#### WEST BANK

#### **Closure:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints set up at entrances to the city of Jerusalem and Al Agsa Mosque.
- On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order (ii) # S/02/09 closing the seam line area, an extension of the Wall.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian (iii) access to a hill located in an area between the villages of Biddu and Beit Iksa.

#### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt (i) barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al Bareed in Jerusalem city from the town of Ar Ram.

#### **Checkpoints:**

- The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint (i) a "border crossing point" and only allows holders of Jerusalem IDs to access the city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) As of 11 April 2010, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up near the entrance to Shu'fat refugee camp in the city of Jerusalem and prevent daily civilian traffic access from 23:00 until 05:00. The closure of the checkpoint will continue for a week and half under the pretext of maintenance and setting up an infrastructure between the checkpoint and the road leading to Shu'fat refugee camp.
- Raid: At dawn on 10 May 2010, the Israeli army raided the town of Abu Dis and searched 2 houses.
- **Settler Violence:** At 14:30, a group of Israeli settlers protected by the Israeli army raided Silwan neighborhood in Jerusalem city, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas bombs towards civilians attempting to confront the settler attack and arrested 2 civilians.
- Arrests: The Israeli army arrested in the neighborhood of Silwan in the city of Jerusalem the civilians Adel Ash-Shobaki and Muhammad Mousa Odeh.

#### **Wall Gates:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall (ii) gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

#### **JERUSALEM**

	• Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of al-Jib village, in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna, south of Beit Hanina village, and in the area surrounding the checkpoint set up at the entrance to Shu'fat refugee camp.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Roads: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village, Safa village and the junction to the villages of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiya.</li> <li>On 15 March 2010, the Israeli army issued military order declaring the area located between civilian houses and the Wall in the town of Ni'lin and the village of Bil'in as closed military zones from 08:00 until 20:00 every Friday and for a period of 6 months. Civilian access is denied during the mentioned period without a special permit in order to prevent the weekly demonstrations against the Wall.</li> <li>Flving Checkpoint: At 09:05, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction leading to Ras Karkar village and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>Raids: <ol> <li>At 11:20, the Israeli army raided the village of Bil'in, set up a flying checkpoint at its entrance and patrolled the area.</li> <li>At 01:55, the Israeli army raided the village of Mazari' An-Nubani and served summon to a civilian to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency.</li> <li>Settler Violence: At 11:00, a group of about 200 armed Israeli settlers who were protected by the Israeli army raided the towns of Turmus'ayya, Sinjil and Al Mazra'a Ash Sharqiya and the villages of Kafr Malik and Deir Jarir. Confrontations took place with civilians while attempting to confront the settler attacks in the town of Al Mazra'a Ash Sharqiya and the village of Kafr Malik. They withdrew at 12:55.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the towns and villages of 'Abud and Bil'in, and in the areas of al-Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.</li> </ol> </li> </ol></li></ul>
JENIN	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to 'Arraba town, east of the settlement of Dotan.</li> <li>Raids: <ol> <li>At 23:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled 'Arraba town until 02:00.</li> <li>At 01:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Jaba', searched 2 houses and arrested a civilian.</li> <li>At 03:30, the Israeli army raided Sanur village and patrolled the area.</li> <li>Arrest: The Israeli army arrested in the town of Jaba' the civilian Waseem Wajih Said Abu 'Oun.</li> <li>Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.</li> </ol> </li></ul>

TOUBAS	<ul> <li><u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint, east of the city of Tubas, allowing civilian access from 06:00 to 22:00.</li> <li><u>Destruction of Property</u>: At 11:00, fire broke out and destroyed large area of grazing land in the area of Wadi Al Malih in the Northern Jordan Valley as a result of training with live ammunition by the Israeli army in the area.</li> </ul>
TULKAREM	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr Al Labad and the village of Shofeh and the road between the villages of Shofeh and Izbat Shofeh.</li> <li>Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarm-Nablus main road.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoint: At 18:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the towns of Attil and Deir Al Ghusun and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>Raids: <ol> <li>At 11:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarm. Again at 02:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area.</li> <li>At 18:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the neighborhood of Shuweika in the city of Tulkarm.</li> <li>Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.</li> </ol> </li></ul>
QALQILYA	<ul> <li>Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoint: At 21:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the village of Jit and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>Raids: <ol> <li>At 09:30, the Israeli army raided the villages of Hajja and Al Funduq and stormed a number of shops for repairing vehicles.</li> <li>At 01:15, the Israeli army raided Qalqiliya and arrested a civilian.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Arrests: <ol> <li>At 15:15, the Israeli army arrested near the village of Magharet Ad Dabe' 12 workers travelling in a passenger bus as they were attempting to enter Israel for work. They included the bus driver Na'el Ibrahim Odeh.</li> <li>The Israeli army arrested in the city of Qalqiliya the civilian Mujahed Isam Noufal.</li> <li>Military Post: At 13:20, the Israeli army erected 3 tents on the dirt road that connects the town of Jayyus to the village of An Nabi Elias. A number of Israeli soldiers maintained presence inside the tents.</li> <li>Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

	Wall Construction: Wall construction continues south of the town of Jayyus as well as near the settlement of Alfeh Minesheh in the villages of Ras Tira, Magharet Ad Dab'a and Wadi Ar Rasha, located south of Qalqiliya city.
NABLUS	Closure of Main Roads:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the roads of Tel-Burin, Beit Furik-Salem, and the eastern entrance to the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya; and with dirt barricades the southern entrance to the village of Duma, the eastern entrance to the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya, the western entrances to the town of Aqraba and the village of Majdal Bani Fadil, the northern entrance to the town of Qabalan, as well as the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to Alon Moreh settlement.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to close by an iron gate the western entrance to An Naqura village, opposite Shavi Shomron settlement.  (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut and the road connecting the town of Aqraba to the village of Osarin.  (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the side road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin.  Checkpoints:  (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only from 07:00 until 02:00.  (ii) Awarta commercial checkpoint is open for civilians from 05:00 until 20:00 and on Friday from 05:00 until 15:00.  Fiving Checkpoint: At 11:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Qabalan and searched civilians and vehicles.  Raids:  (i) At dawn on 11 May 2010, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya, searched a house and arrested a civilian.  (ii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Aqraba and arrested 3 civilians.  Arrests:  (i) The Israeli army arrested in the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya the civilian Ahmad Muhammad Isma'il Daraghmeh.  (ii) The Israeli army arrested in the town of Aqraba the civilians: Ala' Jamal Deiriyeh; Ahmad Wasfi Deiriyeh; and Adel Ghaleb Naser Bani Jaber.
SALFIT	<ul> <li><u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the northern entrance to the city of Salfit, and continues to close with cement blocks and iron gates the northern entrance to the town of Bruqin and the western entrance to the town of Kafr Ad Dik.</li> <li><u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impede civilian access.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Raid: At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Hares, searched a number of houses, arrested 10 civilians, including 2 children, and served summons to 2 civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency.</li> <li>Arrests: The Israeli army arrested in the village of Hares: Hadi Sabir Souf, 17-year-old; Nadi Eitimad Souf, 17-year-old; Abdallah Othman Dawoud; Samer Ayyad Souf; Qusay Naser Kleib; Rabi' Ali Kleib; Ziyad Muhammad Hasan 'Adasi; Baha' Ramzi Sultan; Sufyan Waleed Othman Dawoud; and Hasan Muhammad 'Adasi.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.</li> </ul>
JERICHO	<ul> <li>Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks.</li> <li>Checkpoints: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at al-Hamra checkpoint and allow civilian access from 06:00 until 22:00.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja and allow access only to civilians holding Jericho and Jordan Valley IDs and those possessing permits.</li> <li>Flving Checkpoint: At 09:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho. Again at 20:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles until 01:00.</li> <li>Raid: At 18:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Al Auja.</li> <li>Arrest: On 11 May 2010, the Israeli army arrested at Al Karama (Allenby) checkpoint the civilian Anwar Zaki Najib Zein from the town of Qaffin upon returning from Jordan.</li> </ol> </li></ul>
BETHLEHEM	<ul> <li>Closure: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to prevent civilian access to an area that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.</li> <li>Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad, the sideway east of Beit Fajjar town and the agricultural road that is located between the town of Taqu'a and the village of Khirbet Al Baq'a.</li> <li>Flving Checkpoint: At 22:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit Fajjar and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>Arrest: At 02:20 on 11 May 2010, the Israeli army arrested during a raid on the village of Husan, in addition to what has been mentioned in the previous report, the civilian Muhammad Khaleel Atiyeh Shousheh.</li> </ol> </li></ul>

	• <u>Wall Construction</u> : Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khadr and Beit Jala city; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of
	Ephrata settlement; and in the area surrounding al-Walaja village.
HEBRON	Closure:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to al Laban Market by iron boards. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the area located near the Green Line, south of Yatta town, evacuating the area of those inside it and denying them access to it.  Closure of Main Roads:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp; the village of At Tuwani as well as the entrance to the town of Adh Dhahiriya.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.  (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60.  Flying Checkpoints:  (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Idhna and searched civilians and vehicles.  At 16:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the juncti

- (ii) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided an area near Al Fawwar refugee camp and served notices for demolishing 4 houses under the pretext of not being licensed and because they are located in area C which falls under Israeli control.
- (iii) At 18:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Ummar. Confrontations took place with civilians while searching a number of houses. As a result, 15-year-old child Nour Muhammad Az Za'aqiq was injured.
- (iv) At 23:30, the Israeli army raided the village of At-Tabaqa and searched 2 houses.
- (v) At 03:25, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Ula and arrested a civilian.
- (vi) At 07:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Adh Dhahiriya.

#### • Arrests:

- (i) At 22:00, the Israeli army arrested 15-year-old child Iyhab Nu'man Abdulhafez Abu Sneineh as he reported to the Israeli Intelligence agency upon a prior summon.
- (ii) The Israeli army arrested in the town of Beit Ula the civilian Ahmad Muhammad Hasan Al 'Adarbeh.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, in the periphery of Eshkolot settlement southwest of Adh Dhahiriya town and between southwest of Arab Ar Ramadin village and the village of Imneizil.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

#### ALL DISTRICTS

- At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the Israeli army declared a unilateral ceasefire. In the meantime, armed Palestinian groups declared a one-week-long ceasefire. Meanwhile, the ceasefire was extended until 05 February 2009. The ceasefire is holding despite the end of the specified period.
- The Israeli army violated the ceasefire by raiding Palestinian territory and opening fire intensively in Rafah. Israeli navy boats also opened machinegun fire intensively towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea in the districts of Northern Gaza and Rafah.

#### NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open for previously coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals.
- <u>Attack</u>: In the morning of 11 May 2010, Israeli navy boats opened machinegun fire intensively towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea opposite As-Sudaniya area beach that is located west of Beit Lahiya town.

	• <u>Demonstration</u> : On 11 May 2010, a mass demonstration, with the participation of international peace activists, took place near Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing, north of Beit Hanun town. The demonstration was against the buffer zone near the border fence where the Israeli army deny farmers and land owners access and cultivation.
GAZA	<ul> <li>Closure of Crossing Points:         <ul> <li>Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is partially open for the transport of wheat and fodder.</li> <li>Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing for fuel transport is closed since 04 January 2010 by an Israeli unilateral decision.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

RAFAH	<ul> <li>Closure of Crossing Points: <ol> <li>Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.</li> <li>Rafah (Al Awdah) Crossing is closed.</li> <li>Sufa Crossing is closed.</li> <li>Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transport of food, humanitarian assistance, a quantity of industrial diesel for the electricity plant and cooking gas.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Raid: In the evening of 11 May 2010, the Israeli army, including a number of armored vehicles and bulldozers covered by reconnaissance aircrafts, raided Palestinian territory east of Ash Shoka town, opened fire intensively towards civilian agricultural land and houses and leveled areas of agricultural land.</li> <li>Attack: At 22:00 on 10 May 2010, Israeli navy boats opened machinegun fire intensively towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea opposite Rafah city beach. Israeli navy boats opened machinegun fire again at dawn on 11 May 2010.</li> </ul>
