<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (i) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hizma village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 15th 2015 and again during the evening of April 15th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, detained a resident, clashed with several residents and as a result injured four residents including Suliman Al-Tarabi (who was injured in the eye). (ii) On April 15th 2015, Israeli forces raided Anata and detained a resident. (iii) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Hizma, stormed several merchant shops and took photographs of the shops as well as recording the owner’s names and their telephone numbers. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On April 15th 2015, Israeli forces detained Sana’ Al-Rajabi (A resident of the old city of Jerusalem) as she was exiting Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) On April 15th 2015, Israeli forces detained Aliya Al-Abbassi (A resident of Jerusalem). (iii) Israeli forces detained Bashar Dari in Al-Eisawiya village. (iv) Israeli forces detained Firas Salaymeh in Anta. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near the north junction of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Al-Tiem.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Ofra” settlement until 10:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 15th 2015, Israeli forces raided Bir Ziet and detained two residents. (ii) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Turmus’aya, confiscated a vehicle owned by Odeh Abu Awwad and summoned him to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning and assaulted Shadi Abu Awwad. (iii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Mahakmah checkpoint near “Bet El” settlement detained Layth Zakarnah (A Police officer) {A resident of Jenin}. (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Yazen Makhamssah and William Abdallah in Bir Ziet. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 22:20, Israeli forces stormed Ein Arik village and served a military order for the demolition a home, which will be implemented in 7 days for allegedly being built without a licence.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuhad’a village, stormed and searched several homes, summoned 4 residents: Mohammad Kamil, Foad Assous, Mohammad Assous and Mujahid Assous to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:15. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p style="text-align: center;">TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Check:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Aqaba village.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural

	<p>road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Azzun until 16:55. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:10. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Burin and Tel village. (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction. (iii) At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Assirah Al-Qibliya and Madma villages. (iv) At 00:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Shave Shamron" settlement junction until 01:35. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qalil village, stormed and searched three homes then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Detention:</u> At 03:10 on April 15th 2015, Israeli forces detained Nayef Hamadna during their raid into Assirah Al-Shimaliya as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 08:20, Israeli settlers raided Al-Bithan and Talouza villages then withdrew at 11:00.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik, stormed and searched five homes then withdrew at 03:45.

	<p>up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:55 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 19:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Marj Al-Na'jeh village searched a home then withdrew at 02:55.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 15th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Rashaydeh village and detained a resident. (ii) At dawn on April 15th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Doha and detained a woman. (iii) At dawn on April 15th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Sahur and summoned Saber Awwad to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iv) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhisheh camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed a number of homes and as a result injured Yazid Faraj and summoned Ahmad Al-Ja'fary to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on April 15th 2015, Israeli forces detained the child: Mohammad Al-Qaddi (16 years old) during their raid into Husan village as mentioned

	<p>in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained Majid Rashaydeh in Al-Rashaydeh village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Nisreen Hamaydeh in Al-Doha.</p>
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 and road #35 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Abu Al-Ghouzlan village, which is located in North Al-Thahriya and searched two homes. (ii) At 12:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Shiyoukh, stormed a home and again at dawn on April 16th 2015, stormed several homes, detained two residents and summoned Musa Halayqa to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, set up a checkpoint, stormed and searched two homes then withdrew at 19:20. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Hamaydeh in the old city of Hebron. (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Ghassan Issa ’fin and Ashraf Halayqa in Al-Shiyoukh. • Home Demolition: On April 15th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Dirat village located in east Yatta and served a military order for the demolition of a home owned by Salah Mohammad and served another military order for the halt to construction of a home owned by Mohammad Al-Amour for allegedly being built without licences because of their location in area C which is under Israeli Military and Administrative control.
