ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank. • Since 24:00 on April 17, the Israeli army has been imposing entire closure on the West Bank and denying laborers and civilian access to the city of Jerusalem, except for humanitarian cases. The closure will go on until April 27 midnight.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. • Flying Checkpoints: At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of Hizma, and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Abu Dis. (ii) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Anata, searched 1 civilian house, and incurred material damage to the furniture.. (iii) The Israeli army raided the town of al-Ram, searched 1 civilian house, and handed 1 military officer a notification to report to he Israeli military intelligence. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira

	<p>al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to ‘Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba’ road, the area of al-‘Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
RAMALLAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Safa. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Ras Karkar. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the villages of Ras Karkar and Kharbatha Bani Hareth, the western entrance to the village of Ain Yabroud, and the junction of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiah with dirt barricades and cement blocks. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of ‘Atara and impede civilian access. • Flying Checkpoints: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:15, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the refugee camp of al-Jalazon, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the village of Surda and impeded traffic. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Aroura and clashed with civilians during patrol. (ii) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of al-Am’ari in the city of al-Bireh, searched 1 civilian house, and withdrew at 04:00. (iii) At 03:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Ramon and arrested 1 civilian. • Arrests: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:40, the Israeli army arrested at the checkpopint of the town of ‘Atara 1 civilian called Safwat Rashid al-Rimawi, from the town of Beit Rima. (ii) The civilian arrested in the village of Ramon is Ahmad Hani Hatem Kuhleh. • Settler Violence: At 16:15, a bunch of settlers physically assaulted 1 civilian called Khaled Abu Gharra while he was shepherding sheep east of the town of al-Taybeh. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of ‘Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni’lin and Ni’lin to Deir Qaddis.

<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:10, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the village of Kafr Dan, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 21:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Arraba, and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 22:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the north-western entrance to the city of Jenin, detained 2 military officers and led them to Salem detention camp but released them at 23:00 after the intervention of the military liaison. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Kafr Dan. (ii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Arraba, and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Jenin. (iv) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Qabatia, searched a number of civilian houses, and withdrew at 03:40. (v) At 04:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin and its refugee camp, and opened fire intensively during patrol. • Arrests: On April 22, the Israeli army arrested at a checkpoint a civilian called Mohammad Na’im Mohammad Abu Danhash.. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
<p style="text-align: center;">TOUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • Flying Checkpoints: At 00:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the city of Toubas and the town of Iqaba, and fired illumination bombs. • Raids: At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Toubas.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal’a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to ‘Attil’s plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun’s plain; and the entrance to the village of ‘Izbat Abu Khamis. (ii) At 20:00, the Israeli army closed the road connecting the villages of Ramin and Bazaria with dirt barricades. (iii) At 17:00, the Israeli army closed the northern entrance to the town of ‘Azzun with barbed wires. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav

QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the town of ‘Azzun to the village of ‘Asla. (iii) At 11:30, the Israeli army closed with dirt barriers the road connecting Azzun town to Izbat Tabib village. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede civilian access. At 14:10, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint because 2 veiled female civilians refused to take of the veil. The checkpoint was reopened at a later time. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Qalqilya. (ii) At 21:45, the Israeli army raided the town of ‘Azzun and imposed curfew after a cocktail Molotov was hurled at a settler vehicle on Qalqilya – Nablus road. In addition the Israeli army arrested 1 civilian, and remains in the town of ‘Azzun until the time this report is being prepared. • Arrests: The civilian arrested in the town of ‘Azzun is Abdel Mu’ti Ahmad Mahmoud. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. • Wall Construction: Land leveling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun.
NABLUS	<p>Closure of Main Roads:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of

	<p>al Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only. (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan. (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. (iv) At 14:20, the Israeli army closed Huwara checkpoint and impeded traffic until 14:35. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 23, the Israeli army raided the village of Duma and handed 9 house demolition notifications under the pretext of unlicensed construction. (ii) At 14:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Burqa. (iii) At 17:50, the Israeli army raided the village of Sebastia and clashed with civilians during patrol. (iv) At 02:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and the refugee camp of Balata in the city, occupied 1 civilian house overlooking the camp and converted it into a military post. In addition, the Israeli army searched a number of civilian houses and arrested 7 civilians (including 3 brothers). • Arrests: The 7 civilians arrested in the city of Nablus and the refugee camp of Balata are: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Taher & Ahmad & Mahmoud Abdel Mu'ti Ziyadeh; (b) Issam Tufahah; (c) Ra'ed Samih Abu Arab; (d) Mohammad Walid Youssef Habash; and (e) Jasem al-Qanni.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and Hares. In addition, the Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Yassouf and the southern entrance to the village of Deir Istiyya with dirt barricades, as well as the southern entrance to the town of Kafh Hares and the 2 northern entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Qarawa Bani Hassan. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir

	<p>Ballut and Za'tara checkpoints and prevent civilian vehicles from traveling towards the town of Kafr al-Dik. At 17:00, the Israeli army closed Za'tara checkpoint and impeded traffic upon the arrest of a civilian under the pretext of finding a suspicious object with him. The checkpoint was reopened at 17:40.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the village of Marda, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 23:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the towns of Kafr al-Dik and Brouqin, and searched civilians and vehicles until 00:40. JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located

	<p>in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Teqoa and detained 1 child during patrol but released him at a later time. (ii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Khader, arrested 5 civilians, and withdrew at 04:00. (iii) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Za'tarah, searched 7 civilian houses, and handed 1 civilian a notification to report to the Israeli military intelligence. • Arrests: The 5 civilians arrested in the town of al-Khader are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Ahmad Hassan Ya'coub Salah; (b) Walid Khader Ali Salah; (c) Ashraf Salah Eddin Salah; (d) Ayman Ishak Marzouk Salah; and (e) Ali Abdek Fattah Mahmoud Salah. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi

	<p>neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-‘Arroub refugee camp.</p> <p>(ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the town of Halhoul overpass, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 12:15, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of Nouba, and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron. The raid recurred at 17:25 during which the Israeli troops set up a checkpoint in the area of Bi’r al-Mahjar. The raid occurred for the third time at 01:50 during which the Israeli army searched 1 civilian house. (ii) At 12:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Ula and searched 2 civilian houses. (iii) At 23:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Sa’ir and clashed with civilians during patrol. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since April 20, the Israeli army has been intensifying restrictions in the old city of Hebron. The Israeli troops set up a number of checkpoints, occupied rooftops of civilian houses, and prevented pupils from reaching their schools, under the pretext of securing security to settlers during the Passover. (ii) At 11:00, the Israeli army detained 5 civilian employees who work in the municipality in the old city of Hebron and released them later after the intervention of the military liaison. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

	<p>Hanoun, opened fire and fired tank missiles towards civilian houses, occupied rooftops of civilian houses and converted them into military posts, besieged a number of civilian houses, and clashed with armed individuals. In addition, an Israeli drone fired one missile towards armed individuals, and killed a physically handicapped civilian, injured 6 civilians, including 3 armed individuals. Furthermore, the Israeli army razed agricultural land and remains in Beit Hanoun until the time this report is being prepared.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attacks: At 17:00, the Israeli army fired tank missiles from its posts inside the Green Line towards agricultural land east of the town of Jabalia. • Deaths: The civilian killed in the town of Beit Hanoun is Daoud al—Kafarneh, 55. • Palestinian Attacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:55, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line. (ii) At 18:30, one unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. (ii) Al-Shuja'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. • Palestinian Attacks: At 20:45, one unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
KHAN YOUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, the Israeli army raided the area east of the town of Khuza'a and opened fire intensively towards civilian houses and agricultural land. (ii) At 13:15, the Israeli army raided east of the town of Abassan al-Kabira and clashed with armed individuals. (iii) At 02:00, the Israeli army east of the village of Abassan al-Saghira, opened fire intensively, occupied rooftops of civilian houses and converted them into military posts, searched a number of civilian houses, and clashed with armed individuals.
