JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 12:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Beit Iksa military checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic and prevented residents from entering or leaving the area. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram until 10:40. (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Rafat village, clashed with several residents as they demolished a home owned by Samer Ghazalneh (consisting of a bed room and a bathroom) for allegedly being built without a licence and as a result Israeli forces uprooted several grape vines and demolished a concrete wall built around the property then withdrew at 14:00. (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 02:00. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On April 28th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Mikabir and forced Eyad Bashar to demolish a portion of his home and imposed a financially penalty on him for allegedly building without a licence. (ii) On the morning of April 29th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Tur in Jerusalem and demolished 2 barracks (Dens) which houses 7 residents and is owned by Mohammad Sulami and detained 2 residents as they attempted to prevent the demolition from taking place. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Omar Al-Muslamani and Ibrahim Al-Shuki in stormed Jabal Al-Tur in Jerusalem. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood temporarily detained Nadin Al-Gharali (16 years old school girl) then released her at a later time. • <u>Attack:</u> At 07:00 on April 27th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Zaytoun checkpoint located at the east entrance of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they were waiting to cross the checkpoint. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:30, Israeli settlers escorted by several Israeli Intelligence and Police officers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshiper and Israeli forces confiscated several Al Aqsa mosque school students Identification cards and prevented them from entering the mosque.. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Jenin. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Silat Al-Thaher and Al-Funduqiya village. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, stormed and searched several homes, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 04:50. (iv) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya until 05:30 • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Ysef Al-Qalq, Mohammad Abu Salah, and Firasd Abu Bakr in Ya’bad, • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:55, Israeli forces raided Beit Lid until 22:30.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 17:00. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Jinsafut village located near the road connecting Qalqiliya and Salfit until 21:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village, stormed 7 homes, detained 5 residents and summoned Harith Baraham to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 5 residents: Mustafa Ishtawi, Murad Ishtawi, Ahmad Ishtawi, Wi'am Barham and Raslan Jum'a in Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit junction until 11:10. (ii) At 15:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Shave Shomron" settlement junction until 16:20. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Harris village until 20:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 06:30, Israeli forces raided Harris village took photographs of several homes including Layth Odehs home then withdrew at 07:00. (ii) At 07:30, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harris. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 08:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village, served demolition orders to demolish 5 homes owned by Mohammad Ebiyat, Sami Rashaydeh, Ahmad Ebiyat, Adnan Nuwara, and Saddam Nuwara and a merchant shop owned by Awad Nuwara giving him 7 days for implementation. (ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village, stormed a home, temporarily detained Ahmad Sa'aydeh and released him after questioning then withdrew at 00:25. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On April 29th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Sameh Mara'beh (a Member of the Palestinian Soccer Team) as he was returning from training camp in Qatar. (ii) On April 29th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained 2

<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou' until 13:00. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Nihalin village until 18:00. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 13:20, Israeli forces temporarily seized several construction Machines owned by Al-Tarifi Company as they were working on road rehabilitation construction in Husan village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to

closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at Halhul bridge, Beit Anun village junction and Al-Fuwar camp until 10:00.
- (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge.
- (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Shalashelh road in the old city of Hebron.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Fikhat village in south Yatta, took photographs of a school under threat of demolition and verbally ordered Ibrahim Makhamreh to demolish his stent and a livestock shed for allegedly being an environmentally protected site then withdrew at 12:30.
- (ii) At 13:30 and again at 23:45, Israeli forces raided Nuba and set up a checkpoint in front of Palestinian Police headquarters.
- (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 04:55.
- (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed several homes, detained 4 students (3 University students and 1 High school student), stormed a bakery shop, temporarily detained its workers then withdrew at a later time.

- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Nur Sabarna, Yusef Sabarna, Mohammad Arrar and Omar Al-Alamy in Beit Ummar.

- **Demonstration:** At 10:00, a demonstration took place in front the International Red Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
