JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 18:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Beit Ikksa checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 18:35. • <u>Raid:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aqab and stormed an apartment building. • <u>Detention:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces detained Khaled Al-Shawarna in Al-Aqsa mosque compound the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Yabrud bridge until 13:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Saleh, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes, detained 2 residents and temporarily detained Rafat Al-Tamimi, a National Security force officer then released him at a later time then withdrew at 03:00. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazun camp, detained 2 residents including a child then withdrew at 05:00. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Al-Tamimi and Rayan Al-Tamimi in Al-Nabi Saleh village. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Jablun village, stormed a home, placed number tags on 6 homes located 300 m on the west side of the wall then withdrew at 15:00. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Za'tara village, stormed 2 homes, and summoned Mohammad Sadaqa to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:00. (iii) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Jenin until 03:25. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Far'ata camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched 2 homes and as a result injured Jihad Hassan, detained a residents then withdrew at 05:00. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Jabr Siyam in Al-Far'ata camp.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Kafriyat road which connects Tulkarem and Qalqiliya until 11:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00 on April 23rd 2014 and again at 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya and detained a resident. (ii) At 00:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Kafr Thulth until 01:15. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun until 23:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Saleh Daud (A residents of Qalqiliya) at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Tel village until 01:15. (ii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided the east neighbourhood of Nablus until 04:10.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from

	<p>08:00 until 09:20.</p> <p>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:20, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Qarwat Bani Hassan and damaged the limbs of several Olive and fruit bearing trees. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00 and again at 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 11:55. (iii) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Jericho, temporarily detained Hussein Yusef (A Palestinian Intelligence officer) then released him at a later time then withdrew at 18:30. (iv) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction, detained 2 residents, assaulted and injured 4 residents: Bassam Tubasi, Bassam Ghawawdeh, Jamal Tubasi and Mohammad Tubas as well as damaging their vehicle. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge crossing detained Islam Miflih, a resident of Nablus as he was travelling to Jordan. (ii) Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint at the Daed Seas junction detained 2 residents: Tarik Tubasi and Issa Tubasi , residents of Hebron.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.

(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Dar Salah village until 10:45. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar until 13:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30 and again at 01:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar stormed a home then withdrew at 02:10. (ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Sahur until 09:55. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.

- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Yunis area along the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem until 11:00.
 - (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna until 12:30.
 - (iii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul bridge until 18:00.
 - (iv) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Einun village junction until 18:00.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At dawn on April 23rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, detained a resident and again at 21:00 detained another resident then withdrew at 21:30.
 - (ii) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 12:10.
 - (iii) At 10:30, Israeli force raided Yatta, stormed 2 homes then withdrew at 11:30.
 - (iv) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Um-Rish village , stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 23:40.
 - (v) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit village, stormed and searched several home, detained 8 residents and summoned 4 residents: Jihad Huroub (A University Student), Alla Al-Hurub, Eyad Al-Hurub and Raed Al-Hurub to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 06:00.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) On April 23rd 2014, Israeli forces detained Ra'fat Awad (16 years old), resident of Beit Ummar he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Raf'at Mustafa and Ayman Al-Za'aqiq in Beit Ummar.
 - (iii) Israeli forces detained 8 residents: Wael Al-Hurub, Mahmoud Abu Harid, Daoud Al-Aziz, Musa Al-Hurub, Jihad Al-Shawarna, Munir Al-Awawdeh , Ra'fat Al-Awawdeh and Azzam Al-Awawdeh in Deir Sammit.
 - (iv) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Najjar in Al-Fuwar camp.
 - **Destruction of Property:** At 11:30, Israeli forces stormed agricultural land in Beit Ummar and uprooted several fruit bearing trees owned by Ali Awad as they were conducting military training in the area.
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and raiding Khan Yunis and fired Artillery shells from their positions behind the Green line towards North Gaza. • Israeli Drones broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles towards North Gaza and as a result injured 6 residents including 2 children. • Israeli naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza, Gaza and Rafah. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and launching 3 projectiles towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the afternoon of April 24th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched 3 Tank Artillery shells towards agricultural land in Beit Hanun. (ii) On the afternoon of April 24th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Waha area located north west of Beit Lahiya and detained 2 fishermen. • <u>Air Assault:</u> On the afternoon of April 23rd, 2014, Israeli drones launched 2 missiles towards a Palestinian gunman's motorcycle in Beit Lahiya and as a result injured 6 residents including 2 children. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Hamdi Sultan and Mohammad Zayed off the shores of Al-Waha area located North West of Beit Lahiya. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> On the evening of April 23rd 2014, Palestinian gunmen launched 3 projectiles towards the Green Line
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed.
