WEST BANK

Closure:

- (i) On April 11st 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Abu Dis.

• Attack:

- (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jabal area near Abu Dis fired stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3 rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4 th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. Flving Checkpoint: At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Malik, temporarily detained Anas Ayash, a resident of Kafr Malik village then released him after confiscating his vehicle. Raid: (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Saleh village until 20:30. (ii) At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 23:00. Attack: (i) At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of "Ofar" military base fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. Demonstrations: (i) At 13:55, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin village protesting against the construction of the wall then clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 14:05, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against than clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injuned an International Peace Activist and left several other suffocating from tear gas inhalation then temporarily detained 2 women and 3 International Journalists then released them at a later time. (iii) At 14:05, a demonstration took place in Bil'in village protesting against the construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. Checkpoints: At 13:50, Israeli forces closed "Movo Dotan" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem for alleged firebombing of a settler vehicle then reopened it at a later time. Attack: At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near a bypass road in Jenin fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades and as a result injured 2 residents: Mohammad Jalamna and Abdallah Abu Ghani. Confiscation of Property: At 09:15, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jamala checkpoint located on the Green Line in North Jenin and confiscated several utility bills of merchants as they were importing products from Israel and impeded the free flow of traffic. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou until 16:50.

Raid

- (i) 13:25, Israeli forces raided Taqou', clashed with several resident then withdrew at 16:50.
- (ii) At 19:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya.
- (iii)At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village until 01:30.

Attack:

- (i) At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah Mosque located in north Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 17:05, Israeli force positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Hamza Batah and Mohamad Abu Khdeir and also left Ghadda Hamad suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained a resident.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hamza Batah (as he was injured) in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 13:35, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'assra village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces prevented protesters from reaching the demonstration site

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa'

HEBRON

- towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9^{th} 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction until 19:30.
- (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awwa (after the alleged firebombing of an Israeli military tower) until 00:20.

• <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 09:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Mar'iya area in Halhul as they escorted several Israeli settlers then withdrew at 13:45.
- (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Haniniya area in Dura, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 15:00.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Sultan Al-Namura in Dura.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:25, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate temporarily detained Abdel Qadder Abu Farah and Yusef Al-Huwar then released them a later time.

• Attack:

- (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Shalashleh road in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya in Hebron, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Mu'taz Al-Afghani and Mohammad Daoud.
- (iii)At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 12:15, a demonstration took place in Al-Ras area in the old city of Hebron protesting against an Israeli court ruling to give Israeli settler ownership of a building owned by Al-Rajabi family in order to turn it into a settlement outpost during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and temporarily detained 4 demonstrators.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
