JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 09:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Beit Ikksa checkpoint and prevented a concrete pump truck from entering Beit Ikksa then allowed it to pass through at 09:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:55, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 20:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Koghav Yacoub” settlement fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Absate gate (One of the entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque in the old city of

(ii) At 16:00, a demonstration took place near Abu Dis in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 18:35. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at "Ofar" Prison fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (iii) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Beit Qad until 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Khalouf in Bruqin. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate (300) near Turat village temporarily detained Ramah Khatib, a resident of Thaher Al-Malah village then released him at a later time. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:00, a demonstration took place near the International Red Cross headquarters in Jenin in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 14:15, Israeli forces raided Anabta until 14:20. • Demonstration: At 10:50, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Tulkarem and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) At 18:30 and again at 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • Raid: At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Azzun until 19:10. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army used bomb sniffing dogs to search residents and seized a Palestinian Police vehicle then allowed it to pass through at a later time. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 11:00 and again at 18:25, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 19:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:25, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya until 15:00. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

(ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces positioned near Aqbat Hassan area in Husan village temporarily detained Ahmad Hamarat (17 years old) then released him at a later time. • <u>Home Occupation:</u> At 13:15, Israeli forces stormed Taqou's , occupied Nayef Musa's home and converted its roof top into a military post until 20:00. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:30, a demonstration took place in Bethlehem in solidarity with Palestinian detainee and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close

- the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
 - (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic
 - **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at Halhul bridge, Beit Enun village junction and at the entrance of Farsh Al-Hawa area in north Hebron until 09:00.
 - (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron.
 - (iii) At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge.
 - (iv) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Enun village junction.

 - (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Karmil village as they escorted several Israeli settlers and occupied the roof tops of several homes and converted them into military posts then withdrew at 12:10.
 - (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron, occupied the rooftops of several homes and converted them into military posts and fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 12 residents including 4 children: Anas Salameh (16 years old), Mohammad Qawasmi (15 years old), Yazan Sharif (17 years old), Awni Abu Shamsiya (14 years old), Saed Abu Safi, Za'nun, Khaled Abu Safi, Bashar Omar, Mohammad Al-Zaghir, , Mohammad Salaymeh, Khaled Hajjarat, and Yunis Al-Rajabi leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
 - (iii) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Ithna until 24:00.
 - (iv) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya, stormed a home and detained a resident.
 - (v) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 03:00.
 - (vi) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa, stormed several homes, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 05:25.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) At 03:00 on April 17th 2014, Israeli forces detained Nihad Burtan during their raid into Ithna.

(iii) At 19:55, Israeli forces positioned near a checkpoint near Abu Sneneh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned near Abu Sneneh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Amir Jaber (10 years old) then released him at 21:00. • <u>Assault on Education Sector:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces raided the old city of Hebron and stormed Al-Ibrahimiya school and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at a later time. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> Since April 16th 2014, Israel forces closed the east entrance of Al-Brihimi mosque in the old city of Hebron and prevented residents from conducting prayers in order to allow Israeli settlers to perform Talmudic rituals for Pass over holidays and will reopen it on the evening of April 17th 2014. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On April 17th 2014, a group of Armed Israeli settlers assaulted 2 farmers: Hamad Salibi (77 years old) and Ali Addi as they were farming their agricultural land and stole several farming equipment. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:00, a demonstration took place in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
