| ALL DISTRICTS | At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 13 March 2012 at 01:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza & Khan Yunis leaving a female resident injured. |

Detainees Report

• Israeli military court in Ofar prison sentenced Mohammad Jamour, a resident of Bethlehem to 7 month's prison sentence and fined him 1500 NIS approximately \$400 and sentenced Ahmad Abi Diya a resident of Bethlehem to a 5 month prison sentence and fined him 2000 NIS approximately \$530.
