	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers escorted by several Israeli Intelligence and Police officers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshiper during which Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque, fired tear gas and stun grenades towards residents and assaulted Amjad Al-Alami (A mosque guard) leaving him injured with contusions and detained resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Rami Al-Foukhawi and Mohammad Abdel Latif in Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim.

(iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Abboud. (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Halamish” settlement and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village, temporarily detained 3 residents including a National Security force officer then released them at a later time and withdrew at 01:15 • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Rimawi (a resident of Beit Rima) at a checkpoint near “Halamish” settlement.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Arab – American University road junction until 18:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, stormed a home, temporarily detained Marwan Al-Atarta assaulted him then realised him at a later time, took photographs of several abandoned homes then withdrew at 13:30. (ii) At 11:45, Israeli forces raided Zeid village, summoned Husam Bara to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 13:00. (iii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Rumana village, stormed and searched 2 homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Zuhier Ahmad in Rumana village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bazariya village junction located in east Anabta until 19:55. • <u>Raids:</u> At 08:20 and again at 23:15, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, set up a checkpoint, positioned in front of Palestinian Police Headquarters; set up another checkpoint then withdrew at 01:20. • <u>Detention:</u> At 21:55, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Taybeh checkpoint located along the Green Line in south West Tulkarem detained Mustafa Ighbariya, a resident of Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun until 20:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Jit village until 10:15. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Immatin village until 13:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces temporarily detained Mohammad Jum'a (17 years old), a resident of Kafr Qaddum as he was assisting his father while farming agricultural land then released him at 20:30. (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned near "Tzufim" settlement gate located in North Qalqiliya, temporarily detained 2 children: Yusef Salemh (12 years old) and Ramadan Abu Shahin (12 years old) for alleged stoning then released them at a later time. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holiday.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:25, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Yitsahar" settlement junction located in North Huwara until 11:00. (ii) At 11:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Shave Shomron" settlement junction until 13:00. (iii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 19:25. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus and detained a resident after storming his home. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Amjad Bahloul in Nablus.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (ii) At 14:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, clashed with several residents, occupied a home owned by Ibrahim Al-Masa'id and converted it into a military post and fired tear gas grenades towards Ahmad Al-Amirs home and as a result causing the home to set fire and detained a child and again at 04:10 Israeli forces raided the camp, detained a child as they stormed his home (2 children detained) then withdrew at 05:00. (iii) At dawn on April 14th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Showered village and stormed several homes. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Usayed Al-Jabari (17 years old) and Mohammad Ziyarna in Al-Ayda camp • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza’s seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire and raiding Khan Yunis.

<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija’iya (Nahal ‘Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
