#### **WEST BANK**

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Hizma, stormed Abdel-Fatah Salah Al-Dins home and summoned him to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Biddu, stormed Wassim Mustafa's home.
- (iii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, stormed Mohammad Gharbiy'as home and summoned him to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Luuwz neighbourhood in Silwan fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, Israeli forces closed the main entrance
  gates leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound and allowed a group of Israeli settlers
  lead by Moshe Figlin to storm Al-Aqsa mosque compound during which Israeli
  forces assaulted a Mosque guard and Israeli settlers provoked worshipers.

- <u>Attack:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result, left several of them suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

### At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by **ALL** the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom DISTRICTS of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients. Killing: On September 14<sup>th</sup> 2014, Anas Al-Hinawi (A resident of Jabaliya camp) **NORTHERN GAZA** died at a hospital in Jordan of injuries sustained from Israeli assault on the Gaza Strip. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **GAZA** (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **Attack:** On the morning of September 14<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores Gaza. **Closure of Crossing Points:**
