### • <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and clashed with its residents.
- (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aqab village and Al-Barid neighbourhood in north Jerusalem, stormed a home and detained a resident in Al-Barid neighbourhood.

### • Detention:

- (i) At 18:15, Israeli forces detained Jawad Siyam in Salah Al-Din Street in Jerusalem.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Alaa Gayth in Al-Barid neighbourhood in north Jerusalem.
- <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces assaulted Ziyada Khilfawi (70 years old) as she entered Al-Aqsa mosque compound for prayers leaving her hospitalised with contusions.
- **<u>Demonstration</u>**: At 17:00 a demonstration took place near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem in commemoration of Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.

### • Raid:

- (i) At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city.
- (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, clashed with its residents and injured 2 residents: Shadi Safi and Ziyad Shihadeh then detained a resident and withdrew at 03:35.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Ma'rouf Najlat in Al-Jalazun camp.
- Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces: At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Mahkama junction near "Bet El" settlement seized a Palestinian Police vehicles as they were transporting unites from Jericho to Ramallah and were released at a later time.

### • Settler Violence:

- (i) At 22:50, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing along the main road near Al-Jalazun camp.
- (ii) On the evening of April 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Deir Nathim village and uprooted 150 Olive trees and 40 Fig trees owned by Sa'di Al-Khatib.

### • <u>Demonstrations:</u>

- (i) At 11:30, a demonstration took place in Ramallah Jerusalem in commemoration of Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
- (ii) At 12:35, a demonstration took place in Al-Jalazun camp Jerusalem in commemoration of Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian

TUBAS	<ul> <li><u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army increased its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and prevented residents from entering the area.</li> <li><u>Raid:</u> At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Far'a camp, stormed several homes, detained 2 residents and summoned Hamza Aliyan to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.</li> <li><u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Shoubaki and Jamal Salah in Al-Far'a camp.</li> <li><u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:30, a demonstration took place in Tubas Jerusalem in commemoration of Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.</li> </ul>

checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic.

### Raid:

- (i) At 18:35, Israeli forces raided Kafr Sur village until 19:20.
- (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and clashed with its residents.
- (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, stormed a home and detained 2 residents.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Nabil Al-Hamouda and Akram Al-Hamouda in Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem.
- Physical Assault: At 13:05, Israeli forces assaulted Mustafa Al-Aswad as he was herding his sheep near "Enav "settlement leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- **Demonstration:** At 10:00, a demonstration took place in Tulkarem Jerusalem in commemoration of Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons
- Wall Gates: Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.

### **Closure of Roads:**

- Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of (i) Azzun town.
- In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, (ii) the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

### Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Oaddum and assaulted Salah Ishtawi and Anas Barham.
- (ii) At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction.
- (iii) At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Nabi Elisa's village.
- (iv) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the entrance of Izbat Al-Tabib.
- (v) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun.
- **Demonstration:** At 13:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Qalqiliya, in commemoration of Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

### **Wall Gates:**

- The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to (i) search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the (ii) village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

### **Wall Construction:**

- (i) Wall construction resumed Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
- (ii) On January 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces levelled residential land located at the eastern entrance of Azzun Atma for the purpose of constructing

SALFIT	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Roads: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.</li> </ul>

### **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho.
- (ii) At 07:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction.
- Raid: At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Jericho.

### **Temporary Detention:**

- (i) At 10:55, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Ahmad Al-Daghamin, a National Security Officer as he was returning from Jordan.
- (ii) At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Hamra checkpoint temporarily detained Ahmad Salim then released him at 13:15.
- **Demonstration:** At 13:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross in Jericho in commemoration of Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

### Closure:

- The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the (i) exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road (i) between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Oumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" (ii) settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Tagou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iii)
- Flying Checkpoint: At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajiar.
- Raid: At 09:00, Israeli forces raided Taqou' and stormed a local Secondary School.
- **Detention:** At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint detained Sharhabil Masalma, a resident of Hebron and temporally detained Mohammad Masalma and released him at a later time.
- Attack: At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near Bilal Ben Rabah Mosque, fired sound grenades towards Al-Ayda camp despite the fact there were no residents in the area.
- Physical Assault: At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jab'a checkpoint assaulted Suliman Jantouli, a resident of Bethlehem leaving him hospitalised with contusions.

### **Demonstration:**

(i) At 08:55, a demonstration took place Dar Salah village located in east Beit Sahour in commemoration of Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons

during which they clashed with Israeli forces.

- (ii)At 11:55, demonstration took place in Al-Obayda village in commemoration of Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
- (iii) At 14:45 demonstration took place in Um Al-Rakaba area near Al-Nashash junction in commemoration of Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons, clashed with Israeli forces who fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades and as a result injured 4 residents including the child Wael Subieh (16 years old) as well as leaving 5 children suffocated from tear gas inhalation and damaged an ambulance after firing rubber coated steel bullets towards it.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town

### • Closure:

- The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) On December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

## • **Flying Checkpoint:** At 08:20, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at Beit Anun village junction and Wadi Qabun area in north Hebron.

• Raid: At dawn on April 18<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and detained 3 residents.

### • Attack:

- (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 6 residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

### **HEBRON**

(iii) At 17:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
• <b>Detention:</b> Israeli forces detained Abdallah Abu Sharar, Oday Jabura and
Awassim Al-Badawi in Al-Urub camp.

• <u>Demonstration:</u>
(i) At 10:25, a demonstration took place in Ithna in commemoration of
Detainees day and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and
demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which they clashed with Israeli forces.
(ii) At 12:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red
Cross headquarters in Hebron in commemoration of Detainees day and
in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from
Israeli prisons during which they clashed with Israeli forces.
• Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding

the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

### **GAZA STRIP**

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul> <li>At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.</li> <li>On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles.</li> </ul>
