ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. Flying Checkpoints: At 10:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junctions of the towns of Beit Hanina and Bir Nibala, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 10:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Bir Nibala. At 11:00, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Izariyyeh, searched 2 civilian houses, and arrested 1 civilian. At 13:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Beit Iksa. Arrests: The civilian arrested in the town of al-Izariyyeh is Ahmad Walid Bassah. Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to ‘Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba’ road, the area of al-‘Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
RAMALLAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Safa. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Ras Karkar. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the villages of Ras Karkar and Kharbatha Bani Hareth, the western entrance to the village of Ain Yabroud, and the junction of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiah with dirt barricades and cement blocks. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of ‘Atara and impede civilian access. • Raids: At 00:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah and the town of Beitunia town and searched 1 building. • Attacks: At 14:00, the Israeli army assigned to guard the apartheid wall south of the city of al-Bireh opened fire towards young Palestinian under the pretext of stone throwing. • Arrests: at 12:00, the Israeli army arrested civilian Awni Fares Hamed from the town of Silwad while he was reporting to the Israeli military intelligence. • Demonstrations: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, a public march set out, with the participation of international peace activists and supporters, in the village of Bil’in in protest of the apartheid wall construction. The Israeli army clashed with civilian protestors and injured 1 Israeli journalist. (ii) At 14:00, a public march set out in the villages of Beit Ur al-Tahta and al-Foqa, Beit Sira, Safa, al-Tireh, and Kharbathah al-Misbah and the town of Beit Luqya, with the participation of international peace activists and supporters, in protest of the Israeli discriminatory measure that denies Palestinian civilian the right to travel on road #443. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area west of the town of ‘Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni’lin and Ni’lin to Deir Qaddis.

TOUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Toubas. (i) At 01:25, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the refugee camp of al-Far'a.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil's plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun's plain; and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamis. (ii) At 20:00, the Israeli army closed the road connecting the villages of Ramin and Bazaria with dirt barricades. (iii) At 17:00, the Israeli army closed the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun with barbed wires. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarem-Nablus road and at Jubaa checkpoint. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the town of Zeita, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 11:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance of the town of 'Atil, and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Zeita. The raid recurred at 21: during which the Israeli army arrested 5 civilians (including 2 children and 1 military officer). (ii) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of 'Atil. (iii) At 21:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Anabta and clashed with civilians during patrol. (iii) At 11:30, the Israeli army closed with dirt barriers the road connecting Azzun town to Izbat Tabib village. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede civilian access. • Flying Checkpoints: At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the villages of Izbet al-Tabib and Asala, and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, the Israeli raided and patrolled the city of Qalqilya and set up a checkpoint in the city center. (ii) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Kfar Qaddoum. (iii) The Israeli army raided the town of Jayyous and clashed with civilians during patrol. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians at the checkpoint set up on eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya. The arrested civilians are: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Anis Fares Imawi; (b) Mohammad Khaled Salem Imawi; and (c) Mohammad Samir Imawi. (ii) At 17:00, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians on the entrance to the village of Izbet al-tabib. The arrested civilians are: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Omar Ali Ahmad Abu Haniyyeh; (b) Omar Rashid Salim; and (c) Abdel Halim Abdel Rahman Hussein. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal

NABLUS	<p>Closure of Main Roads:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only. (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan. (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Sebastia. (ii) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, opened fire during house search, and then withdrew at 04:00. • Attacks: At 12:00, the Israeli army stationed at Eval military post opened fire towards the area of Jabal al-Shimali. • Physical Assaults: At 12:00, the Israeli army in the area of al-Jabal al-Shimali physically attacked 4 civilians. • Detention: At 18:20, the Israeli army detained 3 civilians but later handed them to the Palestinian side.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and Hares. In addition, the Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Yassouf and the southern entrance to the village of Deir Istiyya with dirt barricades, as well as the southern entrance to the town of Kafh Hares and the 2 northern entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Qarawa Bani Hassan.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tara checkpoints and prevent civilian vehicles from traveling towards the town of Kafr al-Dik. At 12:00, the Israeli army closed Za'tara checkpoint and impeded traffic upon the arrest of a civilian under the pretext of finding a suspicious object with him. The checkpoint was reopened at 14:20. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided the towns of Brouqin and Kafr al-Dik and patrolled them until 11:15. (ii) At 13:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Hares, lashed with civilians, and physically attacked a child called Imran Zaher Sa'id Shamlawi, 12, and then withdrew at 15:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 09:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the junction of the village of al-'Auja (along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah) and impeded traffic. • <u>Raids:</u> At 18:10, the Israeli army raided the village of al-'Auja and searched 1 building.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on al-Nashash junction (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem), and impeded traffic until

	<p>13:30.</p> <p>(ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the entrance to the town of Jenata, and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(iii) At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint opposite a Palestinian security checkpoint and stoned Palestinian security officers.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <p>(i) At 11:25, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Salah and set up a checkpoint. The raid recurred at 15:00 and then the Israeli army withdrew t 15:30.</p> <p>(ii) At 21:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem.</p> <p>(iii) At 23:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the refuge camp of Aida.</p> • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <p>(i) At 11:00, a public march set out I n the village of al-Ma'sara in protest of the apartheid wall construction. The Israeli army impeded the progress of civilian protestors by putting barbed wires on their way and preventing them from reaching the land threatened with confiscation.</p> <p>(ii) At 13:30, a public march set out in the town of al-Khader and held Friday noon prayer on land threatened with confiscation.</p> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.</p> <p>(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.</p> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and</p>

The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-‘Arroub refugee camp.</p> <p>(ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the refugee camp of al-Arroub, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Beit ‘Ummar, and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 23:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on Halhoul overpass, and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 23:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of al-Fawwar, and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Halhoul and set up a checkpoint in the town center. (ii) At 16:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron and set up a checkpoint in the area of Bi’r al-Mahjar. (iii) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Bani Na’im and clashed with civilians during patrol. • <u>Deaths:</u> At 13:00, child Fares Issa Ahmad al-Najjar from the town of Yatta died in an explosion of an Israeli UXO alongside the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

(ii) Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is partially open to let in a limited quantity of fuel. • <u>Palestinian Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, 14:30, two mortars were fired towards al-Shuja'iya – Nahal Oz Crossing on the Green Line. (ii) At 16:15, armed individuals opened fire towards an Israeli military jeep on the Green Line east of the area of Johr al-Dik.
<p style="text-align: center;">CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> Since 01:00 on April 10, the Israeli army has been raiding east of the refugee camp of al-Breij. The Israeli troops opened fire towards agricultural land and civilian houses, and occupied rooftops of houses and converted them into military posts. In addition, an Israeli drone fired missiles towards armed individuals and residential locales and killed 7 civilians (including 2 children and 2 armed individuals) and injured 29 civilians, including. Moreover, the Israeli troops incurred damage to the electric and water networks and razed agricultural land. children and armed individuals.
