• Closure:

- (i) On April 24th 2015 the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Hizma village and forcibly closed several merchant shops for alleged stoning of a settler vehicle.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces detained the child Ahmad Ashayer (17 years old) in Al-Tur neighbourhood.

Attack:

- (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Kabsah area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 00:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Za'im checkpoint opened fire towards a child for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier and as a result killed the child.
- (v) At 00:40, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.
	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic. <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballout. <u>Raid:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces raided Masahma village.

- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 10:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata until 11:05.
- Raid: At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Deir Salah village.
- Attack:
 - (i) At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 17:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Khadr fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **<u>Demonstration</u>**: At 13:50, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'sra village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and prevented them from reaching the demonstration site.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhoul Bridge until 20:55.
- **<u>Detention:</u>** At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Salah Al-Din Al-Ja'bari.

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
 - Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result injured a resident.
