ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. On 05 January 2009, the Israeli authorities issued Military Order # S/02/09 on the closure of and denial of civilian access to the "demarcation area" along the Wall in the area surrounding the city of Jerusalem. Accordingly, local residents and civilians holding permits can access this area through crossings and gates set up at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. (The demarcation area is defined by a set of military orders relating to land confiscation for Wall construction). Beginning on 02 April 2009, the Israeli army has continued to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill located in an area between the village of Biddu and Beit Ikse due to its geographical significance as it overlooks the city of Jerusalem. Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'. The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section, separating the area of Dahiyat al Bareed from the town of Ar Ram. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> On 23 April 2009, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Anata and searched a number of mechanics' workshops. On 23 April 2009, the Israeli army raided the village of Biddu and arrested 1 civilian. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Mohammed Sabri 'Ayyash in the village of Biddu. Detentions: At 11:15, Israeli troop positioned at the checkpoint set up near the village of Jaba' detained 3 Palestinian security officers, including 2 General Intelligence officers and 1 Preventive Security officer, and released them at 11:30, after coordination with the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu; in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina; west of the village of Al Jib; in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna; south of the village of Beit Hanina; and in the area surrounding the checkpoint set up at the entrance to Shu'fat refugee camp.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & EL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades and cement blocks the road connecting the villages of Ras Karkar and Kharbatha Bani Harith; the entrances to the villages of Sinjil, Saffa, and 'Ein Yabrud; and the junction to the villages of Kafr Malik – 'Ein Samiya. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint on the overpass to 'Atara town and impede civilian access. • Flying Checkpoint: At 00:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Surda along the road connecting the city of Ramallah to the town of Bir Zeit and searched civilians and vehicles until 03:15. • Raids/Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On 22 April 2009, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Arura and arrested 1 civilian. (ii) At 16:25, the Israeli army raided the cities of Ramallah and El Bireh, searched 1 building in the city of Ramallah, and withdrew at 17:30. (iii) At 23:20, the Israeli army raided the village of 'Ein Qiniya, searched 1 house, detained 1 female civilian, and released her at 00:30. (iv) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled a residential neighbourhood in the city of Ramallah. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Abdul Razzaq al Khuseib in the town of 'Arura. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of 'Abud town and in the areas of Al Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 10:45, Israeli troops positioned at Al Jalama checkpoint detained a vehicle belonging to the Palestinian Customs Police and released it at 11:40, after coordination with the Israeli authorities (through the DCO). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint in the eastern Tubas district, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • <u>Raids/Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Al Far'a refugee camp. At 01:20, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp again, searched 1 building, and opened indiscriminate fire. At 02:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) At 23:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Tubas and patrolled the area until 02:30.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Shufa. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at 'Einav checkpoint set up on Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the towns of 'Attil and Deir al Ghusun and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 00:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem as well as Tulkarem refugee camp, served summons to a number of civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency, and withdrew at 23:00. (ii) At 22:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Deir al Ghusun. (iii) At 22:25, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of 'Attil. (iv) At 22:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Lid and served summons to 2 civilians as well as to Nahed Abdul Latif Mohammed Salameh, a Palestinian Preventive Security officer, to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.

<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun. (ii) Beginning on 17 March 2009, the Israeli army has continued to close the northern entrance to the town of ‘Azzun with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and to impede civilian access. At 13:45, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint and denied civilian access until 14:45. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Qalqiliya. At 220:00, the Israeli army raided the city again and searched 1 house. At 02:35, the Israeli army raided the city for the third time and patrolled the area until 04:40. (ii) At 18:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of ‘Azzun. (iii) At 00:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Hajja, searched 1 house, and withdrew at 04:45. • <u>Detention:</u> At 22:10, Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya detained Hassam Mohammed Hamdan, a Palestinian General Intelligence officer, and released him later, after coordination with the Israeli authorities (through the DCO). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Having completed the Wall-related infrastructure, land levelling for Wall construction ceased in the towns of 'Azzun and Kafr Thulth as well as in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif. (ii) Wall construction continues south of the town of Jayyus as well as near the settlement of Alfe Menashe in the villages of Ras Tira, Magharet ad Dab'a, and Wadi ar Rasha south of the city of Qalqiliya.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the roads of Sarra-Jit; Til-Burin; Beit Furik-Salem; the road between the town of 'Aqraba and the main road; and the eastern entrance to the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya. The Israeli army also continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Til and Madama; the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut; the eastern entrance to the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya; the western entrance to the town of 'Aqraba; the southern entrance to the village of Duma; the northern entrance to the town of Qabalan; the western entrance to the village of Majdal Bani Fadil; and the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to restrict civilian daily passage along the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to Deir Sharaf village and the settlement of Shavei Shomron between 06:00 and 21:00. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only. (ii) The Israeli army continues to allow Palestinians holding Israeli-issued IDs to access the city of Nablus by their private vehicles through Beit Furik checkpoint and Biet Iba iron gate. Additionally, the Israeli army allows free access to physicians, who are residents of the city of Nablus. (iii) Beginning on 15 February 2009, the Israeli army has allowed free access by private vehicles to all residents of the city of Nablus, who are above 50 years of age and in company with their families, through checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus. (iv) Having removed Beit Iba checkpoint, the Israeli army installed an iron gate near the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf along the Nablus-Tulkarem main road. The iron gate is open everyday between 05:00 and 24:00 to allow civilian access without permits. • Raids/Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:55, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya and patrolled the area until 12:00. (ii) At 12:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Yasid. (iii) At 17:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, set up a checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. At 02:15, the Israeli army raided the city again, arrested 3 civilians, and withdrew at 04:45. (iv) At 17:45, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Sharaf and fired sound grenades while it was patrolling the area. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Ahsraf Qarqash; (ii) Adham Tashtoush; and (iii) Wajdi Khashaneh.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the northern entrance to the city of Salfit. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and iron gates the northern entrance to the town of Bruqin and the western entrance to the town of Kafr Ad Dik. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at the Za'tara junction checkpoint. • Construction of Military Post: At 14:00, Israeli troops erected and took position a tent northwest of the town of Kafr ad Dik along the settler bypass road connecting the settlements of Zahav and Bedo'il.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Haris north of the settlement of Ariel.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) According to Military Order # 07/02/S, the Israeli army has continued since 15 September 2007 to deny civilian access to an area measuring 22 <i>dunums</i> (5.436 acres) of land in the area of Mazmuriya in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. The land was confiscated pursuant to Military Order # 07/31/T. • Closure of Main Roads: In addition to 2 side roads east and south of the village of Al Walaja, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad; Talita-Nazlet as Sidr in the city of Beit Jala; Al Khadr -Road # 60; Al Khadr -Beit Jala Housing Project; Wadi Rahal-Efrat; and the side road east of the town of Beit Fajjar. • Flying Checkpoint: At 09:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the town of Tuqu' and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army raided 'Ayda refugee camp in the city of Bethlehem and patrolled the area until 09:20. (ii) At 10:25, the Israeli army raided the village of Ash Shawawra and served summons to Mohammed Ahmed as Dir'awi to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. (iii) At 10:55, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Al Khadr. At 23:40, the Israeli army raided the town again, set up a checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. (iv) At 12:10, and again at 23:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem. • Palestinian Security Measure: At 00:30, Palestinian security forces handed over to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO) an Israeli female settler, after she had gained access into the city of Bethlehem. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of Ifrat settlement; and in the area surrounding the village of Al Walaja.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prevent civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron.
 - (iii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued Military Order # 09/06/S for closure of the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta, evacuation of civilian residents, and prevention of civilian access to the area. According to Military Orders # 05/03/T and 05/04/T, land in this area was confiscated for Wall construction.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the town of As Samoa'; the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to Al Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; as well as the entrances to Al 'Arrub refugee camp and the village of At Tuwani.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Ash Shalala Old Street leading to the old city of Hebron.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to open the iron gate on the Farsh Al Hawa junction to Road # 35, which leads to Tarqumiya Crossing, from 05:00 until 07:00 and from 09:00 until 13:00.
 - (v) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the entrances to the village of 'Abda and Khirbet Karma.
 - (vi) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks a side road along Road # 35 in the area of Wadi Qeizun near the overpass to the town of Halhul (the northern entrance to the city of Hebron).
- **Flying Checkpoints:**
 - (i) At 02:30 on 23 April 2009, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested a student the Al 'Arrub College of Agriculture.
 - (ii) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Sa'ir and searched civilians and vehicles.

	<p>(iii) At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raids: (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Dura. (ii) At 10:25, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, set up 2 checkpoints, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. At 15:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city again. At 20:35, the Israeli army raided the city for the third time, set up 3 checkpoints, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area until 21:30. (iii) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area of Ras al 'Arudh in the town of Sa'ir. (iv) At 00:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Surif. (v) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Adh Dhahiriya and patrolled the area until 04:00. • Arrest: Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up at the entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp arrested Huthayfah Sameh al 'Ar'ar. • Detentions: At 13:40, Israeli troops positioned near the Ibrahim Mosque in the old city of Hebron detained the Undersecretary of the Palestinian Ministry of Information as well as a foreign delegation. Following coordination with the Israeli authorities (through the DCO), Israeli troops allowed access to all detained persons. • Destruction of Property: At 12:00, the Israeli army demolished makeshift houses as well as sheep pens belonging to Bedouins in the vicinity of the village of Um al Kheir, claiming that they were in close proximity to the settlement of Karmi'el. • Settler Violence: At 09:50, Israeli troops threw stones and garbage at civilians along Ash Shalala Street in the old city of Hebron. • Wall Construction: (i) Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal and in the area between southeast of the village of 'Arab ar Ramadin and the village of Imneizil. (ii) Beginning on 20 April 2009, land levelling for Wall construction has continued in the area surrounding the settlement of Eshkelot southwest of the town of Adh Dhahiriya.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by the Israeli authorities came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire for a week. Later, armed Palestinian groups extended the ceasefire until 05 February 2009. Despite the fact that the extension period expired, the ceasefire continues to hold pending negotiations carried out by Egypt.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Violation of the Ceasefire:</u> The Israeli army raided Palestinian territory and opened intensive fire towards civilians and property in the districts of Northern Gaza and Central Gaza. Israeli navy boats also opened intensive fire towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea off the district of Northern Gaza and Gaza city.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is closed. • <u>Attack:</u> In the morning of 23 April 2009, Israeli navy boats opened intensive fire towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea off As Sudaniya beach northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. • <u>Raid/Attack/Land Levelling:</u> At dawn on 24 April 2009, the Israeli army, including several armoured vehicles and bulldozers, raided Palestinian territory northeast of the town of Beit Hanun. While levelling agricultural land, the Israeli army also opened intensive fire towards civilians and property. In addition, an armed confrontation was reported to have taken place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> At dawn on 24 April 2009, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al Muntar (Karnei) Crossing is closed. (ii) Ash Shuja'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is partially open for transportation of fuel. • <u>Attack:</u> In the morning of 23 April 2009, Israeli navy boats opened intensive fire towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea off Gaza city. • <u>Air Patrol:</u> At 11:40, Israeli F16 combat aircraft patrolled the skies over Gaza city.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid/Attack/Land Levelling:</u> At dawn on 24 April 2009, the Israeli army, including several armoured vehicles and bulldozers, raided Palestinian territory east of Al Bureij refugee camp. While levelling farmland cultivated with fruit-bearing trees, the Israeli army also opened intensive fire towards civilians and property.
