## WEST BANK

## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) On 14 December 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) Israeli forces continue to close the hill between Biddo and Beit Iksa villages and deny civilian access.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
  - (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. At 22:40, Israeli forces closed Qalandiya checkpoint claiming unidentified persons have opened fire towards Israeli soldiers positioned at the checkpoint.
  - (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying checkpoints:**
  - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Khal Al-Ahmar area and impeded free flow of traffic.
  - (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the junction of al-ram town and searched civilians and vehicles.
- **Raids:**
  - (i) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Anata town, stormed and searched 1 civilian home and arrested 1 civilian.
  - (ii) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis town and patrolled it until 05:20.
  - (iii) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Shu'fat refugee camp, clashed with civilians and withdrew at 04:20.
- **Arrests:**
  - (i) On 14 December 2015, Israeli forces arrested 3 children in Bab Hutta (one of the gates leading to Al-Aqsa Mosque) in the old city of Jerusalem: Tamer Amjad Al-Basiti, 17, Mohammad Shaker Salim, 17, and Mohammad Abed Abu Sneineh, 16.
  - (ii) On 14 December 2015, Israeli forces arrested 4 civilians from Qalandya: Hassan Youssef Ghazal, Ibrahim Zuheir Zayed, Seif Mohammad Abu Latife

	<p>and Mohammad Abdel Rahman Hazin.</p> <p>(iii) On 14 December 2015, Israeli forces arrested civilian Mohammad Hassan Khalayleh from Jabal Al-Mukaber neighbourhood in Jerusalem.</p> <p>(iv) On 14 December 2015, Israeli forces arrested civilian Ahmad Samir Mteir from Izariyye town.</p> <p>(v) The civilian arrested in Anata town is Loai Saleh Nimer Abdel Jawad.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Killings:</u></b> At 15:00, Israeli forces shot dead civilian Abdel Muhsen Shaher Hassouneh, 21, while he was driving his car, for allegedly running over 10 Jewish settlers in Jerusalem (according to Israeli claims).</li> <li>• <b><u>Injuries:</u></b> At 10:45, Israeli forces positioned near Zayem village physically attacked civilian Mohammad Ismail Khalil Khamayseh from Taffouh in Hebron city causing him serious injuries.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attacks:</u></b> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Hizma fired tear gas canisters and stun grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attacks on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 08:00, Jewish settlers backed up by Israeli forces raided the compound of Al-Aqsa Mosque and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
