(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second *Intifada*, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to **QALQILYA** KafrQaddum village. **Flying Checkpoints:** (i) At 13:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqiliya. (ii) At 13:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Izbat Al-Tabib village. (iii) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Azzun Bridge until 14:00. (iv) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. (v) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hajja village. Raid: At 22:45, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village until 23:00. (i) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed a home, summoned Ahmad (ii) Anayat to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:15. **Wall Gates:** The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to (i) search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the (ii) village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of RasAtiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted inKafrLagif village north of KarneiShomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of KafrThulth town near Ma 'aleShomron settlement for Sabbath holiday. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of AlonMoreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Oabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. **Checkpoints:** Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All **NABLUS** vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. **Flying Checkpoint:** (i) At 09:35 and again at 23:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction until 01:00. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Subustiya village junction. (iii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf village junction. (iv) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction. (v) At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Madma and Burin village junctions. (vi) At 02:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Yitsahar settlement junction

- (ii) At 14:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Jala until 15:20.

- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Rami Hajjajra during their raid into Bethlehem.
- Provocation of Palestinian Forces: At 19:20 and again at 21:00, Israeli forces stationed near a Palestinian National Security force vehicle near a cemetery in Al-Khader and Israeli forces towed away the vehicle.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction washaltednorthwest of BeitJala town because of Sabbath holiday.

#### **Closure:**

- The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq (i) Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the (ii) Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them.

#### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-(i) Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling (ii) along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as (iii) detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiyavillageaccess to the area.
- Since 17:20 on April 16<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli military closed the entrance to Qalqis (v) village located in southern Hebron with dirt mounds.

#### **Flying Checkpoints:**

- At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna. (i)
- At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Yatta. (ii)
- At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Yatta and Al-Samou and (iii) detained a resident.
- (iv) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction.
- At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron. (v)
- At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in WaiQabbun area located north (vi) of Hebron.
- (vii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar.

#### Raids:

- At 23:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp. (i)
- At 02:10, Israeli raided Yatta and searched a home. (ii)
- At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and stormed a home. (iii)
- **Destruction of Property:** On April 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeliforces served orders for the removal of an electricity network within a time frame of 1 week and demolition orders for several barracks owned by SulimanZa'arna, SulimanJahathba, Mohammad Ishtawi, Khalid Za'arna, Omar Suliman and 4 of his siblings.

#### Hebron

#### • Settlement Activity:

- (i) At 17:45, a group of Israeli settlers stoned several residents in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) At 18:15, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted Hijazi Oday (12 years) injured him in Al-Thahriya.

#### • Demonstrations:

- (i) At 10:50, Palestinian and International peace activists marched towards agricultural land in Yatta, demonstrating land confiscation and the prevention of Palestinian farmers and clashed with Israeli forces that assaulted Mohammad Ihrizat and detained 5 others.
- (ii) At 15:00, Palestinian and International peace activists marched towards agricultural land near "KormiTsuer" settlement demonstrating against settler violence and the prevention of farmers from entering their land during which they clashed with Israeli forces who fired tear gas grenades towards demonstrators leaving several of them suffocating rom tear gas inhalation and also assaulted 4 residents, HamzaHashim (14 years), Yusef Abu Maria, Ahmad Abu Hashim and Muhanad Abu Mariya.

#### • **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces positioned between Yatta and Al-Samou detained Ibrahim Al-Tubas.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Hamada, Fadil Hamada, Naim Al-Odeh, MuadHamadna and Mahmoud Hamadna in Yatta.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town because of Sabbath holiday.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 13 March 2012 at 01:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by firing from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza.
