| <p>JERUSALEM</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Al-Ram. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village and impeded the free flow of traffic. (iv) At 23:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jaba’ village junction and prevented residents from travelling to Ramallah. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on April 25th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Duqqu village and summoned Mahdi Hassan to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 05:00 on April 25th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Anan village and clashed with several residents. (iii). • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of Al-Eisawiya village, Al-Tour and Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhoods fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 26 residents including 2 Paramedics and also left 48 residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Zaytoun neighbourhood in east Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. |

(vii) At 00:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Majlis and Hata gates (Main entrances gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem), in Aqbat Al-Khadr area and in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Settler Violence: At 23:00, Israeli settlers positioned near a settlement outpost in Silwan opened fire towards several residents for allegedly hurling a fire bomb towards the settlement. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. |

(ii) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Abboud. (iii) At 21:10, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Khirbathat Al-Misbah village until 23:00. • Attack: At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Urr Al-Tahta fired flash grenades into the sky as they were searching for unidentified assailants who hurled a firebomb towards an Israeli bus. • Settler Violence: At 21:05, an Israeli settler positioned near "Bet El" settlement stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road leading to Al-Jalazoun camp and as a result damaged a vehicle owned by Salah Allan (a resident of Al-Jalazoun camp). |

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Arrabah and Al-Mansourah village until 18:55. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it. |

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned at the east entrance of Kafr Qaddum fired tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. |

| ALL DISTRICTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Gaza, Central Gaza and Khan Yunis.
