JERUSALEM	 <u>Closure:</u> (i) On April 10th 2015 the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. 			
	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood. <u>Raid:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis until 17:00. 			
	 <u>Attack:</u> (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned at the north entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. <u>Wall Gates:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. ALL DISTRICTS	 At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis and as a result injured a child in Khan Yunis.

NORTHERN GAZA	<u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, and passengers travelling abroad and through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decisions.
KHAN YUNIS	 <u>Attack:</u> (i) On the morning of April 10th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire, launched stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents in east Abbassan Al-Kabbirah. (ii) On the evening of April 10th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire, launched stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents in east Abbassan Al-Kabbirah and as a result injured the child Ibrahim Abu Teir (17 years old).
