ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. Flying Checkpoints: At 13:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of al-Izariyyeh, and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At dawn on April 28, the Israeli army raided the village of Qatannah and arrested 5 civilians. At 13:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Anata. At 12:00, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Izariyyeh, searched 1 civilian house, and arrested 1 civilian. At 13:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Abu Dis and arrested 4 civilians. Arrests: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The 5 civilians arrested in the village of Qatannah are: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Adnan Ismail Taha; Ibrahim Mohammad Issa Taha; Khaled Abdel Nasser Taha; Mohammad Ibrahim taha; and Sami Rohi Taha. (b) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to ‘Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba’ road, the area of al-‘Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
RAMALLAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Safa. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Ras Karkar. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the villages of Ras Karkar and Kharbatha Bani Hareth, the western entrance to the village of Ain Yabroud, and the junction of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiah with dirt barricades and cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of ‘Atara and impede civilian access. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 21:15, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the villages of Beitin and Ein Yabroud, and handed 1 civilian a notification to report to the Israeli military intelligence. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 21:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Qarawa Bani Zayd and arrested 1 civilian. (ii) At 00:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Qarawa Bani Zayd and then withdrew at 03:00. (iii) At 04:30, the Israeli army raided the cities of Ramallah and al-Bireh and the refugee camp of al-Amari, searched a number of civilian houses, arrested 1 civilian in the refugee camp, and withdrew at 06:00.

JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> at 12:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the southern entrance to the city of Jenin on Nablus – Jenin main road, and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:30, the Israeli army raided the village of al-Mugheir and patrolled it until 22:00. (ii) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Ta’nak and combed the area between the villages of Ta’nak and Rummana. (iii) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TOUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • <u>Raids:</u> At 05:00, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of al-Far’a, searched a farm, and arrested 1 civilian. • <u>Arrests:</u> The civilian arrested in the refugee camp of al-Far’a is called Mohammad Ali As’ad al-Salahi.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal’a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to ‘Attil’s plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun’s plain; and the entrance to the village of ‘Izbat Abu Khamis. (b) At 20:00, the Israeli army closed the road connecting the villages of Ramin and Bazaria with dirt barricades. (c) At 17:00, the Israeli army closed the northern entrance to the town of ‘Azzun with barbed wires. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarem-Nablus road and at Jubaa checkpoint. • <u>Raids:</u> At 02:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and the

	<p>refugee camp of Tulkarem, searched 5 civilians houses, arrested 1 civilian in the city, and then withdrew at 04:30.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: The civilian arrested in the city of Tulkarem is called Safii Imad Eddin al-Safi. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the town of ‘Azzun to the village of ‘Asla. (iii) At 11:30, the Israeli army closed with dirt barriers the road connecting Azzun town to Izbat Tabib village. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede civilian access. At 14:10, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint because 2 veiled female civilians refused to take of the veil. The checkpoint was reopened at a later time. • Raids: At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Qalqilya, searched a number of civilian houses, arrested 1 civilian, and withdrew at 04:15. • Arrests: The civilian arrested in the city of Qalqilya is called Abdallah Mohammad ‘Aref Nofal. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. • Wall Construction: Land leveling for Wall construction continues in villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun.
NABLUS	<p>Closure of Main Roads:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan. (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. (iv) At 11:30, the Israeli army closed Beit Iba checkpoint and impeded traffic under the pretext of suspecting a civilian carrying a bag. The checkpoint was reopened at 12:50. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:45, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the town of Iqraba and the village of al-Majdal. (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on al-Badhan road (eastern entrance to the city of Nablus), and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, the Israeli army raided the western are of the village of Deir Sharaf for military training until 11:15. (ii) At 15:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of al-Badhan. (iii) At 21:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Beita, opened fire intensively and fired illumination bombs. (iv) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and the refugee camps of Balata and Ein al-Ma', arrested 4 civilians in the refugee camp of Balata, and then withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Arrests:</u> The 4 civilians arrested in the refugee camp of Balata are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Firas Abdallah al-Sheikh Khalil; (b) Qusay Khaled Hashash; (c) Mohammad Tawfiq Doqan; and (d) Mohammad Sa'id Sidqi al-Aghyar.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and Hares. In addition, the Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Yassouf and the southern entrance to the village of Deir Istiyya with dirt barricades, as well as the southern entrance to the town of Kafh Hares and the 2 northern entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Qarawa Bani Hassan. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tara checkpoints and prevent civilian vehicles from traveling towards the town of Kafr al-Dik. At 17:00, the Israeli army closed Za'tara checkpoint and impeded traffic upon the arrest of a civilian under the pretext of finding a suspicious object with him. The checkpoint was

(ii) At 00:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Fahma, searched a number of civilian houses, and withdrew at 01:50. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. • Flying Checkpoints: At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah., and searched civilians and vehicles. • Arrests: At 18:40, the Israeli army arrested at the checkpoint that is set up on the junction of the village of al-'Auja a civilian called Ahmad Mifleh. • Palestinian Security Measures: On April 27, the Palestinian security forces handed over to the Israeli side through the D.C.O. a female settler called Ilya Rafil who was caught in the city of Jericho.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. • Checkpoints: At 15:00, the Israeli army closed al-container checkpoint and impeded traffic under the pretext of finding a suspicious object. The checkpoint was reopened at 16:30. • Flying Checkpoints: At 09:35, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the town of Jenata, and searched civilians and vehicles until 10:00. • Raids:

	<p>(i) At 10:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem, the town of al-Khader and the refugee camp of Dheisheh and stormed a boys' school. In addition, the Israeli arrested 1 civilian in the town of al-Khader, and then withdrew at 11:00.</p> <p>(ii) At 23:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem and the refugee camp of Aida.</p> <p>(iii) At 00:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Beit Jala.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> at 18:10, the Israeli army detained at al-container checkpoint members of a sports team on their way to the city of Bethlehem, but released them at 18:30 after the intervention of the military liaison. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp. (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 15:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the

	<p>town of Halhoul overpass, and searched civilians and vehicles until 17:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on April 28, the Israeli army raided the town of Nouba and arrested 1 civilian. (ii) At 18:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Awwa and patrolled it until 18:50. (iii) At 23:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, searched 1 civilian house, and confiscated the ID of 1 civilian called Walid al-Qawasmi. (iv) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Tafouh, searched 1 civilian house and incurred damage to its furniture, confiscated 1 computer from it, and arrested 1 child. (v) At 01:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Thahiriyyeh. (vi) At 01:45, the Israeli army raided the town of Dura, searched 2 garages and a store that deals with spare parts. <p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanoun (Erez) Crossing is partially open (to allow previously coordinated humanitarian access). • <u>Raids:</u> Since 05:30 on April 28, the Israeli army has been raiding the town of Beit Hanoun and northeast the town of Beit Lahia, opened fire intensively and fired tank missiles towards civilian houses. In addition, an Israeli drone fired 1 missile towards armed individuals. Moreover, Israeli troops searched a number of civilian houses, clashed with armed individuals and killed 1 armed individual and injured 15 civilians, including 6 armed individuals and 4 civilians who were seriously injured. The Israeli army also arrested 10 civilians and razed agricultural land. • <u>Deaths:</u> The civilian killed in the town of Beit Hanoun is called Mu'ath Mohammad Atallah al-Akhras.
