#### WEST BANK

# ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

# • <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.

# **JERUSALEM**

#### • Flying checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the village of Hizma, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 11:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the junction of Ma'ale Adomim settlement.
- (iii) At 14:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the town of Bir Nibala, and searched civilians and vehicles.
- **Raids**: At 08:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Abu Dis.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of

• <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede civilian access.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 12:30, the Israeli raided the city of Qalqilya. The raid recurred at 15:30 during which the Israeli army photographed 2 mosques.
- (ii) At 19:30, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Azzun and the village of Izbet al-Tabib, and arrested 1 civilian in 'Azzun.
- (iii) At 01:05, the Israeli army raided the own of Jayyous and detained the head of the municipal council and warned him against having civilians throw stones. In addition, the Israeli army searched 2 civilian houses and then withdrew at 01:45.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The civilian arrested in the town of 'Azzun is Mohammad Rushdi Rashid Misleh.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 17:30, a bunch of settlers attacked 2 civilians who were sitting in their agricultural barracks near the village of Jeet.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Land leveling for Wall construction was suspended in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.

#### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:
- (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only.
- (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan.
- (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.

- <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints</u>: At 17:45, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on al-Nashash junction (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem) and physically attacked civilian Khaled Mahmoud Sa'id Issa and injured him.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: At 21:00, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at the alcontainer checkpoint and impeded traffic.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 11:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem. The raid recurred at 23:45.
- (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Beit Jala.

#### • Demonstrations:

- (i) At 12:00, a public march set out with the participation of international peace activists and supporters in the village of al-Ma'sara in protest of the apartheid wall construction. The Israeli attacked civilian protestors and injured 2 children and 2 international supporters.
- (ii) At 13:00, a public march set out in the village of al-Walaja and civilian protestors held worship on the land threatened with confiscation for the purpose of the apartheid wall construction.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35

northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.

(ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 13:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the village of Khars and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At15:00, the Israeil army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the village of Beit Kahel. The checkpoint was set up a second time at 17:30.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 12:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron, and set up a checkpoint. The raid recurred at 24:00.
- (ii) At 13:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Dura.
- (iii) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit 'Ummar\and clashed with civilians during patrol and injured 1 child. The Israeli army withdrew at 17:30.
- (iv) At 22:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area of al-Matniyye in the town of Yatta.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanoun (Erez) Crossing is partially open (to allow previously coordinated humanitarian access).
- Raids: At 22:00, the Israeli army raided the area of Abu Safieh east of the town of Jabalia, opned fire intensively, and arrested 2 civilians.
- <u>Arrests</u>: The 2 civilians arrested in the area of Abu Safieh east of the town of Jabalia have not been identified.

#### • Palestinian Attacks:

(i) At 11:30, armed individuals opened fire towards the Israeli army on the Green Line east of the town of Beit Hanoun. At once, the Israeli army

opened fire and raided east of the town of Beit Hanoun and combed the area alongside the Green Line.
