	(i) Since April 13 th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City.		
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.		
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beitlksa villages.		
	• Closure of Main Roads:		
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.

	(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.		
	Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.		
	• Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'EinSamiya villages.

	(i) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Jreir village junction until 16:35.

	(i) At 13:30, Palestinian and international activists demonstrated in Al-Nabi Saleh village against land confiscation; Israeli forces fired teargas towards the protestors, injuring Osama Tamimi in the head as a result of a tear canister,
	assaulted and injured several International peace activists as well causing several cases of suffocation from teargas inhalation.
	(ii) At 13:40, Palestinian and international activists demonstrated in Bi'lin village
	against the construction of the separation wall; Israeli forces clashed with
	protesters, injuring 5 and causing several cases of suffocation from tear gas
	inhalation.

At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbat Al-Tabib (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (iii) At 13:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Eliyas (iv) At 13:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqilya. (v) At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Thulth until (vi) 23:55. Raid: At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village. (i) At 22:45, Israeli forces raided Azzun, because of alleged stoning and (ii) throwing a Molotov cocktail towards an Israeli military jeep, until 24:00. **Demonstrations**: At 13:25, Palestinian and international peace activists marched in KaferOaddum village to protest closures of the entrance gate leading to the village; Israeli forces fired teargas and stun grenades towards demonstrators as they approached the village entrance, injuring MihiyiIshtawi, DiyaJum'a and Muawiya Amar with contusions, leaving several demonstrators suffocating from teargas inhalation. **Wall Gates:** (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the (ii) village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of RasAtiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued inKafrLagef village north of KarneiShomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of KafrThulth town near Ma'aleShomron settlement. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and BeitFurik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of AlonMoreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Oabalan town; the (ii) southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. **NABLUS Checkpoints:** At 05:00Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. Flying checkpoints: At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Deir Sharaf junction (i) until 09:45. (ii) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at "Yitsahar" settlement

	Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years,			
	and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of			
	traffic.

	forces assaulted ObiaydaBrujiya (11 years) leaving him hospitalised with
	contusions.
	Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of BeitJala town.
	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
	(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiyavillageaccess to the area.
	• Flying Checkpoints: At 18:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp; temporaraly detained Ali Shihadeh and Ahmad Al-Krunz and released them at 18:50.

Hebron	(i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Tarmat village.(ii) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 10:00.
	• Settler Violence: At 14:25, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of
	Israeli forces raided Hebron, uprooted several olive trees during which Israeli forces fired teargas grenades towards residents as they attempted to prevent the
	settler attack leaving ShaklerMihanad suffocating of teargas inhalation.
	• <u>Demonstrations:</u>
	At 13:00, Palestinian and international peace activists marched in Tel Al-Rumeideh neighbourhood in Hebron's Old City to protest against settlement expansion and demanded that Al-Shuhada road be reopened (it was closed in 1994).

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 13 March 2012 at 01:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
