JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local

- residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
 - **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - **Flying Checkpoints:**
 - (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu.
 - (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Khan Al-Hamra area located along the main road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho and detained a resident.
 - **Raids:** At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village, clashed with its residents and detained a child.
 - **Home Demolition:**
 - (i) At 05:00 on February 5th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Dam area in Beit Hanina and demolished a 65m² home owned by Mohammad Sanduqa for allegedly being built without a licence.
 - (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem and demolished an 85m² home owned by Khaled Bashir for allegedly being built without a licence and fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the demolition and as a result injured Mohammad Bashir.
 - (iii) On February 5th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem and forces Maher Mashahra to demolish his home and imposed a hefty financial penalty for allegedly being built without a licence.
 - (iv) On February 5th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Sur Baher and demolished Mujahid Sarhans home for allegedly being built without a licence.
 - **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 09:00, group Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) On February 5th 2014, Israeli forces detained and assaulted Khalid Al-Zir in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Mus'ab Badir, a resident of Abu Dis in Al-Khan A-Hamra area located along the main road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho.
 - (iii) Israeli forces detained Khalil Jarah (17 years old) in Al-Isawiya village.
 - **Settlement Activity:** On February 5th 2014, Israeli authorities approved plans for the construction of 349 settlement unites (223 new settlement unites in "Har Homa" settlement located in south Jerusalem, 102 new settlement unites in "Navi Yacoub" settlement and 24 new settlement unites in "Pisgat Zaiif" settlement both located in north Jerusalem) on land occupied in 1967.
 - **Wall Gates:**

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge until 21:20. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:55, Israeli forces Al-Bireh city and confiscated keys for a vehicle owned by Shadi Al-Amsawi (A National Intelligence Officer) then withdrew at a later time. (ii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Rantis, stormed and searched 2 homes then withdrew at 04:00. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beit Liqya fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On February 5th 2014, Israeli settlers stormed Turmus'aya and assaulted Imad Al-Joulani, a resident of Jerusalem as he was driving a cement truck in the area and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 22:15, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing along the main road leading to Al-Jalazoun camp. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Flying Checkpoint: At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Yamoun junction until 17:30. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on February 5th 2014, Israeli forces raided Kafr Jamal village, stormed a home and summoned Mo’ayad Abdel Rahim to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 11:00 and again at 01:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Shwikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem stormed 2 vehicle spare parts shops, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 05:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Eid Salisi in Al-Shwikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned near “Eniv” settlement temporarily detained 4 residents including 2 children: Jamal Barhoush (16 years old), Anwar Barhoush (16 years old), Osama Barhoush and Ala Barhoush as they were herding their sheep then released them at a later time. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Sinariya and Beit Amin villages. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces raided immatin village, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning. (ii) At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed a coffee shop, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 00:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Oday Hussien and Ahmad Salim in Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Dajjan village junction. (ii) At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sarah village until 10:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Huwara, stormed and searched several homes home, blew up the main entrance of a home owned by Murad Odeh using explosive and detained 6 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:10, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Lu’ay Dweikat (17 years old), Salem Hamayel (17 years old) and Bashir Dweikat in Yatma village. (ii) Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Suliman Abu Shihadeh, kARAM Dumidi, Abdul Hamid Dumidi, Murad Odeh, Khader Odeh Khader, and Abdul-Latif Dumid in Huwara. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On February 5th 2014, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Aqraba and chopped off the limbs of 100 Olive trees owned by Izzat Al-Masri. (ii) At 16:05, an Israeli settler driving a vehicle stormed Huwara and ran over: Taysir Omron, a resident of Deir Al-Hatab in Nablus leaving him hospitalised with contusions.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Harris village until 11:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:45, Israeli forces raided Bruqin until 15:30. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:40 and again at 00:55, Israeli forces raided Jericho, stormed a home, detained a resident, confiscated an agricultural tractor owned by Ibrahim Damarat then withdrew at 04:15. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Damarat in Jericho. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:25, a demonstration took place in front of the International

	<p>Red Cross headquarters in Jericho in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.</p>
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Shawashra village junction. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the

(iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road leading to "Haji" settlement. • <u>Raid:</u> At 08:30 and again at 17:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron while escorting a group of Israeli settlers as they stormed Haram Ramat Well then withdrew at a later time during which Israeli forces set up a checkpoint and detained a resident • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mu'tasim Al-Atrash in Hebron. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned in Tal'at Abu Hadid, Jaroun and Jarrad areas in the old city of Hebron fired tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza and Khan Yunis.
