- (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound as a result prevented residents and workers including those with entry permits from entering Israeli and Jerusalem.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 16:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:00.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Raid: At 05:00 on March 31<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and detained 3 residents including 2 children.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 16:15, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Shushya neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem under the protection of Israeli forces who detained 5 residents who attempted to prevent the settler attack.

Israeli forces set up several checkpoints along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus, between Azzun and "Qaddumin" settlement, along the main road leading to Al-Fundiq village and forced several store owned to close their shops then withdrew at 13:15.</li> <li>(ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Jit junction.</li> <li>(iii) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, closed the entrance then reopened it at a later time.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Raid: At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Azzun, clashed with its residents, temporarily detained several children and released them after interrogation.</li> <li>Attack: At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near south Qalqiliya fired tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.</li> <li>Physical Assault: At 16:20, Israeli force positioned near Joloujliya checkpoint assaulted and injured Saed Nofal (15 years old) leaving him hospitalised with a broken arm and contusions.</li> <li>Wall Gates: <ul> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
