HEBRON	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close AI-Shuhada' Street, AI-Sahleh and Khuzq AI-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to AI-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of AI-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; AI-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to AI-Thahiriya and AI-Samoa' towns, AI-'Arrub refugee camp, and AI-Tuwani and AI-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to AI-Simiya village, the southern entrance of AI-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting AI-Safa and AI-Dirat
	 and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. Flying Checkpoint: At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 19:20. Raid: (i) At 19:30 on April 11th 2015, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit village and detained a resident. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Karza village, stormed and searched a gas station then withdrew at 14:55. Detention: Israeli forces detained Hassan Al-Haroub in Deir Sammit village.

GAZA STRIP

 At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

NORTHERN GAZA	<u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al Kamma grassing with previous coordination.

GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
