All Districts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> On July 20th 2014, President of the State of Palestine Mahmoud Abbas declared 3 days of mourning in memory of the 72 civilians killed by Israeli forces in Al-Shuja'iya neighbourhood in Gaza city for all Governmental Institutions in the country and abroad. Also a District wide strike closing all shops in protest of the Israeli Assault on the Gaza strip.
JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the

- entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - **Attack:**
 - (i) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of Al-Ram, Bir Nabala, Qutna village, in the vicinity of Qalandiya and Shu'fat checkpoints and located near Abu Dis and Bab Al-Amoud area in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents and detained 2 residents in Abu Dis.
 - (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata, Biddu, Al-Eisawiya villages, on Salah Al-Din road and in Silwan and Al-Tur neighbourhood's and at Al-Zaytoun checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents and detained 5 residents including a child in Anata, Salah Al-Din road and Silwan neighbourhood.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) At dawn on July 2nd 2014, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Khawis (A resident of Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood) as he was receiving medical treatment in Al-Makassid Hospital.
 - (ii) At dawn on July 17th 2014, Israeli forces detained four residents: Abed Abu Sbieh, Amjad Abu Sbieh, Salah Abu Nab and Khaled Qanbar in Silwan neighbourhood.
 - (iii) At dawn on July 18th 2014, Israeli forces detained Jihad Al-Jamal in Beit Suriq village.
 - (iv) At dawn on July 19th 2014, Israeli forces detained Billal Al-Shiekh in Al-Ram.
 - (v) At dawn on July 20th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Hizma village detained three residents including two children: Bara' Yacoub (16 years old), Mohammad Fahidat (16 years old) and Abdel-Hafath Al-Kahtib.
 - (vi) At 17:30, Israeli forces detained two residents: Tariq Sarur and Aboud Abu Sbieh in the old city of Jerusalem.
 - (vii) Israeli forces detained Rami Allariya and Nabil Juhar in Abu Dis.
 - (viii) Israeli forces detained five residents: Mohammad Al-Hudari (16 years old), Fadi Maraghat, Amjad Khalifeh, Mus'ab Al-Nabali and Tarik Al-Zaraba.
 - **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the areas north and south

	of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Izbie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a resident. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrances of "Bet El" and "Pesagout" settlements located in north and east of Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured six residents including a child. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Ni'lin fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured a resident. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Ra'i until 04:00. (ii) At 05:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ma'moun Farihat in Al-Yamoun. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Zubaba village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bardalah village.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) At 09:40, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near "Evni Heves" settlement. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Lid junction until 16:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Baqa Al-Sharqiya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several home and residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned near “Ashour” factories in west Tulkarem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 18 residents including five children.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. (iv) At 19:50, Israeli forces closed the dirt road leading to the north entrance of Jinsafut with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:00 and again at 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 00:20. • <u>Attack:</u> At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 23:30, Israeli settler positioned near “Qadumin” settlement stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction until 16:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 01:30, Israeli forces positioned near Qusra village fired rubber coated

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to tw9 detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 02:20. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Yasuf village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Qarwat Bani Hassan fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan

- area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Al-Khadr Bridge until 12:00.
 - (ii) At 00:20, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar until 01:00.
 - (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Faradis village junction until 01:00.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 15:30 and 02:55, Israeli forces raided Husan village and detained three residents.
 - (ii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and stormed a home.
 - (iii) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Wadi Fuqin village, stormed a home then withdrew at 01:00.
 - (iv) At 04:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, detained 3 residents including a Security force officer and assaulted three other residents.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) Israeli forces detained three residents: Firas Sbatin, Mohammad Sbatin and Hassan Sbatin.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Nur Sarour (a Security force officer), Ahmad Yusef and Khalil Abu Sarour.
 - **Attack:**
 - (i) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near a checkpoint located near Billal Bin Rabah mosque in Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 12 residents.
 - (ii) At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents.
 - (iii) At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Dar Salah village located in east Beit Sahur, near Al-Khader and at the entrance of Husan village, fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - **Settler Violence:** At 23:15, Israeli settler positioned near Al-Walaja village stoned residents and vehicles then proceeded to storm the home of Ibrahim Al-Araj then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 01:00.
 - **Wall Construction:**
 - (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
 - (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
 - (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents occupied two homes owned by Abdel Aziz Abu Ayash and Jamal Al-Alami and converted their rooftops into military post. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Awa fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron, at the entrances of Beit Ummar and Al-Urub camp, at Halhul bridge, near Al-Nabi Yunis area and near Khursa , AL-Tabaqa and Zif villages fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as result injured 35 residents. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease-fire. • On November 14th 2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire and launching tank Artillery shells towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah .Tank Artillery fire target several mosques and Beit Hanoun hospital • Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 200
