<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Duqu village. (iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Ram. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Hizma village then stormed and searched a vehicle repair shop. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:30 on April 7th 2015, Israeli forces detained Jihad Ab u Latifah (A resident of Qalandiya camp) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 01:00 on April 7th 2015, Israeli forces detained two children: Hazim Sa’idah (16 years old) and Husam Sa’aydeh (16 years old) in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood. (iii) At 19:30, Israeli forces detained Samir Shuqayer in Wadi Rababa area in Silwan neighbourhood. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces positioned in Ain Al-Lawaz area in Silwn neighbourhood, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in

	<p>Abu Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p>
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Raid: At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 02:45.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Raids: At 16:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Jabirat area in Jenin city. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Tubas city, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:55. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abdel-Raziq in Tubas.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Lid junction. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces closed wall gate (708) located in Far’oun village and as a result temporarily seized several farmers on the other side of the wall gate until 13:00. (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces closed wall gate (526) located in Nazlat Issah village and as a result temporarily seized several farmers on the other side of the wall gate until 20:40.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:15 and again at 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 20:55, Israeli forces closed Huwarah checkpoint and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it at 21:30. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Aqraba and Osirin village junctions until 11:50. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Tel village junction and temporarily detained Ahmad Assidah then released him later. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:20, Israeli forces raided Nablus as they escorted several Israeli settlers who stormed Joseph’s tomb then clashed with several residents and as a result injured Issa Hashash (17 years old) then withdrew at 02:50. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:25, Israeli forces positioned at a military post in Jabal Attil located in south Nablus temporarily detained Mahmoud Judeh as he was herding his sheep then released him at 19:25.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Ariel” settlement and detained a resident. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at the east entrance of Yasuf village and Iskaka Village Bridge thus preventing residents from entering Salfit city until 20:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Musa (A resident of Deir Ballut) at a checkpoint near “Ariel” settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Raid:</u> At 14:50, Israeli forces raided Jericho as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed a Synagogue then withdrew at 15:45.

<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jab'a village until 12:50.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

	<p>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.</p> <p>(v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces set up checkpoint at Al-Fuwar camp junction until 09:05. (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna until 13:10. (iii) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Awa junction. (iv) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp. (v) At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Tal'at Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron, occupied Shaher Abu Sbeih's home and converted its rooftop into a military post and temporarily detained 50 residents inside of a school yard for the alleged stoning of Abu Rish checkpoint in the area then released them after interrogation by Israeli Intelligence officers, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 01:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on April 7th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Awa and detained two residents. (ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Karmil village as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers as they stormed an archaeological site and then temporarily detained several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and released them later then withdrew at 17:10. (iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir until 19:20. (iv) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Dura, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:10. (v) At dawn on April 8th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained two residents after storming and searching their homes. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 7th 2015, Israeli forces detained Na'im Al-Rajabi in the old city of Hebron. (ii) Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint in Tal'at Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron detained two residents: Ramzi Ashour and Sa'di Al-Qariri. (iii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Firas Masalmeh and Khaled Masalmeh in Beit Awa. (iv) Israeli forces detained two residents: Munthir Atwan and Abdel-Qadder Al-Sharawneh. (v) Israeli forces detained two residents: Alaa Al-Za'ariq and Ismail Al-Salibi in Beit Ummar.

	<p>be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> At dawn on April 8th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
