Closure: The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem (i) city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) **JERUSALEM** entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

Raid: At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and removed a Bus stop booth

	 located near the wall gate then withdrew at 02:00. <u>Detention</u>: On April 3rd 2014, Israeli forces detained Sabri Awad, a resident of Beit Ummar, while in Jerusalem. <u>Home Demolition</u>: At 09:00, Israeli forces demolished 2 barracks owned by Salem Al-Jahalin and Mahmoud Al-Jahalin in Jabal Baba area located in Al-Eizariya for allegedly being built without proper licencing.
	 <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On April 3rd 2014, Israeli forces demolished a coffee shop near Jaba' junction for allegedly being built without a licence. <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.
	Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al- Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
	Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
	 Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Attack: At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Rami Al-Rimawi (13 years old), a resident of Beit Rima leaving him hospitalised with contusions. At 18:05, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazun camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud
	town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al- Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
	 Closure of Main Road: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.
JENIN	 Raid: At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Zabada village, stormed and searched a home, detained a University student, temporarily detained 2 residents: Taha Sharuqi and Mahdi Sharouqi then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officer.
	 Detention: (i) At 11:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Al-Jamalah crossing point detained Saleem Abu Salameh, a resident of Faqou's village and confiscated hi vehicle. (ii) Israeli forces detained Obeid Al-Za'tari in Al-Zabadeh.

TUBAS	 Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. Raid: At 01:00 on April 3rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Bayda village, stormed 5 homes, summoned 3 residents: Nihad Fuqaha, Omar Fuqaha and Osama Fuqaha to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. Physical Assault: At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned in east Tayassir village assaulted and injured Thiyab Suliman (A special needs patient). Temporary Detention: At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at Tayasir checkpoint temporarily detained Ibrahim Yusef Ibrahim then released him after question by Israeli intelligence officers. Assault on Property: At 09:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Hadidiya village in the north Jordan valley and served eviction orders to 4 families: Abdel Mahdi
TULKAREM	 Suliman, Ayed Suliman, Saddam Suliman and Oday Suliman to leave their homes. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	 Closure of Roads: (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Flving Checkpoint: At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 17:50. Raid: At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, temporarily detained Mohammad Abu Libdeh then released him at 00:25. Wall Gates:

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
	 Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 08:00 and again at 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Madama village and opened fire after alleged firebombing of an Israeli settler vehicle in the area until 12:30. (ii) At 08:35 and again at 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the
	entrance of Beit Furiq until 19:30. • Raid: At 17:40, Israeli forces raided Awarta village and clashed with several residents.
	 Attack: At 13:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Madama village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Alcheckpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoint: At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Kafil Harris and Harris village, temporarily detained Abdel Rahim Shamlawi then released him at 14:20. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	 Checkpoints: At 18:25 Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District until 18:50. Flying Checkpoint: At 08:10 and again at 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nu'emeh village. At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 08:40. At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 19:00. Raid: At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jiftlik village and served a demolition order for a home owned by Mohammad Bani Odeh for allegedly being built without a licence.
BETHLEHEM	Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area
	in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hussan village.
- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction located at the south entrance of Beit Jallah until 18:30.
- (iii)At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Marah Rabah until 19:00.
- Raid: At 11:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Dar Salah village

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May $1^{\rm st}$ 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa'

- towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September $23^{\rm rd}$ 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.

• Raids:

- (i) At 02:00 on April 3rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained 2 residents.
- (ii) At dawn on April 3rd 2014 Israeli forces raided Surif and detained 2 residents.
- (iii)At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa, clashed with residents as they stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 17:40.
- (iv) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Yatta.
- (v) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed 2 homes, summoned 2 residents: Khalil Omran (A Civil Defence officer) and Akram Al-Sus

Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Fadil Qawasmeh and Mohammad Al-Ghazawi in Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ehab Al-Hur and Mu'ab Al-Hur in Surif.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire and launching tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green line towards Gaza.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards

Attack; (i) At 06:00 on April 1st 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. (ii) At 19:00 on April 1st 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. Air Assault: At dawn on April 4th 2014, Israeli fighter jets launched several missiles during 3 consecutive air strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in Beit Lahiya and as a result destroyed a vehicle repair shop and a washing machine maintenance shop and also damaged several homes in the area.

Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Air Assault: (i) At dawn on April 4th 2014, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile during 2 consecutive air strike towards a home in south Gaza and as a result injured 2 residents including a child and caused damaged to several surrounding homes. (ii) At dawn on April 4th 3014, Israeli fighter jets launched missiles during 3 consecutive air strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in south Gaza, in Tel Al-Hawa neighbourhood in south Gaza and agricultural land in south Gaza.
