<p><b>JERUSALEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On April 10<sup>th</sup> 2015 the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 12:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis until 17:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned at the north entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>released him later.</p> <p>(ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village, detained a resident and temporarily detained two children: Ameer Hajiji (16 years old) and Usayed Omar (16 years old) then released them at 23:30.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Beituniya until 04:40.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Basil Al-Khatib (A resident of Beit Rima) near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of “Ofar” military base fired live ammunition stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents including a child: Ali Nakhlah (16 years old), Mohammad Abu Skhidium and Musa Qahoush.</li> <li>(ii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sinjil fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iv) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Tariq Zubiedy (14 years old) and as a result left him hospitalised.</li> <li>(v) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents: Mohammad Matariya, Mohammad Shalabi and Mohammad Hamoudeh leaving them hospitalised.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstrations:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:45, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left them suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:45, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(iii) At 14:15, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against the confiscation of land for the purpose of settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces who fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result left them suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p><b>QALQILIYA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 11:30 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hajja village.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Jayyus village, clashed with several residents then withdrew 20:15.</li> <li>• <b>Demonstration:</b> At 11:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration who fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result injured 4 residents including 2 children: Raed Ishtewi (15 years old), Jihad Rayan (13 years old), Anas Barham and Mohammad Qaddumi and also left several demonstrators suffocating form tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>SALFIT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> </ul>

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.</li> <li>(ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decisions.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
