JERUSALEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beitlksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beitlksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Raid: (i) At 15:25, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis until 16:00. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, assaulted Samir Wahwah, a resident of Hebron leaving him hospitalised with contusions. Physical Assault: At 20:00, Israeli forces assaulted Yunis Al-Adm, a resident of Hebron as he was returning from Jerusalem leaving him hospitalised with contusions. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al- 		

	Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs
	to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
	• Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of
	Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of
	the illegal settlement Ma 'aleAdumim.
	• Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to
	Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
	• Flying Checkpoint:
	(i) At 15:55 and again at 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara bridge until 16:30.

	the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision,

	the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.

	town of Azzun
	(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i> ,
	the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to
	KafrQaddum village.
	• Flying Checkpoints:
	(i) At 11:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun.
	(ii) At 11:45 and again at 20:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the
	entrance of Qalqiliya until 21:50.
	(iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up checkpoint at Jinsafut village junction until
	20:50.
	• Raid:
	(i) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Hablat and Ras-Terih village.
	(ii) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya until 02:05.
	• Attack:
	(i) At 21:25, Israeli forces positioned near the Wall Gate leading to Azzun Atma
	village fired flash and tear gas grenades towards labourers as they attempted to
	enter Israel. Israeli forces then assaulted Hani Al-Tourabi a resident of Nablus.
QALQILYA	(ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces opened fire towards a vehicle as they perused it near Gate
	#109 located south of Qalqiliya.
	• <u>Detention:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at a Wall Gate in southern Azzun
	detained Eyad Salameh, confiscated his identification card after interrogation and
	released him afterwards.
	• Wall Gates:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to
	search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the
	village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows
	residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at
	the entrance to the village of RasAtiya; the Israeli army only allows students
	to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	• Wall Construction: Wall construction continued inKafrLaqif village north of
	KarneiShomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement;
	and east of KafrThulth town near Ma 'aleShomron settlement.
	Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-
	Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the
	settlement of AlonMoreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the
	village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the
	village of Osrin.
NABLUS	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the
NADLUS	southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and
	Qaryut.
	• Checkpoints:
	At 05:00Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to
	cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays.
	All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles
	and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.

	 Flying Checkpoint: At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Shave Shomron" until 14:30. At 12:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beita village junction until 13:50. At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction until 18:45. At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furik until 21:30. At 23:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction. Raid: At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Beita.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. Since April 15th 2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed since the year 2000. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict access at Za'tara checkpoint and impede the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoint: At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Iskaka village. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of DeirIstiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Oja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits.
	 Flying Checkpoint: At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road #90 in Al-Oja village until 12:00. At 20:20 and again at 01:00 and later at 05:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho until 06:15. Detention: On April 15th 2012, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Barakat Abu Jalboush and Zakariya Abu Jalboush as they were returning from the Hashemite Kingdome of Jordan.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in BeitSahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road
	east of BeitFajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting WadiFukin and Al Jab'a villages.

- (ii) Since 14:30on January 10th 2012, the Israeli army closed a road leading to Taqou with dirt mounds.
 Flying Checkpoint: At 22:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ta'mmar village.
 Raid:
 - (i) At 14:35 and again at 22:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader, set up a checkpoint and assaulted Mohammad Khalil then withdrew at 22:40.
 - (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed several homes and detained 3 residents.

• Detention:

- (i) In addition to those mentioned in the previous report at 03:45 on April 15th 2012, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Shawashra during their raid into Ya'bad.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ayed Al Harimy, Ibrahim Al-Harimi and Alaa Awad during their raid into Bethlehem.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of BeitJala town.

Closure

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiyavillageaccess to the area.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Thahriya.
- (ii) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.

Hebron

• Raids:

- (i) At 09:25, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im.
- (ii) At 11:45, Israeli forces raided Qalqis, stormed home under construction owned by Hassan Al-Atrash for allegedly not having proper building permits because of its location in area C which is under Israeli administrative and military control and confiscated construction equipment.
- (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Samit and clashed with residents.
- (iv) At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Dura until 14:00.
- (v) At 14:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 15:00.
- (vi) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta and Beit Ammra village.
- (vii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Sima village.

- (viii) At 23:15, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home and summoned Ayman Al-Jundy to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 18:30, a group of Israeli settlers stormed merchant shops owned by Ramadan Idris in the old city of Hebron and attempted to confiscate his shops.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Palestinian Attack: On the evening of April 15th 2012 Palestinian Gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line. Aerial Assault: At dawn on April 16th 2012, Israeli drones fired a missile towards eastern Gaza.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students and passengers with permits. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing isopen for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, 24 truckloads of wheat and Livestock feed and construction material for internationally funded projects including the export of 2 shipments of flowers
