WEST BANK

•	Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Agsa mosque compound as a result prevented residents and workers including those with entry permits from entering Israeli and Jerusalem.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (iii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 16:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:00.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of

JERUSALEM

Al-Isawiya village.

• Demonstrations:

- (i) At 12:00, a demonstration took place near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem, protesting the killing of Palestinian detainee Maysara Abu Hamadiya who died in Israeli prisons due to medical negligence on the part of the Israeli prison authority, clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured 5 residents including 3 journalists: Dalia Jouhan (Journalist), Mahmoud Aliyan (journalist), Sa'id Al-Qaq (Journalist), Amin Siyam and Khalid Al-Silwadi as well as detaining 9 residents including a paramedic.
- (ii) At 14:00, a demonstration took place near Qalandiya checkpoint, protesting the killing of Palestinian detainee Maysara Abu Hamadiya who died in Israeli prisons due to medical negligence on the part of the Israeli prison authority, clashed with Israeli forces and injured several residents who suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (iii) At 16:20, a demonstration took place in Abu Dis protesting the killing of Palestinian detainee Maysara Abu Hamadiya who died in Israeli prisons due to medical negligence on the part of the Israeli prison authority, clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) On April 2nd 2013, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Basam Zaghir,Mohammad Al-Daba' and Nassir Abu Asab as they entered an Israeli Police station based on previous summons in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) On April 2nd 2013, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ahmad AlZaghal and Nasser Awawda in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained 9 residents: Foad Obied, Wa'ed QANAM, Zakariya Hijazi, In'am Colombo, Nasser Qaws, Imad Al-Hussieni, Ahmad Oda and Lafi Al-Rumani near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem.
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> On the evening of April 1st 2013, Israeli forces forced Taysir Abu Al-hawa to demolish 25 m² portion of his home and imposed a financial penalty for allegedly constructing without proper licencing.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- Raid: At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village, stormed and searched a home.

(i) At 11:15, a demonstration took place in Hebron protesting the killing of Palestinian detainee Maysara Abu Hamadiya who died in Israeli prisons due to medical negligence on the part of the Israeli prison authority, clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured 8 residents including 6 children: Ahmad Al-Zur (16 years old), Mahmoud Abu Al-Dab'at(13 years old), Ali Dadawien (15 years old), Qusay Al-Fakhouri (13 years old), Ihab Abu Eisheh (16 years old), Jallal Al-Qawasmeh(14 years old), Ramez Al-Salhi, and Rafat Taha as well as leaving several others

suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

- (ii) At 13:50, a demonstration took place in Al-Fuwar camp, protesting the killing of Palestinian detainee Maysara Abu Hamadiya who died in Israeli prisons due to medical negligence on the part of the Israeli prison authority during which Israeli forces clashed with demonstrators and detained a child.
- (iii) At 16:00, a demonstration took place in Beit Ummar, protesting the killing of Palestinian detainee Maysara Abu Hamadiya who died in Israeli prisons due to medical negligence on the part of the Israeli prison authority and clashed with Israeli forces.

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli Air force broke the cease fire agreement by launching missile airstrikes towards North Gaza and Gaza. Palestinian gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line.

Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. Air Strikes: At 22:35, Israeli F-16 fighter jets launched a missile towards a Green **NORTHERN GAZA** House in Al-Badawiya village located in north Beit Lahiya and destroyed a Green House, a water well and agricultural crops owned by Farah Abu Rabie. Palestinian Attack: On the morning of April 3rd 2013, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line. **Closure of Crossing Points:** Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the (i) Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, (ii) **GAZA** the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Air Strikes: At 23:45, Israeli F-16 fighter jets launched a missile towards east Gaza city.

Detainees Update

At 08:00 on April 2nd 2013, Palestinian Detainee Maysara Abu Hamida, a resident of Hebron, died at an Israeli hospital after being admitted on April 1st 2013, because of deterioration in his health condition due to medical negligence on the part of the Israeli prison authority; during which the Palestinian Minister of Detainees and Ex Detainees Affairs held the Israeli government directly responsible for A Mysara Abu Hamdiya's death.
