<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 08:00, Israeli forces closed Shu’fat checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it later. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 07:00 on April 26th 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 21:50. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Mukhmas village and clashed with several residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces detained Nadim Issa (A resident of Bethlehem) in Jerusalem for allegedly entering the city without a valid permit. (ii) At dawn on April 27th 2015, Israeli forces detained three residents: Ahmad Owisat, Mohammad Owisat and Mo’men Hashimah after storming their homes in Jabal Al-Mukabir and the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of Wadi Al-Joz neighbourhoods fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Su'fat camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 02:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (As they were participating in the funeral of Ali Abu Ghanam (17 years old) who was killed by Israeli forces. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sinjil until 23:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00 and again at 14:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 17:00. (ii) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 03:30. (iii) At 04:55, Israeli forces raided Silwad, stormed a building then withdrew at 05:35. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 21:35, an Israeli soldier positioned near "Bet El" settlement stoned a vehicle owned by Mohammad Al-Nabali (A resident of Al-Jalazoun) and as a result shattered the front windshield as he was travelling along the main road leading to Al-Jalazoun camp.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Arrabah village junction until 23:30. (ii) At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za'tarah village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Jenin, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched three homes then withdrew at 05:20.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At dawn on April 27th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Silah Al-Harthiya and stormed several homes. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned at Salem checkpoint detained Raed Saleem (A National Security Force officer) as he was awaiting the release of his nephew from Israeli Prison. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned at Barta'a checkpoint detained Mohammad Qubaha (A National Security Force Officer). (iii) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned at Barta'a checkpoint detained Anas Obiedi (a resident of Talouza). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Thanabah neighbourhood in Tulkarem, inspected several water wells then withdrew at 10:50.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, temporarily detained Abdel-Hamid Al-Khateeb (A Palestinian Intelligence Officer) then released him at 10:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, took photographs of Odeh Saleem's home then withdrew at 02:50. • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:55, Israeli forces positioned at the east entrance of Kafr Qaddum fired tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and temporarily detained Ehab Ali then released him later. • <u>Injury:</u> At 16:10 on April 25th 2015, 2 children: Wissam Al-Shiekh (10 years old) and Nasser Nimer (10 years old) after a tear gas grenade fired by Israeli forces exploded prematurely as they were walking near a field in Azzun Atmah. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunums of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.

<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 16:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qabalan village junction until 10:00. (ii) At 14:20, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near "Yitsahar" checkpoint located in North Huwarah, temporarily seized a bus carrying several school children then allowed them to pass through later. (iii) At 16:20 and again at 02:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Shave Shomron settlement junction, detained a Presidential Guard and a resident. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 26th 2015, Israeli forces raided Assira Al-Shimaliya, stormed 2 homes and forced the wife of Riyadh Yassin to sign on a document (the subject of the document is unknown). (ii) At 10:05, Israeli forces raided Burin village, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes and temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning then withdrew at 12:15. (iii) At 22:45, Israeli forces raided Rujieb village. (iv) At 03:35, Israeli forces raided Bazariya village, stormed and searched a home, confiscated three computers then withdrew at 03:45. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Samed Salem (A resident of Bazariya) and Oman Hardan (A resident of Jenin) at a checkpoint near Shave Shomron settlement. • Settler Violence: At 05:00, Israeli settlers stormed Josephs Tomb in Nablus then where chased away by Palestinian Police whom guarding the area.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Ballout, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 19:25.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 09:00. (ii) At 17:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction. • Raid: At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Aqbat Al-Jabr camp, stormed three homes, summoned 2 residents: Mahmoud Al-Mimi and Mohammad Muslieh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:00. • Injury: At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge assaulted Fadi Al-

<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Shawarat village until 12:00. • Raid: At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, stormed and searched six homes, temporarily detained Musa Ja'rah then released him at 04:30. • Attack: At 07:40, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned at near Abu Al-Rish checkpoint in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and Central Gaza and as a result injured a resident in North Gaza. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaz.
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers in Abu Safiya area located in east Jabaliya and as a result injured Rami Matar. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of AL-Sudaniya area in west Beit Lahiya.
<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija’iya (Nahal ‘Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p>CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 07:30 on April 26th 2015, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards agricultural land located in east Al-Maghazi camp.

RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u><ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) Yasser ‘Arafat International Airport remains closed.(ii) Rafah (<i>Al ‘Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed.(iii) Sufa Crossing is closed.(iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
