JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Biddu village until 22:00. (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qalandiya junction until 22:00. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces surrounded Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and prevented residents, students and workers from entering the mosque and again at 11:30, Israeli police fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who were positioned at the mosque entrance to repel a planned settler attack on

	<p>the mosque and as a result injured 20 residents and left 37 other suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</p> <p>(ii) At 13:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound and provoked worshippers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 16th 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Najjib and Moayia Kheiri after storming their homes in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces detained 5 residents: Mohammad Abdel Lattif, Mohammad Abu Sbieh, Mohammad Abu Sneneh and Taysir Abu Sbieh near the main gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces detained Omar Abu Arafah near Bab Al-Al-Saharat gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) At dawn on April 17th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Rimawi in Beit Rima • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.

(ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Meithalun until 13:00. (iii) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, took photographs of several homes then withdrew at 02:40. (iv) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Jenin. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • <u>Raid:</u> At 09:45, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed a home, detained a resident and confiscated a computer and several cellular telephones. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli force detained Musa Shabayta in Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Shave Shamron" settlement until 17:20. (ii) At 18:45, 2 Israeli settlers stormed Burqa village then withdrew at 19:10. (iii) At 00:10, Israeli settlers stormed Huwarra and stoned residents and vehicles passing near "Yitsahar" settlement junction then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Khaled Daraghmeh in in Al-Laban Al-Sharqiya.

(ii) At 21:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 21:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Fasayil village, stormed and searched 4 homes, damaged a home entrance and assaulted Fahed Nuwara as they damaged his furniture then withdrew at 02:45. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 21:25, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Massir Masoud, a resident of Hebron as he was returning from Jordan for allegedly assaulting a customs officer.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.

(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village at the entrance of Beit Sahur until 11:05. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 13:00. (ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Jallah and Doha until 15:00. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 01:45. (iv) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar until 00:30. • <u>Attack:</u> At 07:50 on April 17th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:15, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Husan village and stoned several farmers. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles passing near the west entrance of Beit Fajjar. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Halhul bridge until 08:45.
 - (ii) At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Wadi Qabbun area junction in north Hebron until 16:30.
 - (iii) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron.
 - (iv) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Kahil until 15:00.
 - (v) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrances of Surif and Khursa village until 16:00.
 - (vi) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Karnitina area of the old city of Hebron until 21:00.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At dawn on April 16th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Awa, stormed a home, detained a resident and at 03:00, Israeli forces occupied the rooftops of several homes and converted their rooftops into military posts and detained 2 residents (total of 3 residents detained).
 - (ii) At 08:15, Israeli forces raided Beit Enun and occupied the home owned by Al-Jabari family and converted its rooftop into a military post.
 - (iii) At 08:15, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya.
 - (iv) At 11:30 and again at 03:00, Israeli forces raided Ithna, set up a checkpoint at its entrance thus preventing residents from entering or exiting the area, forced merchant shop owners to close their stores and confiscated surveillance tapes from Sa'di Salome's home then withdrew at 04:45.
 - (v) On April 16th 2014, Israeli forces raided Hebron as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed B'ir Saba' road thus preventing resident from using the road and forced merchant shop owners to close their stores.
- **Attack:**

 - (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning, detained a resident and again at 16:00 confrontations erupted between residents and Israeli forces and as a result injured 7 residents including 4 children: Raed Mujahid (16 years old), Mohammad Natsheh (17 years old), Ahmad Al-Joulani (17 years old), Mu'taz Asfura (16 years old), Ayman Al-Matour, , Omar Al-Natsheh and Sahrq Al-Natsheh.
 - (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
