JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 27th 2014, Israeli forces raided Biddu, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and summoned Haytham Hamadin to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (ii) At dawn on April 27th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village, clashed with several residents as they stormed a merchant shop, assaulted and injured Sa’ed Mustafa leaving him hospitalised with contusions and detained 2 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Nabil Mustafa in Al-Isawiya village. • <u>Expulsion:</u> On APRIL 27TH 2014, Israeli forces served expulsion orders for 2

	<p>residents: Aboud Abu Sbeih and Tarik Al-Zaraba preventing them from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 3 months placed them under house arrest for a period of 10 days and imposed a financial penalty of 1000 NIS approximately \$285.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:40, Israeli settlers escorted by several Israeli Intelligence and Police officers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshiper during which Israeli forces installed surveillance cameras overlooking the main entrance gate of Al-Aqsa mosque compound. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 16:00, a demonstration took place with several University students in Abu Dis protesting Settlement Activity and settler violence on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem during which they clashed with Israeli forces • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near Atara Bridge in North Bir Ziet fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and

	<p>impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jabbara junction in south Tulkarem until 17:15. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:15 and again at 22:10, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, stormed several merchant shops, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 01:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun until 02:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Izbit Al-Tabib village until 20:30. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Jinsafut village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holiday.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunums of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq. (ii) At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sarah village and detained a University student. (iii) At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Yitsahar” settlement junction in north Huwara until 23:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:25, Israeli forces raided Osirin village after unidentified assailants hurled a fire bomb towards an Israeli military vehicle during which Israeli forces opened fire and launched stun grenades towards residents then withdrew at 22:30.

	<p>(ii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Nablus, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning and withdrew at 02:50.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Oday Jum'a , a resident of Kafr Qaddum village, in Sarah village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:50, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Huwara and chopped the limbs of 60 Olive trees owned by Murad Odeh, Bashir Odeh and Nayef Al-Zifa.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 20; 15, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 09:55, Israeli forces raided Harris village, temporarily detained 2 residents: Mohammad Sultan and Murad Sultan then released them after questioning and withdrew at 10:25. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 20:00. • <u>Detention:</u> On April 27th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Ahmadin Abu Maria, a resident of Beit Ummar in Hebron as he was returning from Jordan
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with

(iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:30 on April 17th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Doha and detained a resident. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Za'tara, stormed and searched a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:00. (iii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 03:45. (iv) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem, stormed and searched a home , detained a resident then withdrew at 03:55. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:55, Israeli forces detained Muhanad Abu Sarour, a resident of Ayda camp in Bethlehem as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence based on a prior summon. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Aliyah in Al-Doha. (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Makhtoub in Za'tara. (iv) Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Arafa in Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:25, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and attack dogs stormed agricultural land in Irtas village during which Israeli forces temporarily detained Mohammad Ayash as he was attempting to prevent the settler attack. (ii) At 09:25, An Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured Ismail Abu Sheikh (70 years old) near Al-Nashash junction and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Khilat Hadour area in the old city of Hebron.
 - (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya, took photographs of several homes and buildings then withdrew at 12:30.
 - (ii) At 17:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Zif village and stormed several homes.
 - (iii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 06:25.
 - (iv) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Umar, stormed a home and detained a resident.
 - (v) At 07:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa and detained 2 residents including a child.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Nader Iqtit (15 years old) for allegedly finding a knife in his possession.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Qasem Hisham in Beit Ummar.
 - (iii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Suhayeb Shalash (15 years old) and Izat Shalash in Beit Awwa.
- **Temporary Detention:**
 - (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained 2 children: Suhayeb Abu Nijmeh (15 years old) and Husam Abu Sineneh (15 years old) then released them at a later time.
 - (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Yusef Al- Batsh then released him at a later time.
- **Settler Violence:** At 14:00, Israeli settlers stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and attacked Thiyab Jabrs home and caused minor damage to the home.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and as a result injured 2 residents. •
