<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) At 18:00, The Israeli army closed the east entrance of Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 17:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram until 21:00.</li> <li>(ii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, stormed a home then withdrew at 02:30.</li> <li>(iii) At dawn on April 28<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya and detained four residents.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained four residents: Mahmoud Abdel-Raof, Murad Al-Shalloudi, Mohammad Attiya and Ali Mahmoud in Al-Eisawiya.</li> <li>• <b><u>Temporary Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained six women: Su’ad Obadiya,</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>Eman Abu Snieneh, Salwa Al-Ghazawi, Akram Al-Ghazawi, Suha Obeid and Khadiejah Khaweis in Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers.</p> <p>(ii) At 20:15, Israeli forces temporarily detained the child Adam Subah Laban (12 years old) in the old city of Jerusalem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Injury:</u></b> At 21:00 on April 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, the child Layth Al-Hussieni was injured during confrontations with Israeli forces near the entrance of Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem as mentioned in the previous report.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting the Israeli military's closure of the village entrance.</li> <li>(ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan and Al-Thuri neighbourhoods fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Jabal area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iv) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near Sur Bahar, Wadi Al-Juz and Ras Al-Amoud and Salah Al-Din road fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces:</u></b> On April 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces summoned Eyad Al-Dahra (A National Security Force officer) to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.</li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settlement Activity:</u></b> On April 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli authorities issued tenders for the construction of 77 new settlement units (36 units in "Navi Yacoub" settlement and 41 settlement units in "Pizgat Za'iv" settlement) on Palestinian owned land in Jerusalem, which was occupied in 1967.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 02:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Jerusalem and sprayed pepper spray onto the face of Zakariya Sakafi and as a result, left him hospitalised with eye burns and suffocation.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JENIN</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Road:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.</li> <li>(ii) Since the evening of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 15:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababda and Raba village, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 17:05.</li> <li>(ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Jalqamous village until 17:30.</li> <li>(iii) At 22:55, Israeli forces raided Muthalath Al-Shuhada and Jalqamous villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 00:25 on April 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Obied during their raid into Jenin as mentioned in the previous report.</li> <li>(ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Barta’a checkpoint detained Aseel Abadi (A resident of Turat village).</li> <li>(iii) Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Al-Arqa village detained Ahmad Salah.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Killing:</u></b> Mohammad Yahya (A resident of Al-Arqa village) was killed by Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Aqraba</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.</li> </ul>
