JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, stormed several merchant shops, detained a resident and confiscated a fire arm and at 23:55, Israeli forces stormed a Gas Station and confiscated several surveillance camera recordings then withdrew at 00:30. (ii) On April 2nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Samual village, stormed and searched several homes and detained 3 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Abboud Abu Sbeih and Diya Hassan after storming their homes in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mohammad Rayan, Osama

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 2nd 2014 22:00, Israeli forces raided Qurwat Bani Zeid village and detained a resident. (ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 01:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mukhlis Abdel Salam Arrar in Qurwat Bani Zeid village. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 00:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad levelled a plot of land a Military Watch tower. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:45, Israeli settlers stormed the area between Ein Yabrud and Beitin villages and temporarily abducted Hiba Jum’a , a resident of Yabrud village as she was herding her goats then released her at 15:15. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jamalat village until 00:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

	<p>Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:15, Israeli forces raided Atil, clashed with several residents as they Israeli forces took photographs of several old homes then withdrew at 09:15. (ii) At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Kur village until 13:40. (iii) At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Saffarin village until 14:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbat Al-Tabib village until 21:15. • <u>Raids:</u> At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun, detained a resident then withdrew at 07:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:10, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Kashmar during their raid into Qalqiliya as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained Bajjis Shabatiya in Azzun • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Faruq

	<p>until 11:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 15:20 and again at 20:15, Israeli force set up 3 checkpoints at the entrances of Burin, Madama and Asira Al-Qibliya villages, for alleged fire-bombing of a bus carrying several Israeli settlers) during which they seized and searched a Palestinian National Security force vehicle, detained a resident after assaulting him near the entrance of Madma village until 23:25. (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-Bithan and Al-Far'a villages until 22:00. (iv) At 22:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummrin village until 23:30. (v) At 22; 15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Asira Al-Shimaliya. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:30 on April 2nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Assira Al-Shimaliya and detained a resident after storming his home. (ii) At 02:30 on April 2nd 2014 and again at 16:35, Israeli forces raided Awarta village, detained a resident after storming his home, clashed with residents then withdrew at 17:05. (iii) At 13:30 and again at 20:15, Israeli forces raided Madma, imposed a curfew, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 23:25 (iv) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed Joseph's Tomb, clashed with residents and as a result injured Qassim Shahin leaving him hospitalised with contusions then withdrew at 05:15. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 2nd 2014, Israeli settlers stormed the outskirts of Jallud village and damaged a vehicle owned by Riyadh Abu Al-Haba. (ii) At 15:40, an Israeli settler threatened Iz Omran with a fire arm after the Israeli settler purchased a laptop from him after which he led the victim to the settlement to allegedly give the money for the lap top during which Iz Omran was able to take the fire arm from the settler and take the computer after wards he informed Palestinian Intelligence officer regarding the incident. (iii) At 20:40, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land and assaulted 4 residents: Dahman Hijazi, Suliman Hijazi, Mazen Hijzi and Eyad Hijazi during which an Israeli settler vehicle proceeded and ran over Suliman Hijazi leaving him hospitalised with contusions and Israeli forces detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On March 31st 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mahmoud Malalee and Hatem Ma'alee in Beita. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Nassar in Madma village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Nassir Jamal in Assira Al-Shimaliya. (iv) Israeli forces detained Marssel Awwad iin Awarta . (v) Israeli forces detained Mazen Hijazi near "Elli" settlement in Nablus district.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with

<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 11:25. (ii) At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jiftlik village until 17:30. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Jericho in solidarity with Palestinian detainee and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Detention:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint detained 4 residents: Mohammad Hammad , Omar Mutier, Khalil Nassar and Mohammad Hajjajha.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun grenade towards several residents inside the camp for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic. (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun. (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Sinjir area located between Hebron and Dura until 10:30. (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp. • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:45, Israeli forces raided Halhul, detained a resident after storming a home then withdrew at 05:20. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:20 on April 2nd 2014, Israeli forces detained Abdel Fattah Al-Gharib after confiscating a hand gun while storming and searching his home. (ii) Israeli forces detained Saed Zama' reh.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards Rafah. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Attack: At dawn on April 3rd 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach off the shores of Beit Lahiya. • Detention: On April 2nd 2014, Israeli forces detained 3 unidentified residents as they attempted to climb the border fence into Israel from north Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
