#### WEST BANK

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North junction of Al-Ram.
- (ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Khan Al-Ahmar area located along the main road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho and detained a resident.

#### • <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At dawn on December 8<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained a resident.
- (ii) At dawn on December 8<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and detained a resident.
- (iii) At 11:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 11:50.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained five residents including a child.

#### • Detention:

- (i) At dawn on December 8<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Munthir Obada and Ali Obada in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood.
- (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa in Al-Tur neighbourhood.
- (iii) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained Tarik Nimr in Sur Bahar village.

#### **JERUSALEM**

- (iv) At 00:30, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Ghol (A University student) in Silwan neighbourhood.
- (v) Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint in Al-Khan Al-Ahmar area located along the main road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho detained Idris Shihadeh (A resident of Al-Jaderah).
- (vi) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Bakr (16 years old) in Al-Eisawiya village.
- (vii)Israeli forces detained Mohammad Halabiya in Abu Dis.
- (viii) Israeli forces detained five residents: Malik Abdel-Jawad (14 years old), Mohammad Abdel-Jawad (15 years old), Mahmoud Aliyan, and Mahmoud Ibrahim near the entrance of Anata.
- Expulsion: On December 8<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli military authorities served Zaynab Omar (A teacher at Al-Aqsa mosque school) {a resident of Jerusalem} an expulsion order preventing her from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 3 months.
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> On December 8<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces stormed Sur Bahar village and served demolition orders for two homes owned by Mohammad Amiereh and Madhouh Al-Qarut for allegedly being built without a licence and served demolition orders for several homes in Silwan.
- <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of December 8<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshiper by conducting Talmudic rituals.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 08:00, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted two residents: Mu'tasim Shawki and Shadi Al-Manshi as they were at a gas station near "Karem Abu Salem" Haddassa hospital and as a result left them hospitalised with contusions.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Illu village.
- (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Safa village until 22:00.
- **Raid:** At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 01:35.

#### Attack:

- (i) At 15:45 and again at 19:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Nathim village, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:15, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Pesagout settlement located in east Al-Bireh city stoned the home of Khaled Shahin.

- (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou', clashed with several residents and occupied Sa'ed Musa's home and converted its rooftop into a military post.
- (ii) At 22:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya until 24:00.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and

- (i) At 09:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Farsh Al-Hawa area located in North Hebron until 10:40
- (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at the main road near Hadgi settlement located in South Hebron until 16:10.
- (iii)At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Fahs area located in south Hebron until 15:25.
- (iv)At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna until 17:20.

- At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire and launching tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza and Khan Yunis.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza

### NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
- <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of December 8<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of West Beit Lahiya.
