<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On April 17th 2014, Israeli forces detained Hassan Hassaneh, a resident of Bethlehem as he was in Jerusalem for allegedly entering the city without a permit. (ii) At 18:55, Israeli forces positioned at Bab Al-Salaseleh (a gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque) in the old city of Jerusalem detained Ahmad Farakh • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qalqndiya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem thus preventing residents below the age of 50 from entering the mosque for prayers in order to allow Israeli settler to enter the mosque compound. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim for Sabbath Holiday.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of

	<p>Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Nathim, temporarily detained Nidal Al-Tamimi, and a National Security force officer then released him at 21:25. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village, clashed with its residents and as a result suffocated Muna Al-Tamimi from tear gas inhalation and temporarily detained Abdel Al-Hamid Al-Tamimi (12 years old) and Muhana Al-Tamimi and released them at a later time then withdrew at 15:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 22:45, Israeli forces temporarily detained 3 children: Moath Jabra (15 years old), Qusay Abu Awad (15 years old) and Mohammad Awad (15 years old) near the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus then released them at a later time. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages for Sabbath holiday.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafriyat village until 16:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Silah Al-Harhiya, stormed a home then withdrew at 05:30. (iii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, detained 2 residents in the camp then withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Al-Husrai and Sa’ed Baragish in Jenin camp. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Bayda village, stormed several homes, summoned 4 residents: Saleh Fuqaha, Anwar Fuqaha, Yusef Maraj’a and Samer Maraj’a to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 21:55.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Kafa village junction until 08:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<p>of Azzun town.</p> <p>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holiday.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:25, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrances of Beit Furiq and Beit Dajjan village until 14:10. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Naqura village until 15:45. (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Sahve Shomron” settlement junction until 17:35. (iv) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Yitsahar” settlement junction, temporarily detained Mo’ayad Al-Samar (A National Security officer) then released him at a later time. (v) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 22:00. (vi) At 22:55, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrance of Burin village and beneath Madma Village Bridge. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Asira Al-Shimaliya until 15:35. (ii) At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Nablus as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed Joseph’s Tomb, clashed with residents and left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation then withdrew at 01:50. (iii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Asira Al-Qibliya village.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Alaa Aqel in Kafr Al-Dik village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 08:00 Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District until 13:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nabi Mus area junction located along the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem until 10:00. (ii) At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fasayil village. (iii) At 07:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Jericho • <u>Detention:</u> On April 16th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Ayman Sa'ed, a resident of Nablus.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Taqou'. (iii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem, stormed 4 homes and summoned 3 residents: Salah Ja'adi, Malik Abu Khalif and Abdel Qader Al-Ghazi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction was halted in North West of Beit Jala town for Sabath holiday. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza’s seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Rafah.
