JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continue to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City for Friday prayers. The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. Checkpoints: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:50 and again 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Atara bridge, fired tear gas and stun grenades towards demonstrators for alleged stoning leaving several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation and detained a child from Au Qash village. • <u>Raid:</u> On November 14th 2012, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village detained 2 residents including a child and summoned Obeida Al-Tamimi, Saber Al-Tamimi and Yazan Al-Rimawi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned near Sinjil fired tear gas and stun grenades towards demonstrators for alleged stoning leaving them suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 11:40. Israeli forces positioned near Al-Nabi Saleh village junction fired tear gas and stun grenades towards demonstrators for alleged stoning leaving them suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near Beitin village, fired tear gas and stun grenades towards demonstrators for alleged stoning leaving them suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iv) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Ofar military base fired rubber coated steel bullets, tear gas and stun grenades towards demonstrators injuring Ameer AlRamahi and leaving several other suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Biyabna (16 years) near Atara bridge. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Tamimi (15 years) and Nabil Al-Tamimi in Deir Nathim village. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 19:10, a demonstration took place in Ramallah protesting Israeli military aggression towards Gaza. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 11:00, the Israeli army closed on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and reopened it at a later time.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 08:00, The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Quffin village junction until 20:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the eastern entrance of Qalqiliya, prevented the flow of traffic after closing the entrance, fired tear gas grenades towards demonstrators leaving them suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (iii) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village. (iv) At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Izbit A-Tabib village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:15, Israeli forces raided Azzun. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned in Kafr Qaddum fired tear gas and stun grenades towards demonstrators for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Mahmoud after being struck with a tear gas canister in the head. (ii) At 18:25, Israeli forces positioned at military tower in North Azzun opened fire towards several children for alleged stoning. (iii) At 19:20, Israeli forces positioned at the north entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets, tear gas and stun grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a resident and leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Burin village, clashed with residents, detained 4 residents (including 3 children) and temporarily detained 20 students inside a school. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint detained Mujahid Mabrouka, a resident of Nablus and severely beat him. (ii) Israeli forces detained Obieda Najjar (16 years), Ahmad Qaddus (16 years), Yussef Qaddus (14 years) and Mohammad Ass'oud in Burin village. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 21:00, a demonstration took place in Nablus against Israeli aggression towards Gaza.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) Since 14:00 on August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed the bypass road leading to Haris village junction. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Harris village until 13:00. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

(iv) At 11:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Thariya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and fire bomb throwing. • <u>Detention:</u> At dawn on November 14th 2012, Israeli forces detained Amar Ghayth (17 years) and Muntasir Al-Rajabi in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained Mohammad Rajabi (15 years), Yusef Rajabi (13 years) and Anan Rajabi (12 years) in the old city of Hebron for alleged stoning and released them at a later time. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 21:00, a demonstration took place in Hebron against Israeli military aggression towards Gaza. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 11 November 2012 at 18:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by conducting military operation under the code name "Cloud Foundation" by firing tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line, launching missiles from Naval vessels, Israeli fighter jet launching 70 missiles towards all districts in Gaza which left 1 Palestinian gunman killed in an assassination attack after launching missiles

Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:10, Israeli Naval vessels launched missiles towards Gaza and injured several residents. • <u>Aerial Assault:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli Drones launched a missile towards a vehicle carrying Palestinian gunmen in an assassination attempt and killed a gunman. (ii) At 17:10, Israeli drones launched a missile towards a vehicle carrying several Palestinian gunmen near Gaza sea port and injured 2 gunmen.
