- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Beit Sahur until 11:10.
- (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 19:25.
- Raid: At 22:10, Israeli forces raided Taqou's, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 23:30

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction was halted in North West of Beit Jala town for Sabath holiday.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the

HEBRON

Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints in Wadi Aziz area located between Surif and Harris village, at Ithna junction and at Kharsa village junction, temporarily detained Amin Abu Atwan at the entrance of Ithna then released him at 18:05.

• Raid:

- (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 12:10.
- (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Burj village damaged a vehicle owned by Zied Hijjeh after it crashed while being apprehended by Israeli military vehicles near the wall gate.
- (iii)At 20:20, Israeli forces raided Ithna, clashed with residents as they stormed a carpentry shop and 2 homes and as a result injured Rafaat Abu Hashisheh, detained a resident then withdrew at 21:45
- (iv) At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron
- (v) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou', stormed 2 homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:00.
- (vi) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya, took photographs several old homes, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 06:00.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) Israeli forces detained Ashraf Tuma'zi in Ithna.
- (ii)Israeli forces detained Ahmad Hamoudeh in Al-Samou'.
- (iii) Israel forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Hassan Abu Adabous and Mohammad Sa'di Abu Adabous in Tarqumiya.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town for Sabbath holiday.

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into
effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an
agreement to cease fire.

• On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
