## WEST BANK

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.</li> <li>• Since 24:00 on April 17, the Israeli army has been imposing entire closure on the West Bank and denying laborers and civilian access to the city of Jerusalem, except for humanitarian cases. The closure will go on until April 27 midnight.</li> </ul>

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> At 09:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Anata, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> At 13:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Jeeb.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-</li> </ul>

<b>RAMALLAH</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Safa.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Ras Karkar.</li> <li>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the villages of Ras Karkar and Kharbatha Bani Hareth, the western entrance to the village of Ain Yabroud, and the junction of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiah with dirt barricades and cement blocks.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of ‘Atara and impede civilian access.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided the city of al-Bireh, stormed an internet café, set up a checkpoint and withdrew at 00:10.</li> <li>(ii) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Silwad and searched a number of civilian houses.</li> <li>(iii) At 04:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Birzeit.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attacks:</u></b> At 21:30, the Israeli army assigned to guard the apartheid wall south of the city of al-Bireh fired opened fire towards a number of civilians under the pretext of stone throwing.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 22:40, 3 armed settlers entered the village of Beitin and withdrew later towards Beit El settlement.</li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstrations:</u></b> At 14:00, a public march set out in the village of Bil’in with the participation of international peace activist and supporters. The Israeli army clashed with civilian protestors and injured a journalist called Ammar Awad with rubber coated bullets.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area west of the town of ‘Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni’lin and Ni’lin to Deir Qaddis.</li> </ul>

<b>TOUBAS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> At 07:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the refugee camp of al-Far'a.</li> </ul>
<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil's plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun's plain; and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamis.</li> <li>(ii) At 20:00, the Israeli army closed the road connecting the villages of Ramin and Bazaria with dirt barricades.</li> <li>(iii) At 17:00, the Israeli army closed the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun with barbed wires.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarem-Nablus road and at Jubaa checkpoint.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> At 11:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the towns of Zeita-'Atil, and searched civilians and vehicles until 17:30.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 22:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and the refugee camp of Tulkarem, and patrolled them until 23:35.</li> <li>(ii) At 22:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Anabta, clashed with civilians, and withdrew at 23:40.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Arrests:</b> At 11:15, the Israeli army arrested at Jbara checkpoint a civilian called Amjad Adnan Abu Khalil.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> </ul>
<b>QALQILYA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the town of 'Azzun to the village of 'Asla.</li> <li>(iii) At 11:30, the Israeli army closed with dirt barriers the road connecting Azzun town to Izbat Tabib village.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and</li> </ul>

	<p>impede civilian access. At 14:10, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint because 2 veiled female civilians refused to take of the veil. The vehicle was released at 20:40 upon the intervention of the military liaison.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Qalqilya and patrolled it until 01:05.</li> <li>(ii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Kfar Droum and arrested 2 military officers.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> The 2 military officers arrested in the village of Kfar Droum are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Ahmad Abdel Rahman Jumaah; and</li> <li>(b) Baha' Abdel Moumen Jumaah.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 21:20, a bunch of settlers stoned civilian vehicles near the entrance to the village of Izbet al-Tabib.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Land leveling for Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.</li> </ul>

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising).</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and Hares. In addition, the Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Yassouf and the southern entrance to the village of Deir Istiyya with dirt barricades, as well as the southern entrance to the town of Kafl hares and the 2 northern entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Qarawa Bani Hassan.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tara checkpoints and prevent civilian vehicles from traveling towards the town of Kafr al-Dik. <b>BETHLEHEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 16:05, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the village of al-S,hawawreh, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 01:45, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the area of Steih (eastern entrance to the city of Beit Sahour), and searched civilians and vehicles until 02:20.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Fajjar and arrested 3 civiians.</li> <li>(ii) At 20:15, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem, set up a checkpoint in the area of al-Ibiyyat, and withdrew at 21:00.</li> <li>(iii) At 02:55, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Khader and searched 1 civilian house.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> The 3 civilians arrested in the town of Beit Fajjar are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Abdallah Ahmad Thawabteh;</li> <li>(b) Youssef Mohammad Salman; and</li> <li>(c) Mohammad Hussein Taqatqa.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstrations:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 11:00, a public march set out in the village of al-Ma'sara in protest of the apartheid wall construction. The Israeli army clashed with civilian protestors and injured 9, including a child called Qatibah Abu Shaqra, 9.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:00, a public march set out in the town of al-Khader and civilian protestors held Friday noon prayer in land threatened with confiscation for the construction of the apartheid wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.</li> </ul>
<b>HEBRON</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.</p> <p>(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa.   - **Palestinian Attacks:**
    - (i) At 10:00, one unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
    - (ii) At 05:20, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
    - (iii) At 07:00, armed individuals perpetrated a military operation using two booby-trapped vehicles near Karm Abu Salem Crossing on the Green Line east of the city of Rafah and clashed with Israeli troops resulting in the death of 3 armed individuals.
  - **Deaths:** The 3 armed individuals killed near Karm Abu Salem Crossing are:
    - (a) Ghassan Irhim;
    - (b) Mahmoud Abu Samra; and
    - (c) Ahmad Abu Sleiman.
