JERUSALEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and BeitIksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to BeitIksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Detention: At 22:05, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained Mamoun Aqbat a resident of Nablus. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

- (iii) At 07:45, Israeli forces set up checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village and detained 3 residents including a Police officer.

• Raid:

- (i) At 09:35 and again at 21:00, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed 3 homes and inspected surveillance camera recordings of the house.
- (ii) At 18:45, Israeli forces raided Jit village, surveyed the area, detained Abdallah Ali as he was farming his land and released him at 19:10.
- (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Hajja village.
- (iv) At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at Kafr Qaddum checkpoint detained Mohammad Jum'a, Agel Ishtawi and Mohammad Ishtawi.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of RasAtiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued inKafrLaqif village north of KarneiShomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of KafrThulth town near Ma 'aleShomron settlement.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of AlonMoreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

• Checkpoints:

NABLUS

At 05:00, Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction until 12:35.
- (ii) At 10:30 and again at 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Shave Shomron settlement junction until 24:00.
- (iii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up at the entrance of Burin village.

• Raid:

- (i) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Beita until 11:25.
- (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Orif village until 13:45.
- (iii) At 13:50, Israeli forces raided Asira Al-Qibliya, took photographs of the western area then withdrew at 14:10.

	 (iv) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Balata camp, occupied Abdel Fatah Fayyad's rooftop and converted it into a military post as well as firing teargas and stun grenades then withdrew at 01:55. (v) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Tel village and positioned near Police headquarters then withdrew at 02:15.
	• <u>Settler Violence</u> : At 23:30, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted Ayman Hijja, a
	resident of Deir Sharaf leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • Closure of Main Roads:
	 Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since April 15th 2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses and Ambulances only. The entrance had been closed since the year 2000.
	• <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict access at Za'tara checkpoint and impede the free flow of traffic.
	• Flying Checkpoint: At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Iskaka village until 16:00.
SALFIT	• <u>Destruction of Property</u> : At 08:00, Israeli forces demolished 3 Green houses, 4 water wells and 2 barracks owned by Najeh Ahmad, Ali Ahmad, Sa'adat Ahmad, Majid Ahmad, Mohammad Ahmad, Aziz Ayash and Yusef Ayash in Kafr Al-Dik for allegedly not having proper licencing because of its location in area C which is under Israeli administrative and security control and clashed with residents as they attempted to stop the demolitions then withdrew at 12:10.
	 <u>Land Levelling</u>: At 13:20, Israeli forces levelled approximately 10 acres of land and uprooted several Olive groves and almond trees owned by Samir Al-Masri and Fathi Alqam then withdrew at 16:00. <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area north of DeirIstiya
	town southeast of the illegal settlement.
	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. Checkpoints:
	(i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area.
JERICHO	(ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Oja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits.

	to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues
	to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables
	market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
	(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the
	Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall
	construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied
	them.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-
	Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil
	villages.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling
	along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as
	detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
	(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to
	the entrance to Al-Simiyavillageaccess to the area.
	(v) At 17:20, Israeli military closed the entrance to Qalqis village located in
	southern Hebron with dirt mounds.

- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:50, a group of Israeli settlers erected tents on agricultural land in the area located in eastern Yatta.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
