JERUSALEM	 Closure: (i) On 27.04.2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads:
	the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 21:55, at Attara town bridge Settler Violence: At 15:20, a group of Israeli settlers raided Betelo village Demonstration: (i) At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Al Nabi Saleh against the the confiscation of the village's land; Israeli forces clashed with the demonstrators leaving with Israeli forces leaving several demonstrators injured including a journalist and several others suffocating as a result of tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:30, two demonstrations took place in Nilin town and Bilin village against the confiscation of the village's land; Israeli forces clashed with the demonstrators with Israeli forces leaving Tarek Khatib and several demonstrators injured including a journalist and several others suffocating as a result of tear gas inhalation.

JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Raids: At 16:30, at Arbuna village. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00. <u>Deportation:</u> At 12:50, Israeli forces forced out Adel Daraghma from staying in his home in Ein Hilwa to an area near Tayyasir town.
TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoints: The Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoint: BetweeenBetween 20:20 – 21:30, at Shweakh neighbourhood. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	 Closure of Roads: Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Flying Checkpoint: At 09:35, at the entrance of Kafer Qaddum village At 11:15, at the entrance of Azzun town and Izbet AlTabeeb village. Raids: Between 15:50 – 19:40, at Azzun town, searched homes and detained 3 minors. Detention: Abed Dahbur 16 years, Bara Abu Hanyia 15 years and Mohammed Monthana 15 years old. Demonstration: At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Kafer Qaddum village, against the closure of the eastern entrance of the village. Israeli forces fired rubber coated bullets and tear gas towards the demonstrators; resulting in injuring several people among them Bashar Nazzal a journalist. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.

	Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
	 Checkpoints: (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Mount Jerzim) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 (ii) At 05:00 Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.
NABLUS	 Flying Checkpoints: Between 12:30 – 13:30, at the entrance of Madama village Between 15:40 – 17:20, at the entrance of Sawyia village. At 17:20 and repeated at 22:30 – 23:20, at Sheve Shamron settlement junction. Raids: Between 09:00 – 12:40, at Kafer Khalel village Between 11:30 – 12:50, at Rujeb village and searched homes. Between 00:40 – 01:35, at Tal village, searched a house and summoned Izzat Yassin for questioning. At 01:00, at East of Nablus city.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000. Checkpoints: Between 14:45 – 15:30, the Israeli army continues to increase restrictions on access at the Za'tara checkpoint and impedes the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoints: At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Istyia town. At 23:45, between Bedyia town Masha villages. Raids: Between 10:00 – 10:20, at Sarta village and took pictures of an area near Ali Musa property. Demonstration: At 12:50, a demonstration took place against the confiscation of land. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. Checkpoints:

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards fishermen boats North Gaza.
