NABLUS	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin, and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. Checkpoints: At 05:00Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. Flying Checkpoint:
	in Burin village, conducted Talmudic prayers then withdrew at 10:00. (ii) At 18:30, a group of settlers accompanied by military bulldozers under the protection of Israeli forces raided Karim Salem area in Burin village and levelled plots of land.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict access at Za'tara checkpoint and impede the free flow of traffic. Raid: At 14:20, Israeli forces raided Burqin, searched an auto spare parts shop then withdrew at 15:00. At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Salfit, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes then withdrew at 00:50. Settler Violence: At 13:00, a group of Israeli settlers raided residential land in Wadi Qana area and withdrew at a later time. Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya
	town southeast of the illegal settlement for Passover holiday.
JERICHO	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. Checkpoints: (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up
	along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron.
- (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge until 01:35.

Raids:

- (i) At dawn on April 8th 2012, Israeli forces raided Sair village and stormed a home.
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron while protecting a group of settlers as they entered Anatils Tomb, fired rubber coated steel bullets and teargas grenades towards several minors for alleged stoning, assaulted 3 international peace activists as they attempted to prevent settler assaults then withdrew at 18:00
- (iii) At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Yatta.

• Detention:

- (i) At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Mohanad Al-Jabari (16 years) for allegedly carrying a knife.
- (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Turki in the old city of Hebron.

• Temporary Detention:

- (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces temporarily detained Alaa Abu Sbieh after storming his shop in Talat Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron (which is under Israeli administrative control) and released him at a later time.
- (ii) At 17:45, Israeli forces temporarily detained Ibrahim Abu Turki in Al-Sahala area in the old city of Hebron (which is under Israeli administrative control) and released him at 18:15.
- (iii) At 22:20, Israeli forces temporarily detained several residents including women and children after forcing them out of their homes in the old city of Hebron.
- Obstruction of Places of Worship: Since April 7th 2012 at 22:00, Israeli forces closed down Al-Ibrahimi Haram mosque in the old city of Hebron prevented prayers from taking place to allow Israeli settlers to celebrate Talmudic holidays inside the mosque until 22:00 of April 9th 2012.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town for the Passover holiday.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 13 March 2012 at 01:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards Central Gaza and Khan Yunis Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and firing tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza, Gaza and Khan Yunis. Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza. Palestinian Gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. Attack: On the evening of April 9th 2012, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards agricultural land in Beit Hanun and Jabalya. On the morning of April 9th 2012, Israeli Naval vessel opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Beit Lahiya. Aerial Surveillance: On the evening of April 8th 2012, Israeli aircrafts surveyed the skies of North Gaza. Palestinian Attack: On the evening of April 8th 2012, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attack: On the evening of April 8th 2012, Israeli forces opened fire and fired artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards agricultural land in Kafr Al-Dik located in Gaza.
CENTRAL GAZA	• Raid: At dawn on April 9 th 2012, Israeli forces escorting military bulldozers raided Al-Buriej camp, opened fire towards agricultural land and homes as they levelled a plot of land.
KHAN YUNIS	 Raid: At dawn on April 9th 2012, Israeli forces escorting military bulldozers raided 250 meters inside the vicinity of Khaza'a, opened fire towards agricultural land, homes and residents as they levelled a plot of land. Attack: At dawn on April 9th 2012, Israeli forces from their positions behind the Green Line fired tank artillery towards Al-Qarara.

Detainees Report

 On April 8th 2012, Israeli military court in Ofar prison sentenced Basil Milhim, a resident of Bethlehem to 2 years in prison and imposed a fine of 4000 NIS approximately 1080 USD, Mahmoud Jalham, a resident of Bethlehem to 22 month in prison and imposed a fine of 4000 NIS approximately 1080 USD, Basil Al-Issa to 10 months in prison and imposed a fine of 2500 NIS approximately 675 USD and sentenced Anas Ramadan to 7 months in prison and imposed a fine of 2500 NIS approximately 675 USD.
