JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to Jerusalem city and to prevent civilians from other Palestinian districts from entering the city, only allowing access to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding Jerusalem city and restrict access to the area to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'. The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section, separating the area of Dahiyat al Barced from the town of Ar Ram. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and force civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoint: The Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designates a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Flying Checkpoint: At 15:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Qalandiya village and searched civilians and vehicles. Attack: At 16:00, the Israeli army fired sound and tear gas grenades on civilians near the southern entrance to Al 'Isawiya village, allegedly for throwing stones. Raid: At 24:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Ar Ram town. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil town and Saffa village and the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.

<u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the area north of Qalandiya village; south of Az Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi

(ii) Although it removed the dirt barricade, the Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to An Nabi Salih village.

	 Flving Checkpoint: At 00:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Deir as Sudan village and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids/Attack: At 00:25, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Beit Liqya town. At 00:40, the Israeli army raided Turmus'ayya town and served a summons on Akram Suleiman Jubara to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. At 01:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Deir Abu Mash'al village. At 01:45, the Israeli army raided Ramallah city and patrolled it until 05:00. At 01:50, the Israeli army raided Silwad town and fired sound grenades, while patrolling the area. At 02:00, the Israeli army raided Bir Zeit town and patrolled the area until 05:20. Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding 'Ofarim settlement and
JENIN	 north of Al Lubban al Gharbi and Rantis villages. Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of Dotan settlement. Flying Checkpoints: At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to 'Anin village and searched civilians and vehicles. At 15:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to Jaba' town and searched civilians and vehicles. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	 Checkpoint: Though allowing civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley between 06:00 and 22:00, the Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the city of Tubas. Flving Checkpoint: At 20:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Bardala village and searched civilians and vehicles. Detentions: At 12:00, the Israeli army detained two civilians (a father and son), while they were grazing sheep near Al Farisiya village in the Northern Jordan Valley area: Husni Zuhdi Abdullah Mahasneh; and his son Zuhdi Husni Zuhdi Mahasneh, 15 years old.
TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting Kafr al Labad town to Shufa village as well as the road connecting Shufa and 'Izbat Shufa villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions and impede civilian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:45, and again at 12:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Kafriyat road connecting Tulkarem and Qalqiliya road and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 10:40, and again at 21:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Beit Lid town and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 11:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to Zeita and 'Attil towns and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 11:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Qaffin town and searched civilians and vehicles.
- Raid: At 22:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Beit Lid town.
- <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- <u>Closure of Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near Jit village on the Oalgiliva-Nablus main road and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 19:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near Jinsafut village on the Qalqiliya-Nablus main road and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 20:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to 'Azzun town and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Raids:

- (i) At 20:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Jinsafut village.
- (ii) At 22:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled An Nabi Elyas village.
- <u>Detention</u>: At 09:00, the Israeli army detained Sa'id Mohammed Radhwan, while he was present on his land near the eastern entrance to Qalqiliya city, and released him at 10:45.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi ar Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the iron gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.

QALQILYA

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osarin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to the town of Qabalan; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut; and the western entrance to An Naqura village opposite the settlement of Shavei Shomron.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:
- (i) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only between 07:00 and 02:00.
- (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, but between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All civilian vehicles are allowed to access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.
- (iii) At 17:15, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and impeded civilian access.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between 'Urif and 'Asira al Qibliya village and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 16:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to Qabalan town and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 17:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to 'Awarta village and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 20:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to Ousin village and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (v) At 21:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between Nablus city and 'Asira ash Shamaliya town and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (vi) At 21:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction to Deir Sharaf village on the Nablus-Tulkarem main road and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (vii) At 03:05, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Badhan road (the eastern entrance to Nablus city) and searched civilians and vehicles

• Raids/Detention/Attack/Curfew:

(i) At 12:30, the Israeli army raided Kafr Qalil village and patrolled the area until 12:45.

NABLUS

- (ii) At 14:10, the Israeli army raided and patrolled 'Iraq Burin village. Meanwhile, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. At 15:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.
- (iii) At 17:10, the Israeli army raided Qusra village, searched three houses, detained Ahmed Reidah, and released him at a later time.
- (iv) At 02:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Beita town.
- (v) At 05:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Balata refugee camp in Nablus city.
- (vi) At 05:25, the Israeli army raided 'Awarta village. While imposing curfew, the Israeli army opened fire and fired sound grenades. The Israeli army also closed the village's entrances with checkpoint and denied civilian access to or from the area. In addition, the Israeli army searched many houses and arrested eight civilians, including brothers. The Israeli army remains positioned in the village as of 08:00 this morning.

• Arrests:

(i) At 17:15, Israeli troops positioned at Huwwara checkpoint arrested Fares Mustafa 'Awwad.

The Israeli army arrested eight civilians in 'Awarta village:

- (ii) Amjad Mohammed Fawzi 'Awwad;

• <u>Settler Violence/Destruction of Property:</u>

- (i) At 09:20, a group of Israeli settlers raided 'Asira al Qibliya village and threw stones and empty bottles at civilian houses, injuring two civilians:
 - (i) Qasem Mohammed Hasan Saleh; and
 - (ii) Abdullah Abdul Salam Yousef Ahmed.

Both civilians were transported to hospital for treatment of injuries sustained. Israeli settlers also set fire to a vehicle belonging Ali 'Isa Makhlouf and damage an electricity generator inside a stone processing factory. Subsequently, the Israeli army evacuated settlers from the area.

(ii) At 15:50, a group of Israeli settlers from Alon Moreh settlement gathered near Deir al Hatab village's school and withdrew at 16:20.

• Closure of Main Roads:

SALFIT

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the northern entrance to Salfit city and with cement blocks the northern entrance to the Bruqin town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to respective farmland.

- (iii) Beginning on 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has continued to open the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years.
- <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions and impede civilian access at the Za'tara junction checkpoint.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the entrance to Haris village and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern entrance to Qarawat Bani Hassan town and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Raids:

- (i) At 15:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Kafr ad Dik town.
- (ii) At 00:50, the Israeli army raided Salfit city, served summons on two civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency, and withdrew at 01:30.
- <u>Arrest</u>: On 09 April 2011, Israeli troops positioned at the Za'tara junction checkpoint arrested Mohammed Khaled Suleiman.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of Emmanuel settlement.

• <u>Closure of Main Road</u>: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al 'Auja village with cement blocks.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting Jericho and Nablus districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho district of the Jordan Valley area.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al 'Auja village along Al-Mu'arrajat road connecting Jericho and Ramallah districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho district as well as to others holding access permits.

• Flying Checkpoints/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:

- (i) At 09:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance to Jericho city, searched civilians and vehicles, detained a Palestinian National Security vehicle, and allowed it to cross at a later time. At 22:00, the Israeli army set up another checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles until 22:40.
- (ii) At 16:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near 'Ein ad Duyuk village and searched civilians and vehicles.
- Raid: At 02:00, the Israeli army raided Al 'Auja village, searched a house, and arrested a civilian.
- Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Omar Mousa Yousef Hussein in Al 'Auja village.

JERICHO

Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. According to Military Order # S/02/07, the Israeli army has (ii) continued since 15 September 2007 to deny civilian access to an area measuring 22 dunums of land in the area of Mazmuriya in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. The land was confiscated pursuant to Military Order T/31/07. Beginning on 20 January 2011, the Israeli army has continued to (iii) close the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; and a rural road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village. **BETHLEHEM** Raids: (i) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided Ad Duheisha refugee camp in Bethlehem city, searched a number of houses, arrested a civilian, and withdrew at 04:30. At 02:30, the Israeli army raided Husan village, searched two houses, (ii) and arrested a civilian. **Arrests:** The Israeli army arrested Mahmoud Abdul Qader Mohammed al (i) Badawi in Ad Duheisha refugee camp in Bethlehem city. The Israeli army arrested Mohammed Yasser Saleem Zu'oul in Husan (ii) Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the area northwest of Beit Jala city; around Al Walaja village; and east of Efrat settlement. Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shuhada' Street, As Sahleh and (i) Khuzq al Far areas, and the old gold market in the old city of Hebron. In addition to closing the entrance to Al Oeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an iron gate and Al Laban Market with iron plates. (ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued Military Order # 09/06/S on the closure of the area located along the Green Line south of the Hebron town of Yatta, evacuation of civilian residents, and prevention of civilian access to the area. According to Military Orders # 05/03/T and 05/04/T, land in this area was confiscated for Wall construction. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to As Samoa' and Adh Dhahiriya towns, Al 'Arrub refugee camp, and At Tuwani and Al Karmil villages. The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from (ii) travelling along Ash Shalala Old Street in the old city of Hebron.

(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Al Fahs area south of Hebron city and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 09:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Fawwar junction and searched civilians and vehicles. At 18:10, the Israeli army set up another checkpoint and arrested a civilian.
- (iii) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Idhna town and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 10:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Al Ja'bari neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (v) At 10:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in Khallet Hadhur area in the old city of Hebron and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (vi) At 17:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to Halhul town and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (vii) At 24:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to Beit 'Awwara town and searched civilians and vehicles.
- <u>Physical Assault</u>: At 11:45, Israeli troops severely beat Mahir Murtadha Hijazi in the old city of Hebron, leaving him with contusions. Hijazi was transported to hospital for medical treatment.

• Raids/Confiscation of Property:

- (i) At 08:35, the Israeli army raided Hebron city, set up a checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. At 01:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city again.
- (ii) At 13:25, the Israeli army raided Al 'Arrub refugee camp, searched a house, and confiscated an ID card belonging to Usamah Ibrahim Abu Hash'hash.
- (iii) At 14:10, the Israeli army raided Khirbet Safa village and prevented civilians and international peace activists from tending land under the threat of confiscation near Bat 'Ayin settlement. The Israeli army claimed that the area was a closed military zone.
- (iv) At 14:25, the Israeli army raided Khallet al Maya area east of Yatta town and searched a house.
- (v) At 00:40, the Israeli army raided Beit Kahil town, searched a number of houses, and arrested two civilians.
- (vi) At 01:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Yatta town.
- (vii) At 03:30, the Israeli army raided Surif town, searched a house, and served a summons on Ahmed Kamal Ghuneimat to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency.

• Arrests:

(i) Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up on Al Fawwar junction arrested Mohammed 'Ata Yousef Abu 'Allan.

The Israeli army arrested two civilians in Beit Kahil town:

(ii) Lu'ay Na'im al 'Atawneh; and

- (iii) Mus'ab Mohammed Isma'il Rayyan.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in the area surrounding Eshkolot settlement west of Adh Dhahiriya town.

• At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by the Israeli authorities came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire for a week. Later, armed Palestinian groups extended the ceasefire until 05 February 2009. The ceasefire continues to hold.

• <u>Violations of the Ceasefire</u>:

- (i) The Israeli army fired artillery shells from its locations on the Green Line on civilian houses and property. The Israeli navy opened fire on Palestinian fishing boats at sea and UAVs fired missiles on Palestinian territory, killing an armed Palestinian individual and injuring five others. Of those injured, two individuals were in critical health condition.
- (ii) Armed Palestinian individuals fired 85 mortars, including nine Grad missiles, towards the Green Line.

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is closed.

- <u>Air Attack/Injuries</u>: In the evening of 09 April 2011, an Israeli UAV fired a missile on armed Palestinian individuals west of Beit Lahiya town, critically injuring two individuals.
- Attacks:
- (i) At 14:30, the Israeli army fired seven artillery shells from its location on the Green Line on Al Fad'ous and Ash Shayma' areas north of Beit Lahiya town.
- (ii) At 15:00, the Israeli army fired a number of artillery shells from its location on the Green Line on Quleibu hill east of Beit Lahiya town.
- (iii) At 16:20, the Israeli army fired a number of artillery shells from its location on the Green Line Palestinian territory north of Beit Lahiya town.
- (iv) In the evening of 09 April 2011, the Israeli army fired a number of artillery shells from its location on the Green Line on Palestinian territory east of Jabalya town.

• Palestinian Attacks:

- (i) At 08:15, three unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
- (ii) At 08:25, two Grad missiles were fired towards the Green Line.
- (iii) At 10:45, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
- (iv) At 11:45, a Grad missile was fired towards the Green Line.
- (v) At 14:30, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
- (vi) At 15:30, an unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
- (vii) At 16:20, two mortars were fired towards the Green Line.

	Closure of Crossing Points:
GAZA	 (i) Al Muntar (Karnei) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed upon an Israeli unilateral decision.
