<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint, which is located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho, impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it later. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on January 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained three children. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three children: Mohammad Abu Al-Hummus (14 years old), Naddim Al-Saffadi (14 years old) and Qusay Dari (14 years old) in Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Wad road in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 18:50 on January 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the area between Al-Mughier village and a by pas road and the main road between Al-Mughier and Duma villages with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit until 19:00. (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, stormed a home and a Coffee shop then detained a resident. (ii) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Awarta. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Tamer Al-Dolah in Beituniya. (ii) Israeli forces detained Sharif Hamad in Silwad. • <u>Injury:</u> At 17:15 on January 10th 2015, the child Rawiya Sawalha (12 years old) was injured after Israeli settlers stoned their vehicles near “Bet El” settlement (As mentioned in the previous report). • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Nathim village temporarily detained Mohammad Atta (A resident of Deir Abu Mash’al) then released him after questioning at 16:45.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces raided Kafrit village then withdrew at 11:00. (ii) At 11:15, Israeli forces raided the Industrial Zone in Jenin until 11:30. (iii) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Zahrat Al-Finjan area near Kafr Ra’I and inspected several water wells. (iv) At 17:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Taybeh village, stormed a home and detained three residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Hadi Ghaliyoun, Ahmad Ighbariya and Mahmoud Ighbariya in Al-Taybeh village.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned at Tayassir checkpoint temporarily detained Radad Daraghmeh (A resident of Tubas) then released him at 18:55.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Nazlat Issa village, occupied Issam Zabans home and converted its rooftop into a Military post after temporarily detaining its residents in a room then withdrew at 12:00

QALQILIYA

- **Closure of Roads:**
 - (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.
 - (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.
 - (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 12:00 and again at 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 20:40.
 - (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sir village until 18:20.
 - (iii) At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Jayyus Bridge (located along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Tulkerem) until 22:25.
 - (iv) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, impeded the free flow of traffic after closing main the steel gate entrance then reopened it later.
 - (v) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabin impeded the free flow of traffic after closing main the steel gate entrance then reopened it at 21:10.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 18:10, Israeli forces raided Azzun until 19:00.
 - (ii) At 05:20, Israeli forces raided Jayyus until 05:50.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 18:00 on January 10th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in the area between Izbit Al-Tabib and Asalah villages fired stun grenades.
 - (ii) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned in the West area of Jayyus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
 - (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00 on January 10th 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Aqraba junction. (ii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bardala village junction until 19:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30 and again at 01:30, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Shimaliya, stormed several homes, detained five residents then withdrew at 05:15. (ii) At dawn on January 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Askar camp in Nablus and detained a resident after storming his home. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained five residents: Osama Al-Shouli, Oba’y Yassin, Mohammad Al-Shouli, Amir Hamadnah and Qaddi Hamadnah. (ii) Israeli forces detained Yassin Abu Falah in Askar camp.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 01:00 on January 2nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 18:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 19:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya and detained two residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Salam Abu Hajlah and Wissam Abu Hijleh in Deir Istiya. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Yasuf village near “Kafar Tubah” settlement and uprooted 60 Olive trees.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou', temporarily detained Yahya Al-Amour (A National Security Force Officer) then released him at 16:55.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Khirbiet Al-Dir village near Taqou', stormed a home (under construction) then withdrew at 13:20.
 - (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, summoned 3 residents: Mohammad Taqatqaa, Zaki Dariya and Mohammad Thawabteh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 07:00.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Karmil village.
 - (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ithna junction.
 - (iii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Karmil village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 19:10.
 - (ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Shaikh neighbourhood in Hebron, stormed and searched several homes and merchant shops.
 - (iii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home then withdrew at 01:45.
 - (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou', stormed two homes and detained five residents.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained 5 residents: Sanad Al-Badarin, Zaher Al-Mahariq, Mohammad Salamin, Mus'ab Al-Salamin and Qusay AL-Salamin in AL-Samou'.

GAZA STRIP

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
