JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikhsa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikhsa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 19:30, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road which connects Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and detained a resident. (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 14:00.

(iii) Israeli forces detained Yusef Al-Khatib in Qalandiya camp. • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned at Sakhura village junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On April 1st 2014, Israeli Authorities approved plans for the construction of 708 settlements unites in "Gilo" settlement located in south Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Silwad until 17:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Jaba' village , stormed a home, detained a resident after confiscating a Klashinkov rifle and 2 hand guns then withdrew at 22:45. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya , detained a child then withdrew at 02:15. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Islim in Jaba' village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Moath Sharitih (16 years old) in Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and closed the steel gate entrance and reopened it at 17:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 17:30, Israeli settlers stormed Burqa village and attacked a mosque during which local residents were able to repel the settler attack forcing them to withdraw at 17:40. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya until 10:30. (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad until 22:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Hamsa village in the North Jordan valley, demolished 4 residential tents, 11 live stock dens, a kitchen and 2 bathrooms owned by Abed Abu Jawad, Ali Al-Kabash, Harb Abu Kabash and Hakam Abu Kabash then withdrew at 12:15. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 07:00, Israeli forces forcibly removed 20 families from their homes in Wadi Ibziq area from 07:00 until 16:00 on April 2nd 2014 in order to conduct military training in the area based on a prior notice.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 12:30. (ii) At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Beit Lid, stormed a home, summoned Ismail Sharaf to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 00:50. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:30, a demonstration took place in front of the International red cross headquarters in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Jinsafut village. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed several home, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ahmad Hamadan and Taha Abdallah in Qalqiliya. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (ii) At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in east Ras Al-Tireh

	<p>opened random fire.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces temporarily detained Suhayeb Abbas, a resident of Kafr Qaddum as he was farming his agricultural land located near “Qaddumim” settlement then released him at 16:30 • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Faruq until 12:45. (ii) At 14:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near Sarah village junction until 15:30. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Burqa village until 21:05. • <u>Detention:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces detained Aysar Turki, a resident of Usirin as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:45, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Tel village and chased away several Sheppard’s and farmers from their agricultural land.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u>

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North West entrance of Beit Jallah until 16:40. (iii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Kafar Atsiyon" Settlement, Detained A University student and summoned Ammar Bujat to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, clashed with several residents and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation thus preventing several worshipers from entering a nearby mosque for evening prayers, detained a child then withdrew at 17:00. (ii) At 05:10, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 06:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Jamal, a resident of Hebron near "Kafar Atsiyon" Settlement. (ii) Israeli forces detained Abdallah Hamad (15 years old) near AL-Ayda camp. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along

- the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

 - (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint located in Al-Sahla area in the old city of Hebron detained Hamza Salaymeh (a journalist) as he intervened to prevent the detention of Tahani Abu Maliya who was detained for allegedly carrying a knife as she passing through the checkpoint then released her at 17:00.
 - (iii) At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar detained Adnana Awad , a resident of Beit Ummar.
 - (iv) Israeli forces detained Nathir Nasser (16 years old) in Dura.
 - (v) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ahmad Qazaz and Ma'ayad Al-Sous in Qurusiya village.
 - **Temporary Detention:** At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Shifa Wazwaz and released her at a later time during which Israeli forces assaulted Mohammad Qurie' leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
 - **Settler Violence:** At 22:40, Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron assaulted 2 children: Obeid Abu Sneneh (13 years old) and Mohammad Abu Sneieneh (6 years old) as they were riding their bikes
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the

	illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
