Closure: The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem (i) city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads: JERUSALEM** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. Detention:

- (i) On the evening of April 9th 2014, Israeli forces detained Husam Ghanim (14 years old) after storming his home in Al-Wad neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) On April 10th 2014, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mohammad Abu Farha, Tarid Zayed and Salah Al-Ajlouni in the old city of Jerusalem.
- **Assault on Education Sector:** On the morning of April 10th 2014, Israeli forces surrounded an Orphanage secondary school in Jerusalem, positioned near the main entrance gate as they stormed the school and temporarily detained Alaa Shkhudium who refused Israelis to enter the school and turned himself in.
- **Expulsion:** On April 10th 2014, Israeli forces served expulsion orders to 8 residents: Alaa Abu Shkhedum, , Musa Hallaq, Abdallah Al-Sinjlawi, Mohammad Al-Halaq, Wissam Hamoudeh, Mohammad Teryaqi, Ziyad Abu Wahdan and Hamza Milhis preventing them from entering Al-Agsa mosque compound for a period of 17 days until April 27th 2014.
- Home Demolition: On April 10th 2014, Israeli forces demolished 3 barracks owned by Ali Ka'abneh and Suliman Jahalin in Jabal Baba area located in Al-Eizariya for allegedly being built without proper licencing.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.
- Settlement Activity: On April 10th 2014, Israeli forces levelled several plots of land in Beit Duqu village located behind the wall gate in order to construct additional settlement unites near "Jivat Za'if" settlement.

Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate (ii) on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Siniil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.

Temporary Detention: At 10:40, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Mohammad Jarrar, a National Security officer as he was travelling to Jordan then released him at 11:05 **Closure:** The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the (i) exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road (i) between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iii) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan (iv) area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaia with a steel gate and barbed wires. Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and (v) road 60 with dirt mounds. Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to (vi) 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with (vii) dirt mounds. On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of (viii) Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. - Attack: At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp, fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result set fire to Thaer Jawarish'e home after a tear gas grenades exploded inside the home and left Tamam Jawarish suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
- Land Confiscation: On the morning of April 10th 2014, Israeli forces served confiscation orders to confiscate 984 dunumes (acres) of agricultural land in Aqbat Abed, Wadi Bayar, Khirbeit Qandah, Al-Sahafa area, Jaroun AlFuqaha, Wadi Abu Kir,Wadi' Al-Nu'man, Khilat Al-Fahm, Beit Sakariya,Al-Mantaba Al-Mahjara, Eib Asfour, Al-Sabi'a, Al-Zaytouniya, Al-Karami areas located in Al-Kahdr and Nihalin village in Bethlehem and in Beit Ummar in Hebron giving land owners 45 days to remove their property off the land and claiming the land as property of Israel thus preventing resident from entering the areas.
- <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces levelled land in Jabal Al-Nahla area near "Ifrat" settlement in south Bethlehem.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23^{rd} 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fahs area in south Hebron.
- (ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction, impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the main entrance then reopened it at 11:30.

• Raids:

- (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 18:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa and clashed with residents as they stormed a home.
- (iii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 16:20, Israeli settlers assaulted a resident near Jabal Jalis area in the old city of Hebron during which Israeli forces detained the resident as he attempted to prevent the settler attack.
- (ii) At 22:55, Israeli settlers assaulted Nasser Hajja as he was herding his sheep in Dura.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Tariq Thiyabna in Tarqumiya.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Khieiri Al-Ja'bari Jabal Jalis area in the old city of Hebron.
- <u>Home Occupation:</u> At 00:25, Israeli forces occupied a home owned by Fadil Al-Muhtasib located near Al-Shalashleh road in the old city of Hebron and converted its roof top into a military post.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire and launching tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green line towards North Gaza and
- Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards an Israeli military vehicle near the border fence

NORTHERN GAZA

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez)) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.

• Attack;

- (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards several workers in the industrial zone in Beit Hanun- Erez and as a result injured 3 residents including 1 critically injured: Taha Al-Kafrana (critically injured), Bakr Abu Amsha and Salem Al-Hadi.
- (ii) On the afternoon of April 10th 2014, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards several residents near Al-

	Shuhada cemetery in Jabaliya and as a result injured a resident.
