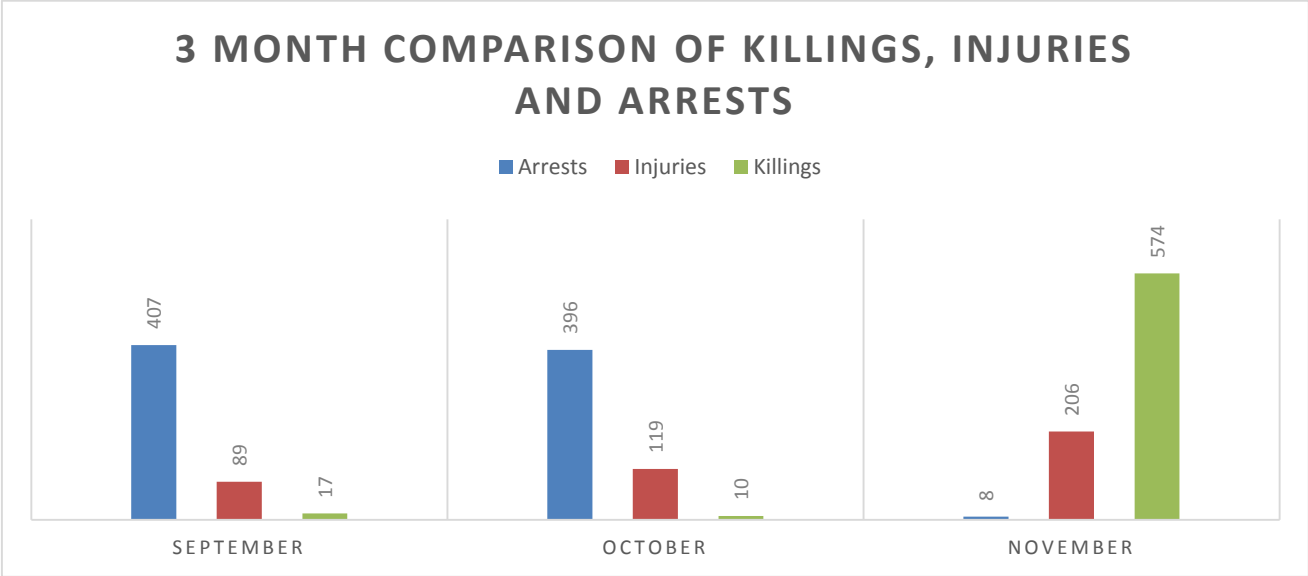

Israeli forces levelled a plot of agricultural land near "Nitavim" settlement located in south Qarwat Bani Hassan for the purpose of settlement expansion. Israeli Authorities approved plans for the construction of 200 settlement units in "Ramot" settlement located in North Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967. Israeli authorities approved the construction of 500 settlement unites in "Ramat Shlomo" settlement in north Jerusalem on Palestinian Land occupied in 1967. Israeli Authorities approved planes for the construction of 78 settlement unites (50 of which will be built in "Har Homa" settlement and 28 will be built in "Ramot" settlement) in Jerusalem on Palestinian land occupied ion 1967. Israeli forces confiscated 214 dunums of land in Biddu, Beit Surik, Qutna and Ghalous area in Jerusalem. Israeli forces served a military order for the confiscation of 12852 dunumes/acres of land in Beit Ikssa for Military purposes. The Israeli Military served an order for the confiscation of 35.1 dunumes/acres of land in Beit Hanina in Jerusalem. Israeli forces stormed the east area of Burin village and levelled a plot of land owned by Al-Najjar family located near a settlement outpost. , Israeli forces confiscated a plot of land located near

## ANALYSIS OF EVENTS

### ■ **Killings:**

During the month of November 2014, Israeli forces killed 8 residents (6 in the West Bank and 2 in the Gaza Strip) which included the following:

- (i) On November 5<sup>th</sup> 2014, Ibrahim AlAkari (A resident of Shu'fat camp) was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him after he had ran over several Israeli settlers with his vehicles and as a result killed one Israeli soldier and injured 13 Israeli settlers near the rail station in Al-Sheikh Jarah neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- (ii) On November 11<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed Mohammad Jawabrah (21 years old).
- (iii) On November 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Yusef Al-Rumani (A resident of Al-Tur neighbourhood) was killed by Israeli settlers as he was on duty working as a bus driver for "Egged" Bus Company during which the Israeli settler beat him and then strangled him to death and left him hanged by a rope inside the bus.
- (iv) November 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, 2 residents: Ghassan Abu Jamal and Oday Abu Jamal (residents of Jabal Al-Mukabir) were killed by Israeli forces after they allegedly entered a Jewish synagogue in Jerusalem and killed 4 Israeli settlers and injured 8 others.
- (v) November 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, the child Mohammad Siyam (16 years old) {A resident of Rafah} died at a hospital in the Republic of Turkey from injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza Strip.
- (vi) November 23<sup>rd</sup> 2014, Ahmad Sawafta (A resident of Tubas died at a hospital in Israel of injuries sustained after an Israeli Military UXO near him as he was herding his sheep in Bardalah village.
- (vii) November 23<sup>rd</sup> 2014 Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line opened fire towards east Jabaliya and as a result killed Fadil Hawalah (A resident of Jabaliya).

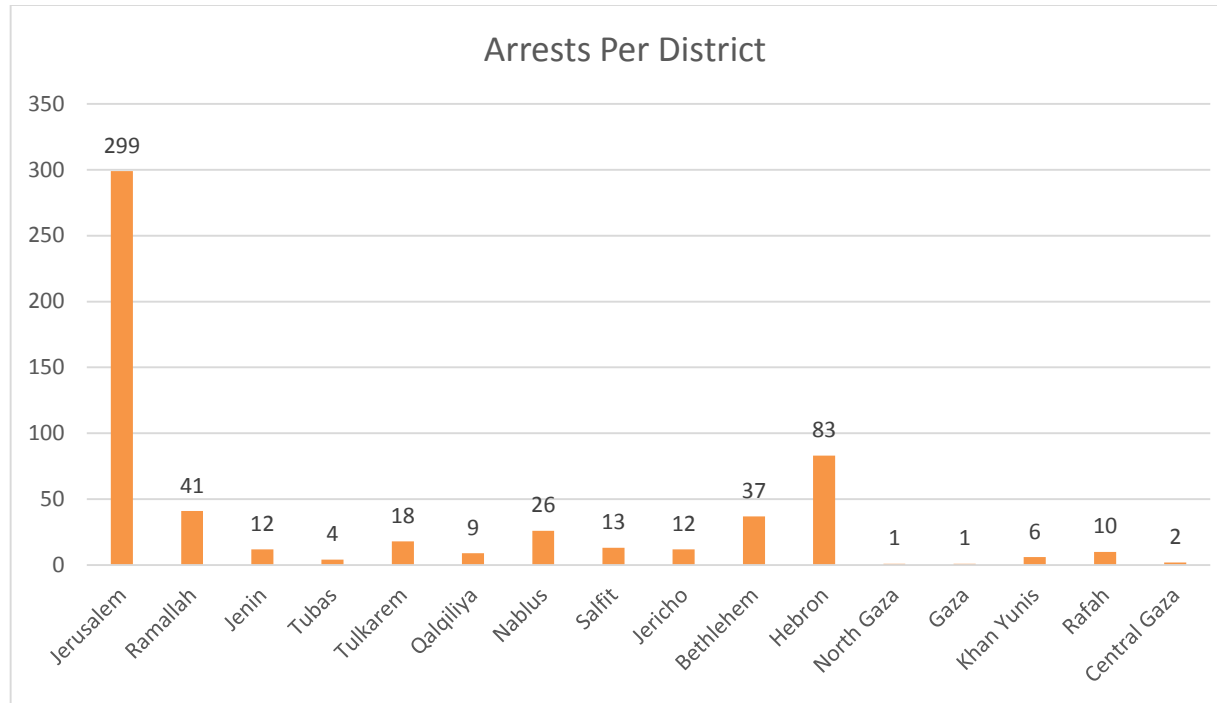
### ■ **Injuries**

206 injuries were reported in the month of November (169 Palestinians in the West Bank and 10 in the Gaza Strip). Injuries included 52 children, 5 Women, 6 Detainees, 2 fishermen, 2 Journalists and 2 Paramedics.

### ■ **Arrests**

During the month of November, the Israeli military arrested 574 Palestinians (554 the West Bank and 20 in the Gaza Strip). The majority of arrests took place in the districts of Jerusalem (299); Ramallah (41); Jenin (12); Tubas (4) Tulkarem (18); Qalqiliya (9); Nablus (26); Salfit (13); Jericho (12); Bethlehem (37); Hebron (83), North Gaza (1), Gaza (1), Central Gaza (1), Khan Yunis (6) and Rafah (10). Among those arrested by the Israeli military were 57 children, 5 Security Force officers and 11 Women.

Israeli forces temporarily detained 326 residents at checkpoint and in residential area including 20 children, a Woman and 20 Security Force Officers.



### ■ Closure

Especially on Fridays, the Israeli military continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances of Jerusalem, and to restrict entrance to the Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem, preventing worshippers from accessing the Mosque. At the *Qalandiya checkpoint north of Jerusalem*, the Israeli military continues to prevent PNA registered civilian vehicles from crossing the checkpoint towards Ar Ram and Qalandiya as well as Dahiyat al Bareed. The checkpoint is overcrowded daily, particularly during rush hours, due to intensified restrictions and search measures applied by Israeli troops. During the month of March the Israeli military also continued to intensify restrictions at the *Tayasir checkpoint* and *Al Hamra junction checkpoint* leading to the Jordan Valley area, only allowing access to civilians whose IDs indicate District of Jericho residence or others holding special access permits. In addition, restrictions were intensified and civilian access was obstructed at the *Za'tara junction checkpoint* (separating the northern and central West Bank districts) as well as at the *As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint* (separating the central and southern West Bank districts).

The Israeli military installed 475 flying checkpoints in November (compared with 480 in October and 493 in September) and as a result restricted the free access and movement of residents, merchant supplies and agricultural goods.

### **Distribution of flying checkpoints in the West Bank**

The Israeli military set up 475 flying checkpoints in November and searched Palestinian civilians and vehicles in and around Palestinian residential areas in the

districts of Jerusalem (78); Ramallah (43); Jenin (3), Tubas (7) ; Tulkarem (10); Qalqiliya (78); Nablus (57); Salfit (12); Jericho (59); Bethlehem (73) and Hebron (55).

▪ **Raids**

The Israeli military carried out 406 **raids** in Palestinian residential areas during the month of November {405 in the West Bank and one in the Gaza Strip}. The majority of Israeli military raids were reported to have taken place in the districts of Jerusalem (36); Ramallah (66); Jenin (18), Tubas (9); Tulkarem (29); Qalqiliya (21); Nablus (66); Salfit (8); Jericho (16); Bethlehem (69) Hebron (67) and Central Gaza (1).

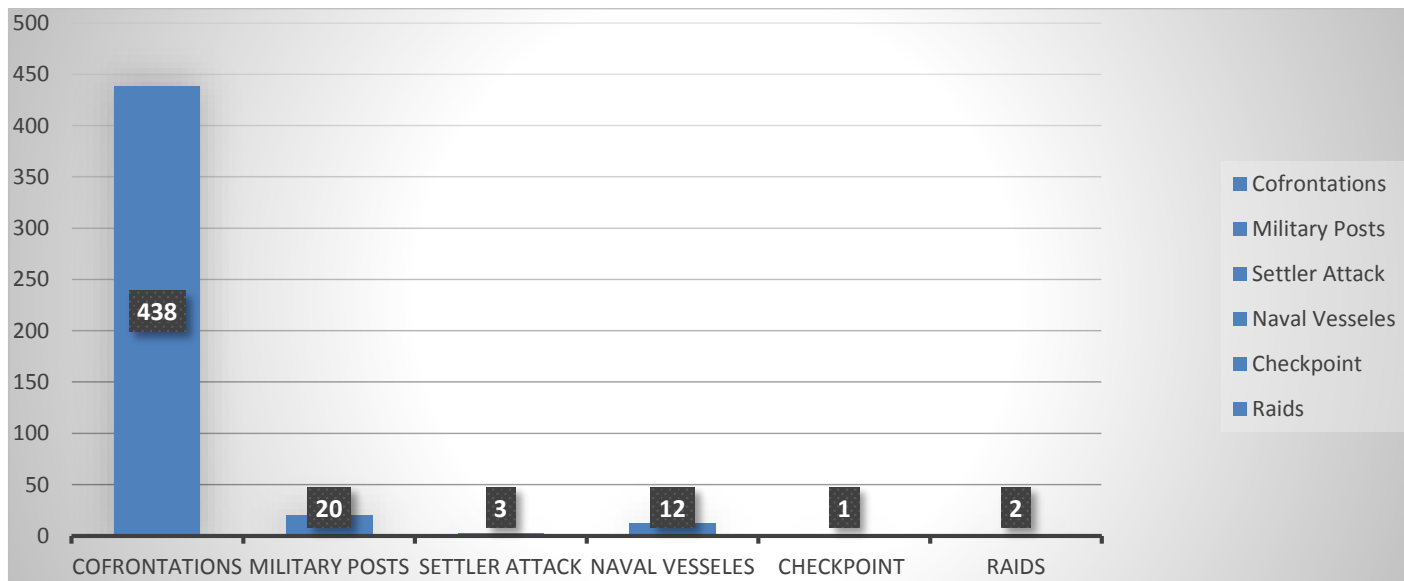
The Israeli military opened fire on 440 occasions during raids and clashes with civilians. (92.8% of attacks)

▪ **Attacks**

478 attacks were reported to have taken place during the month of November (443 in the West Bank and 35 in the Gaza Strip).

The Israeli military carried out 440 attacks during confrontations between the Israeli military and Palestinians and 20 attacks from Israeli military posts on civilian homes and property. In addition, Israeli navy vessels carried out 12 attacks on Palestinian fishermen and territory, 3 from Settler attack, 1 from Military checkpoint and 2 attacks during raids.

## ▪ **Home Demolition**

**During the month of November 2014, the Israeli military demolished Palestinian homes and residential tents, which consisted of the following:**

- The Israeli military demolished two homes (consisting of four apartments) in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces detonated and destroyed a home in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces demolished a home (under construction) in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces demolished several residential tents in Al-Tawil area located in the North Jordan valley in Tubas.
- Israeli forces demolished seven residential tents in Bardalah village in Tubas.
- Israeli forces demolished several residential tents in Bardalah village in Tubas.
- Israeli forces demolished two homes in Khirbeit Al-Taweel area located near Aqraba village in Nablus.
- Israeli forces demolished a residential tent in Um Al-Khaier village located in east Yatta in Hebron.

**During the month of November 2014, the Israeli Military served the following Demolition orders:**

- Israeli forces served demolition orders for 10 homes in Fasayil village in Jericho.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for 2 homes (under construction) in Taqou' in Bethlehem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for several Bedouin family tents in Al-Hijalin area located in west Beit Hanina in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for two homes in Aqbat Hasna area located in North West Al-Kahdr in Bethlehem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for four homes near Hajja village in Qalqiliya.
- Israeli forces served a demolition order for a home in Askar camp in Nablus.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for three homes in Kissan village in Bethlehem.
- Israeli forces served a demolition order for a home in Hebron.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for three homes and two residential tents in Mu'ien village located in east Yatta in Hebron.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for a home in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served a demolition order for the home of Mu'taz Hijazi in Al-Thur neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served a demolition order for the home of Abdel-Rahman Al-Shaludi in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served a demolition order for a home in Al-Eisawiya village in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for three homes in Al-Thur, Jabal Al-Mukabir and Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem.
- Israeli forces served demolition order for seven homes in Um Al-Khier village located in east Yatta in Hebron.
- Israeli forces served demolition orders for two homes owned by Ghassan Abu Jamal and Oday Abu Jamal (who killed four Israeli settlers at a Synagogue in Jerusalem).

## ▪ **Attacks on Public and Private Property**

A total of 90 incidents of destruction and confiscation of Palestinian public and private property by Israeli settlers and Israeli forces were reported in November 2014 (86 in the West Bank and 4 in the Gaza Strip).

**Attack on Public and Private property occurred as follows per District:**

**Jerusalem:** Israeli forces demolished 2 barracks in Jabal Al-Mukabir, set fire to the carpets inside Al-Aqsa mosque after a tear gas grenade canister exploded, Israeli forces demolished a barracks in Al-Tur neighbourhood, Israeli forces stormed and searched the Palestine Football Association headquarters in Al-Ram, and Israeli settlers damaged a vehicle in Sur Bahar village, Israeli forces damaged a vehicle after a tear gas grenade exploded inside the vehicle in Al-Ram, Israeli settlers damaged a rental vehicle near "Ramat Shaakol" settlement in Jerusalem and Israeli settlers slashed the tires of 5 vehicles in Beit Safafa.

**Ramallah:** Israeli settlers damaged a vehicle at the entrance of Burqa village, damaged a vehicle at the entrance of Silwad, Israeli forces shut down several merchant shops in Biet Illu village, Israeli settlers damaged a home in Khirbeit Abu Falah village, Israeli forces opened fire towards and damaged a vehicle in "Ofar" settlement and Israeli settlers smashed the windshield of a vehicle in Beit Illu.

**Tubas:** Israeli forces demolished three Barracks in Bardala village and demolished two barracks in Al-Aqba village.

**Nablus:** Israeli forces levelled a plot of land in Aqraba village, Israeli settlers set fire to agricultural land in Burin, Israeli forces damaged the identification card of a National Security force officer near “Yitsahar” settlement and Israeli forces closed several merchant shops located along the main road in Huwara.

**Qalqiliya:** Israeli forces demolished three barracks in Arab Al-Ramadin area, prevented several farmers from entering their agricultural land in Kafr Qaddum.

**Salfit:** Israeli settlers damaged 30 vehicles near Za'tara checkpoint.

**Bethlehem:** Israeli forces served demolition orders for two merchant shops in Husan village, Israeli settler chopped off the limbs of several Olive trees in Ein Al-Faris area located in Nihalin.

**Hebron:** Israeli forces demolished several barracks in Um Al-Kheir village, Israeli settler opened fire towards and damaged two vehicles in Beit Ummar and Israeli settlers damaged a vehicle near “Adrwar” settlement.

**Rafah:** Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards and destroyed three fishing boats off the shores of Rafah.

### **The Israeli military served the following Halt to construction and demolition orders for the month of November 2014:**

- The Israeli Military served eviction orders for 14 families in Yarziq village and Ras Al-Ahmar area in Tubas from October 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014 until October 4<sup>th</sup> 2014.
- The Israeli military served an eviction order for a plot of land in east Tubas.
- The Israeli military served demolition orders for six water wells in Qusra village in Nablus.
- The Israeli military served a demolition order for a school in east Yatta in Hebron.
- The Israeli Military served eviction orders for nine families in Ras Al-Ahmar area in Tubas from November 9<sup>th</sup> 2014 until November 11<sup>th</sup> 2014 in order to conduct military training.
- The Israeli Military served halt to construction order for a home in Jit village in Qalqiliya.
- The Israeli Military served a halt to construction order for a road in the area between Attouf village and Khirbeit Al-Ahmar area in Tubas.
- The Israeli Military served demolition order for three barracks in Husan village in Bethlehem.

### **Israeli forces confiscated the following property during the month of November 2014:**

- **Jerusalem:** Israeli forces confiscated a computer from a home in the old city of Jerusalem.
- **Ramallah:** Israeli forces confiscated several Aluminium boards (used for roofing) on mobile home in Al-Taybeh village and confiscated surveillance camera footage from a super market in Deir Ammar.
- **Jenin:** Israeli forces confiscated the Identification card of a National Security Force officer in Bruqin.
- **Tubas:** Israeli forces confiscated a tractor in Attouf village, and a cellular telephone after storming a home in Tamouun.
- **Qalqiliya:** Israeli forces confiscated a vehicle near the east entrance of Qalqiliya and confiscated the Identification card of a resident near the wall gate in Azzun.
- **Nablus:** Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint confiscated a resident Identification Card and Drivers licence.
- **Bethlehem:** Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint confiscated a resident's identification card.
- **Hebron:** Israeli forces confiscated surveillance camera footage from a merchant shop in Al-Urub camp, confiscated a Security force officers identification card near Halhul bridge, confiscated an agricultural tractor in East Yatta, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron confiscated a Photo camera from residents and confiscated a computer after storming a home in Surif.

### ▪ **Settlement Activity:**

Israeli authorities approved plans for the construction of 3 buildings and 71 settlement unites in Har Homa settlement located in south Jerusalem on land

occupied in 1967.

Israeli forces levelled 20 dunumes of land in the area between Bruqin and Kafr Al-Dik and installed several mobile homes. Israeli settlers stormed Immatin village, levelled a plot of land owned by Basem Ghannam in an attempt to expand a settler industrial zone located in Salfit and Israeli Authorities approved the construction of 500 settlement unites in “Ramat Shlomo” settlement located in north Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967.

Israeli forces positioned near “Sal’it” settlement levelled 40 dunumes (acres) of agricultural land in Kafr Qaddum village, which is located behind the wall gate. Israeli Authorities approved the construction of 278 settlement unites (216 in Ramot settlement and 62 in Har Homa settlement located in North and south Jerusalem on Residential land occupied in 1967. Israeli forces levelled a plot of agricultural land near “Nitavim” settlement located in south Qarwat Bani Hassan for the purpose of settlement expansion. Israeli Authorities approved plans for the construction of 200 settlement units in “Ramot” settlement located in North Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967. Israeli authorities approved the construction of 500 settlement unites in “Ramat Shlomo” settlement in north Jerusalem on Palestinian Land occupied in 1967. Israeli Authorities approved plans for the construction of 78 settlement unites (50 of which will be built in “Har Homa” settlement and 28 will be built in “Ramot” settlement) in Jerusalem on Palestinian land occupied in 1967. Israeli forces confiscated 214 dunums of land in Biddu, Beit Surik, Qutna and Ghalous area in Jerusalem. Israeli forces served a military order for the confiscation of 12852 dunumes/acres of land in Beit Ikssa for Military purposes. The Israeli Military served an order for the confiscation of 35.1 dunumes/acres of land in Beit Hanina in Jerusalem. Israeli forces stormed the east area of Burin village and levelled a plot of land owned by Al-Najjar family located near a settlement outpost. Israeli forces confiscated a plot of land located near the road leading to Al-Mahasin and Al-Marouj area’s located in Deir Nathim and placed a sign stating that the area is closed military area.

#### ▪ Settler Violence

103 incidents of Settler violence occurred during the month of November including:

**Jerusalem:** Israeli settlers assaulted and injured 3 residents near Bab Al-Amoud gate in Jerusalem, Israeli settlers assaulted a resident as he was working at Haddassah hospital in Jerusalem, Israeli settlers stabbed 3 residents in Jerusalem, Israeli settlers assaulted school children, attacked a vehicle, ran over a child, assaulted 3 residents, opened fire towards residents in Jerusalem, Israeli settlers stoned resident and vehicle in near Jaba’, attempted to abduct 2 children in Shu’fat, sprayed pepper spray into the face of a vehicle driver near “King George road” in the old city of Jerusalem, An Israeli settler’s vehicle ran over a resident in Al-Tur neighbourhood, assaulted a woman in Jerusalem, Israeli settlers assaulted a child in Jerusalem, Israeli settlers sprayed pepper spray onto the face of a woman and Israeli settlers assaulted school children in the old city of Jerusalem, another resident in Silwan and a resident near Yafa road in the old city of Jerusalem, Israeli settlers assaulted a resident near the French Hills in Jerusalem, An Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured a child in West Jerusalem, Israeli settlers assaulted a resident in Jerusalem, An Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured a child in Jerusalem, Israeli settlers stabbed and injured a resident in Jerusalem, Israeli settlers assaulted a resident in Jerusalem.

**Ramallah:** Israeli settlers stormed the entrance of Burqa village and attacked a vehicle owned by Mohammad Moutan and as a result damaged the vehicle, a group of Israeli settlers positioned along the main road located near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp near “Bet El” Settlement assaulted Ghassan Abu Raes (A resident of Balata camp in Nablus) and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions, Israeli settlers closed the main road connecting Deir Ibzi’ and Kafr Ni’meh villages thus preventing residents and vehicles from passing through from both ends then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces, Israeli settlers positioned at the bypass road near “Ofrat” settlement chanted anti-Arab slogans, a group of Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles near the entrance of “Halamish” settlement

**Tubas:** Israeli settlers chased away several Sheppard’s as they were herding their sheep near “Miskiyout” settlement.

**Nablus:** Israeli settlers positioned near Burin village set fire to a home owned by Ghalib Al-Najjar and stoned several other homes, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Burin village, stoned several residents during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents as they attempted to prevent the

settler attack then the settlers withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces, , Israeli settlers positioned near “Yitsahar” settlement stormed Burin village, provoked several residents by picking Olives off trees owned by Palestinians then withdrew, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Huwara checkpoint and attacked residents and vehicles as they were passing through the checkpoint under the protection of Israeli forces, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Orif village , stoned a local school during local residents were able to chase the settlers away and Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Bithan village and entered “Al-Tahouneh Park”.

**Qalqiliya:** Israeli settler positioned near “Karni Shamron” settlement opened random fire in the area, Israeli settlers assaulted a resident in Al-Nabi Eliyas village and Israeli settlers attempted to abduct a resident in Al-Funduq village and stormed agricultural land in Kafr Laqif village.

**Salfit:** Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing through Za'tara checkpoint and an Israeli settler vehicle ran over resident near “Burqan” settlement.

**Jericho:** Israeli settlers from “Feroth Yarihu” settlement pumped sewage waste from the settlement in to Wadi Qult area located in central Jericho.

**Bethlehem:** An Israeli settler vehicle ran over a resident at the entrance of Beit Jallah, Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles near Nihalin village, Israeli settlers chopped off the limbs of several Olive trees in Ein Al-Faris area located in Nihalin, Israeli settlers closed the main road leading to Kafr Etsiyon” settlement, stoned residents and vehicles in the area located between Husan village and Nihalin, stoned vehicles passing near “Ifrat” settlement, stoned residents and vehicles at the entrance of Husan village and stoned residents and vehicles near Kafr Etsiyon” settlement, an Israeli settler vehicles attempted to run over a resident near Al-Kahdr, Israeli settlers levelled a plot of land near Khilat Nakhalah area in Irtas village and stormed Al-Walaja village.

**Hebron:** Israeli settler stormed agricultural land in Halhul, opened fire towards a vehicle at the entrance of Beit Ummar, stoned residents and vehicles near “Adora” settlement, stoned a home and several resident near “Hadgi” settlement , stoned residents and vehicles near Beit Awwa, Israeli settlers attempted to abduct a child near the entrance of “Nogohot” settlement, stoned residents and vehicles near Farsh Al-Hawa area, provoked several residents and attempted to storm a school in near AlO-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron.

#### ▪ **Closure of Crossing Points**

The Israeli military completely closed crossing points into the Gaza Strip, including access points within the Green Line, on **162** occasions during the month of November. The Israeli military closed crossing points within the Green Line on **105** occasions. It opened ***Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing*** for 23 days for previously-coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals and ***Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing*** for **22** days for transportation of food supplies, humanitarian aid, and cooking gas. In addition to allowing in animal feed, construction cargo designated for UNRWA and internationally-funded projects was transported through the Crossing. ***Sufa Crossing*** was closed throughout the month. On the other hand, the Israeli authorities have continued to unilaterally close ***Ash Shuja'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing***. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Israeli authorities has also continued to completely close ***Al Muntar (Karnei) Commercial Crossing***.

The Israeli military closed international crossing points on **57** occasions. ***Rafah Crossing*** was open for 3 days to allow access to civilians departing the Gaza Strip and to those arriving from Egypt. ***Yasser Arafat International Airport*** has remained closed since the outbreak of the second *Intifada*.
